DIVISION 1 REVIEWS AND PREVIEWS

Glenunga vs St. Peter's OC:

The Webb Oval played host to another day at the office for Glenunga, as they comfortably ran over St. Peter's OC to further cement their position at the top of the table, unfortunately perpetuating St. Peter's pain as they sit second to bottom with a winless record so far. Last week, I perhaps jumped the gun again and tipped Glenunga to take the first 100+ point win of the season. At quarter time, an astonishing 50 - 3 lead saw this as a real possibility, and Glenunga's vice skipper Michael Mcmahon tried to make it a reality, booting 6 on the day. However, a more spirited second half from the St. Peter's defense compiled a relatively positive finish to the game. The finals scoreboard read 124 - 49 as Glenunga continued their terrific start to the 2023 football season.

Brighton Bombers vs Broadview:

Broadview again earned the title of ferociously competitive as their defensive pressure, as well as some wayward Brighton Bombers kicking saw the home side fall 56 points short of the visitors. A first quarter onslaught set the tempo for the day as the Bombers had a goalless quarter compared to a 6 goal term for Broadview. Another 6 goal haul for round as Kobi Russell kicked truly all day long, converting 6 shots for 6 goals with 0 behinds. For the bombers, some set shot practice may be on the menu, as they make the trek next week to come up against a red hot Port Districts. The winner of that matchup will earn an important 3 - 2 record at this point in the season.

Tea Tree Gully vs Goodwood Saints:

Tea Tree Gully officially shake their home deck - hoodoo to deliver a convincing 40 point massacre of the briefly competitive saints. Goodward started the game impressively, boasting a 19 - 28 lead at the first change, a goalless second term unfortunately not really seeing them get back in the game. Jade Cleeland was the target up forward, having 8 shots on goal for the day. Unfortunately, a 4 goals 4 conversion rate for the day saw his ledger remain a little bit red. For the straight shooting hosts, a match tally of 15 goals 9 proved enough as their forward shared the proverbial chocolates more evenly.

Old Ignatians vs Sacred Heart OC:

Sacred Heart OC have earnt 2nd place on the season ladder as they deliver a monumental 98 point victory over the Old Ignatians. For the Ignatians, it wasn't actually all doom and gloom. Indeed, at quarter time they possessed an exciting 5 point lead, unfortunately they would proceed to kick only 1 goal for the rest of the day. This is all while Sacred Heart has an incredible 12 unique goal scorers, as after a quarter time spray, everything clicked into gear, kicking 119 points in the remaining 3 quarters, bringing their match total to 134, simultaneously suppressing the Old Ignatians to 36.

Prince Alfred OC vs Port Districts:

Port Districts have pulled off a tremendous win, as they sink Prince Alfred on their home deck and give the hosts their first home loss of the season. From the get - go Port Districts look right on top, the reigning premiers attack on the ball harder than anyone i've seen this year. Some wins are worth more than the 2 points they earn you, this is definitely the case for Port, as the inevitable inspiration they take from this win will be difficult to surmount for whomever their opponents are next week. For Prince Alfred, a disappointing loss at home will prove a vital reality check for their season, they will be keen to put it behind them and look to next week as they again have a tough challenge against Sacred Heart OC.



Division 4 Round 4 review

Pooraka v Hectorville

The only undefeated team in division 4 flexed its muscles at home this week, and in doing so sent out an ominous warning to the rest of the competition. Hectorville kicked the first goal of the game through David Hamann but that proved to be one of the few positives for their day. Pooraka went "Bang, Bang" directly from the next two centre bounces and it was pretty much one way traffic from there on. Pooraka have impressive depth in the midfield and Matt Rankine, Frank Timpano and Sean Hee continued their good early season form to provide the Bulls with plenty of drive. Their speed of ball movement allowed the elusive Ronald Rankine and tall forward Luke Buckby to kick four goals each. Coach Shane Hickey would be especially pleased with the spread of goal kickers they had with 10 different players hitting the score board. For Hectorville their captain Dan Fairbrother is putting together an excellent season in the Hounds midfield. Only tall forward Jak Goudman-Glasson was able to repeatedly hit the scoreboard. Pooraka eventually ran out 88 point victors.

Lockleys v Mitcham

This game also proved to be a one-sided affair with Lockleys jumping out of the blocks quickly and by quarter time the Demons were 37 points in front and the contest was essentially over. Lockleys love to move the ball quickly and with purpose. This is unsurprising given the potency of their forward line. Their two high profile forwards proved unstoppable with Ben Haren kicking six goals despite regularly hitting up to provide a contest across half forward and Matt Mcdonough kicking 4. He also received best player honours. Lockleys were also well served my midfielder Josh Fazzalari and Bowen Hosking who has been in Lockleys best in all four games so far. Mitcham were never really in the contest and only tall forward Lucas Spiniello was able to kick multiple goals. He also was given the best player votes for the Hawks. Both Dan Cross and midfielder Harrison Pride battled on manfully also.

Kenilworth v CBCOC

Being 2 and 2 after four games is by no means a disaster, but it does mean they have much work to do to stay with the pace setters of the competition. There were two factors that proved to be decisive in this contest. The Walkerville tall forwards Adam Proud and James Boston, and the Plympton inaccuracy in front of goal. Walkerville were well served by midfielder Daniel Reardon and captain Sean Kuerschner while Jackson Davis and

Salisbury Vs Central United






