DIVISION 1 REVIEWS AND PREVIEWS



Goodwood Saints vs Brighton Bombers:

Last week I tipped this game to be the match of the round as both teams felt on level pegging. An enthralling 2 point victory to the Brighton bombers has brought that prediction into fruition in a big way. The Bombers have now chalked up their 2nd victory of the season, and sit comfortably in 5th position on percentage. They will rue their convincing in round 1, as their follow up wins have earned them a higher ladder position purely based on determination and hunger for the footy. For Brighton, Thomas Welsby was their primary path to goal as he slammed home 4 goals of their total 11. Otherwise, it was Blake McDonnell and Dayne McGary putting together terrific all-round performances to ensure their team sat inside a finals position at least for the week. For the Saints, an honorable second half comeback will spark some inspiration for next week, however coming off 2 disappointing losses for different reasons, it'll be a long week in Goodwood.



Glenunga vs Old Ignatians:

The Old Ignatians go down in what was a virtuous performance, as their smallest losing margin game at the hands of the very strong Glenunga lineup, as they take a 90 - 53 victory and sit 3 - 0 to earn an emphatic start to their season. Each team will take a lot out of this game, Glenunga get challenged for the first time this year, and respond strongly with a textbook last quarter. The tight unit of the rams proving simply too classy in the end, this serves as an indication as to where each team stands at this point in their respective development. The Old Ignatians will be pretty stoked to be behind by a mere 3 goals at three quarter time, as their drive for the footy equalled that of the hosts. This will hold them in better stead as the season progresses.



Port Districts vs Sacred Heart OC:

Moreover, as they venture to Prince Alfred next week, this early season is turning into a very tough one in the Port Districts camp.



Broadview vs Prince Alfred OC:

The wayward kicking Broadview have been given a lesson in team cohesion as Prince Alfred stamp their authority on the competition, sitting second on the ladder as they also rock a 3 - 0 record early in the season. As Jayden Davis slotted an impressive 4 goals for the second game in a row, bringing his total tally to 11 goals after 3 matches.

Division 4 Round 3



Mitcham v Portland
