Fortunately, sanity has prevailed and Rankine will not have to face the tribunal.

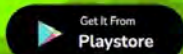
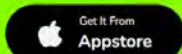

Crows to fly high

Its February 1. You are at SANFL headquarters preparing for the upcoming season and it is time to make the seasons fixture. You see an open Friday night slot for a big game. Who could take this? Who will excite? South Adelaide maybe? No, not enough flare. Centrals? No, not enough success. Oh, I know, you excitedly think to yourself. How about last season's preliminary finalists; Norwood and Adelaide. Perfect, you think. Both sides have a competitive history. Both sides succeeded in 2022. Both sides are exciting to watch. Unfortunately, what was a great decision at the start of the year has quickly manifested into what will likely be a dominant affair. While both sides respectively finished second and third last season, progressing to a preliminary and grand final (Norwood), only one has maintained last seasons form. As such, Norwood enter the match bottom of the table, whereas Adelaide come into the match in quality form, sitting third.

Despite winning last seasons grand final, Norwood are suffering heavily from a premiership hangover. Although having a similar list to last season, they have not won a game. In 2022, Norwood's catalyst for success was their ability to prevent opposition teams from scoring (ranked one). This season the Redlegs are ranked ninth in defence. Similarly, Norwood were ranked fourth in offense last season. Yet, this year, the Redlegs are the worst offensive team, and average a measly 51 points a game. Concerningly for coach, Jade Rawlings, Norwood's lack of pressure (more tackles than the opposition once this season), coupled with their lack of control on the game, has allowed opposition sides to easily transfer the ball. This is exemplified by Norwood having less disposals than their opposition in 50 per cent of matches this season, as well as having less marks in every game. When Norwood have generated inside 50's (more inside 50's than their opposition twice this year), they have been the most ineffective team in front of goals. Fortunately for Norwood and Rawlings blood pressure, the last two weeks have been more impressive. In this period, Norwood won disposals, clearances, inside 50's or disposal efficiency. Further, there have been promising individual performances including ruckman Harry Boyd (who has not lost hit outs this season), Nicholas Rokahr, Jacob Kennerly and Ben Jarvis. Subsequently, if the Redlegs are to challenge Adelaide, these players will not only have to perform well, but also be the catalyst for Norwood to rectify their key performance indicators.

On the contrary, Adelaide have been one of the most dominant sides in the competition. Until last week's loss, to top of the ladder Sturt, the Crows were the number one team in both defence and offense. In stark contrast to Norwood, the Crows domination has come through their ability to control the play. They have had more marks than their opposition every game this year. Similarly, they have not lost a disposal count (they have had a lower disposal efficiency than their opposition once). In fact, in the last three weeks the differential in disposals between Adelaide and their opposition is 228. Surprisingly, the Crows have lost clearances three out of the last four weeks and lost tackles two out of the last three weeks. Nonetheless, through Adelaide's unique ability to control the play as well as their effectiveness when going inside forward 50, they have lost only two games this season.

While Adelaide will enter the game as undeniable favourites, one would be foolish to rule out Norwood, particularly on their home oval, in front of their home crowd, in a stellar Friday night match. Nonetheless, Adelaide have been the superior team this season, and while red and blue fans can expect a Norwood resurgence in the second half of the season, it is difficult to see them defeating one of the competitions strongest sides. Adelaide by 12-24.

Eagles to prove themselves against Westies in a tough, hard-fought contest.

After a week off due to the SANFL West End State Game, Woodville West-Torrens travel to Richmond Oval to take on West Adelaide in Round 7, and with both sides sitting at 2 wins and 4 losses after securing victories against Central Districts, and reigning premiers Norwood, respectively, this is a match up that, this early into the season, could make or break either team going forward. In Round 6, West Adelaide travelled to Centenary Oval at Port Lincoln and faced off against struggling, injury-plagued, Norwood for the Peter Teakle Cup for the second year in a row, having this time around, being triumphant, thanks to a four-goal flurry in the third term, to run out, 11.8 74 to 8.14 62 winners, by 12 points. Norwood came out of the blocks early, booting three quick goals inside the opening 3 minutes of the first quarter, to give coach Jade Rawlings an 18 point lead, and to put their opponent on the ropes early, however the visitors, through goals from Jono Beech and Hamish Ellem were able to reduce the margin to 6 points after 22 minutes of play. A late goal from Norwood's Matt Panos, who was playing his 2nd League Game this season, after a delayed start due to injury, gave the "home team" a 12-point lead at the quarter time break. West Adelaide kicked 3.1 to Norwood's 2.5 in the second term to head into the major break 10 points behind, with the 'Legs missing easy set shots from Cameron Taheny and Sammy Morris to open the quarter. Had those shots on goal been perfect, the Redlegs would have been well in front, however, thanks to back to back goals from Beech and Michael Laudato, Westies were within two points, that was until Baynen Lowe and Xavier Tranfa kicked a goal each to extend the margin out to a game-high 16 points, which after a late captain's goal, was reduced to just ten points at half-time. The Redlegs looked set to snap their five-game losing streak when premiership forward, Baynen Lowe, kicked a goal to put Norwood 16 points ahead, inside three minutes in the third quarter, but the Bloods, all of a sudden were putting work on the scoreboard, as Joel Stevens, Luke Redfern, Hamish Ellem and Michael Laudato managed to kick four quick goals in succession, 10 minutes later, to give the visitors a nine-point lead midway through the third term. Then after a run of 7 consecutive behinds (4 from West and 3 from Norwood), Xavier Tranfa, kicked his second goal of the match, and the second for his team of the quarter, to extend the lead once again to three points with a quarter to play. The tight lead at the final change meant this match was set for an incredible finish. A goal each from Joshua Gore and Luke Redfern in the fourth quarter was enough for the Bloods to hand Norwood their sixth successive defeat as well as secure their second victory on the season and first since Round 3. Baynen Lowe, Matt Panos and Xavier Tranfa each kicked two goals, whilst collecting 21, 18 and 10 possessions respectively. Premiership Captain, Matthew Nunn had 29 disposals to go with 1.0 and nine tackles, Nik Rokhar, (28 and a goal), and reigning Jack Oatey Medalist, Harry Boyd, (22 possessions and six clearances), were also stuffing the star sheet. Michael Laudato, Johnathan Beech, Luke Redfern, and Hamish Ellem each kicked two goals for West Adelaide, while Kobe Ryan (28 disposals, 16 tackles and 11 clearances) and Joel Stevens (28 and 1.1) starred in the midfield. West Adelaide now turn their attention to hosting The Eagles, who were able to overcome and upset the in-form Bulldogs over the weekend at Woodville Oval. The home side prevailed 10.7 67 to 6.7 43, to defeat Central Districts by 24 points, with former Brisbane Lion, Connor Ballenden kicking 3 goals in the victory, improving his tally to 14 from the first 6 rounds in 2023. Joseph Sinor also continued his very impressive start to the season, collecting 21 disposals including a whopping 17 tackles and 10 clearances to go with his 2 goals, he was well helped around the ground by Mitch Hardie, who finished with 27 possessions including nine tackles and four clearances. Harry Grant was a tackling machine for the Bulldogs, having a whopping 15 of his own as well as racking up 20 possessions. Central's Dale Pearce, the brother of Will Pearce, who plays for the Eagles, kicked 2.1 from only 3 disposals, whereas Will Pearce, kicked 2.1 from 14 disposals for Woodville. Jarrod Schiller did all he could in trying to will his side over the line, having collected 18 disposals including 7 clearances. Both Woodville and West Adelaide will be looking to collect a third victory on the season, and both will be looking to win consecutive games for the first time in season 2023, and with the likes of Kobe Ryan and Joseph Sinor opposing each other, as well as battling it out for early Magarey Medal favoritism, this will be a very closely contested match up that is most likely going to be decided in the midfield. With West Adelaide being the home team, they go into this match as the favourites, but never count out the Eagles, who despite also being 2 and 4, much like West Adelaide, are looking to spoil the party and secure their 3rd win of the season.

ROUND 6

Port Adelaide 15.12 (102) def South Adelaide 11.8 (74)

The Magpies used a massive last quarter to propel them home over a strong South Adelaide outfit that led at three quarter time. The Panthers led by seven points at the final change, before just one goal in the last quarter hurt them, as Port Adelaide piled on 6.5 in the same period to win by 28 points. The win marks three on the trot for the AFL side's reserves, as they have found some form to match their senior side's recent success. Once again, Port Adelaide were beaten in the disposal count, and produced at a lower disposal efficiency, but managed to get the ball inside 50 seven more times and were far more efficient once inside their attack, having 27 scoring shots to South's 19. Their game style is not conducive to major ball winning numbers, but it is resulting in wins for the club, and they are pushing for a finals spot early on in 2023. Scott Lycett, who was in doubt throughout the week, shared the ruck duties with Dante Visentini, and together they dominated South Adelaide's ruck tandem. Magpies trio Hugh Jackson, Trent Dumont and Nick Moore all amassed 20 or more disposals, and combined for 17 clearances as they continuously sent Port Adelaide forward out of the stoppages, and once they were forward, their ten different goalkickers did the rest, led by their four multi-goalkickers Cody Szust (3.1), Sam Hayes (2.3), Nick Moore (2.2) and Sam Weideman (2.0). For the Panthers, they struggled without their leader Bryce Gibbs, but Joseph Haines (30 disposals) and former Brisbane Lion Ely Smith (24 disposals, 7 tackles, 9 clearances) more than held their own as they tried to will their side to a vital road win. Damon Freitag (3.1) was their most potent option down forward, but their options went dry in the last quarter as the Magpies ran over the top of them. Looking to next week, both sides have tough draws. Port Adelaide travel to North Adelaide to take on the Roosters (3-3) who have been hot and cold, but are formidable on paper as they aspire to avenge their runner up year last year. South Adelaide take on the undefeated Sturt in what will be very hard to win for the 2-4 Panthers.

South Adelaide v Sturt

Flinders University Stadium, Saturday 27th May, 2:10pm

Round Seven's final matchup sees the Panthers (2-4) host the Double Blues (6-0) in what should be a good game, regardless of the records. South Adelaide have been competitive in almost every game, and have probably looked better at times than their 2-4 record suggests, while Sturt have looked nearly unbeatable for a lot of 2023 thus far. With Bryce Gibbs sidelined for 5-7 weeks as he battles his broken thumb, the Panthers have had to field a depleted midfield the past couple weeks, and while some players have stepped up in Gibbs' absence, they have lacked his leadership around contests and have ultimately fallen short in the last fortnight without him. However, Sturt are not unscathed by any means, with number one ruckman Dan Fahey-Sparks (hand) still a week away, meaning he will almost certainly miss this week's clash. They relied on Amos Doyle (27 hitouts) to do the heavy lifting last week, and he held his own as the Double Blues' main ruck just fine as Sturt beat Adelaide by ten points. This match will be won in a couple of key areas. Firstly, the forward line battle, where Sturt's consistently firing attack has been key to their success early in the year, will be a telling point. Lachlan Burrows and Joshua Hone have led an accurate, potent forward line through six rounds so far, and the Panthers defence must contain at least one of their key forward options to give themselves a chance. At the other end, South Adelaide's attack, led by ex-Giant Zach Sproule, need to match the Double Blues efforts to keep them in it. Furthermore, the midfield battle will be crucial, as Sturt have won almost every week in that area, sending the ball forward constantly and giving their fit and firing forwards chances to create scoring opportunities. Tom Lewis, who leads the league in tackles, continues to produce an astoundingly high work-rate, while ball winners James Battersby and Patrick Wilson, who combined for 12 clearances on the weekend, work in tandem to send the ball forward on a regular basis. The Panthers have the weapons to counter this midfield, however, with Mitch O'Neill and Joseph Haines among the team's best week in and week out. Ultimately, Sturt should hold strong and win their seventh straight. If they can knock off a scintillating Adelaide side, South Adelaide should be a certain win. However, the Panthers have the personnel to cause headaches, but unfortunately the loss of Gibbs may be too great against a top side like the Double Blues.

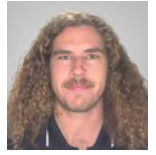

The SANFL heads to Prospect Oval in round 7 for a blockbuster clash featuring North Adelaide Roosters and Port Adelaide Magpies. Both teams have had sub-par beginnings to their seasons but are clinging on to the bottom of the top 5, reluctant to let the finals dream slip so early in the season. North Adelaide have had an inconsistent start to the season, having a 3-3 record through the first month and a half of games. Their most recent game was a 57-point loss to Glenelg, their biggest loss of the season by quite some margin. The first quarter was somewhat even, with most of the quarter being at a stalemate with both sides sitting at one goal apiece. Late in the quarter, Glenelg added two goals to lead by 15 points at quarter time. The second quarter saw the game fall away from the Roosters, conceding 8 goals, including the first three to Liam McBean, while only responding with one of their own to head into half-time trailing by 58 points. The Roosters come out after the main break with somewhat of a response after conceding the first, kicking the remaining four goals of the quarter to cut the margin back to 44 points heading into the final term. The Roosters tried to finish strong but were again outscored 4 goals to 2 in the final term to eventually lose by 57 points. On a sour day for the Roosters, Campbell Combe was a shining light with 36 disposals, 8 tackles and 6 clearances to continue his sublime start to the season. Keegan Ramsey led the way up forward, kicking 3 goals from his 12 disposals to lead the team in scoring. Aaron Young was also a star in the midfield, finishing with 22 disposals, 5 tackles and 2 goals, giving his best all day.

Port Adelaide started the season in disappointing fashion, losing their opening 3 matches before going on a 3-game winning streak to also be 3-3 after the opening 6 games, sitting just under North on the ladder with 2% difference. In their most recent game, Port performed a last quarter comeback to cement their name amongst the final's contenders in 2023. Port started the game red-hot, coming out and kicking the first 4 goals of the game, before South Adelaide responded with 4 of their own in the final 10 minutes, with the Magpies taking a slim 1-point lead into the first break. The second quarter was more of the exciting end-to-end footy that possessed the first quarter. A goal for goal quarter saw South Adelaide take a 6-point lead into the main break, with fans chatting around the ground wanting more of the same come the second half. Again, the third quarter didn't disappoint with both teams once again kicking an equal number of goals for the quarter, leaving South with a slim but handy 7-point lead heading into the final change of ends. The quarter began in exciting circumstances, with the Magpies cutting the margin back to a single point in the opening two minutes, before a rushed behind was conceded by South, leaving the game all square at 68 apiece. While the whole crowd had the prediction of a South Adelaide goal to continue the goal for goal trend, Port Adelaide once again scored to kickstart their runaway victory, kicking a further 4 goals for the game to South Adelaide's 1 to run out 28-point winners in one of the games of the season so far. Without any players having major possession counts, there were still many players who had a major impact on the team. Nick Moore led the way with 20 disposals, 10 tackles, 6 inside 50s and 2 goals to be awarded best-on-ground for the day. Cody Szust had a day out, finishing with 3 goals from his 18 disposals. Trent Dumont was strong all day, with 22 disposals, 8 marks and 5 clearances while Hugh Jackson had 24 disposals, 7 inside 50s and 9 clearances, all team-high stats. AFL listed player Jase Burgoyne has put his hand up for a recall into the Power side, adding 19 disposals, 4 tackles and a goal in a good game up forward with plenty of pressure acts.

Looking ahead to the weekend, it has all that is required to make for a good, tough, and enjoyable game of footy. The Roosters are struggling in a form slump and are looking for a strong response after receiving their biggest defeat since Round 19, 2021. North have all the components to challenge a red hot Port Adelaide outfit, with one of the strongest defences in the league, along with a reliable and tough midfield who can get the ball forward of centre and put pressure on the opponents defence. Port Adelaide have been playing amazing footy recently and are proving to be tough to beat. They can win by opening up the game with their midfield pressure and using their small forwards more than they did in the opening 3 weeks of footy. The last time these two teams played at Prospect Oval (Round 13, 2022) Port Adelaide only scored one goal for the game and lost by 126 points. Expect something very different come Saturday, with the potential for this game to be a belter through the roof.

Brilliant Bays make it six straight Central District faces one of the most daunting challenges in football when it hosts an imposing Glenelg side chasing its sixth consecutive victory on Saturday. The Bays sounded a warning shot to the rest of the competition with their 57-point demolition over last year's grand finalists North Adelaide, which saw them jump to second on the SANFL ladder, joining fellow pacesetters Sturt at the top of the table. It was a commanding first half performance highlighted by a goal-scoring blitz that saw the Bays kick nine unanswered majors, outscoring the visitors 49-6 in the second quarter, as they snuffed out any possibility of a Roosters upset at Stratarama Stadium. Key-forward Liam McBean was spectacular for the Bays, kicking the first three goals of the second quarter inside ten minutes. The Roosters offered a spirited fightback in the second half, kicking five consecutive goals to bring the margin back below 40-points. Glenelg responded with two goals of its own however, including some brilliant overlapping work from Brad McCarthy as he split the middle with a run from half back. Ex-Richmond player McBean finished the game with a season-high six goals alongside a host of Glenelg players who starred as the club continues to thrive under new coach Darren Reeves in 2023. Corey Lyons (31 disposals and eight tackles) led the way for the Bays in the midfield, supported by Luke Partington (29 disposals), Matthew Snook (29 disposals and seven tackles) and Darcy Bailey (26 disposals) off of half back. Luke Reynolds continued his solid season up forward kicking three goals in an even contribution across the field for Glenelg, whilst Ken Farmer Medal leader Lachlan Hosie kicked 1.3 for the afternoon. Central District struggled early last weekend against a relentless Woodville-West Torrens side that applied frenetic pressure, eventually falling to the Eagles by 24-points. The Eagles matched the Bulldogs for tackles despite controlling possession, and were able to withstand repeat forward entries from the Bulldogs, who struggled to score from their inside 50 dominance (42-32). The Bulldogs were able to wrestle back momentum briefly in the second quarter to take the lead, but it was short-lived as the Eagles kicked away to lead by 11-points at half time, they were never headed from there. Whilst the Bulldogs were able to generate forward entries, capitalising on them proved difficult, as the Eagles rebounded from defence 35 times, with the Bulldogs unable to lock the ball inside their attacking territory. It was a day that saw many Bulldogs players struggle to have an influence, with 11 players recording under ten disposals. Harry Grant toiled hard for 20 disposals and an incredible 15 tackles, whilst captain Jarrod Schiller offered resistance with 18 disposals and seven clearances, including a goal in the fourth quarter that threatened to swing the momentum. Key-forward Dale Pearce was the lone multiple goal scorer for the Bulldogs with two goals from his three disposals. Round 19 last year was the most recent clash between these two sides as Central District concluded its season and Glenelg charged towards finals. The Bays won that encounter by two points, winning the possession battle, clearances and inside 50s. It was only a six-goal last quarter however that got them over the line, aided by some missed opportunities in front of goal by the Bulldogs, who had three more scoring shots. Lachlan Hosie was pivotal for the Bays that day with four goals, and it could've been more with seven shots on goal. Glenelg's Matthew Snook (27 disposals) went head-to-head with Central District's Travis Schiller (26 disposals) and Justin Hoskin (25 disposals). A loss against Glenelg on Saturday will find Central District vulnerable in the top five of the SANFL ladder, with North Adelaide (5th) and Port Adelaide (6th) equal on points with the Bulldogs. Back in front of their home crowd at X Convenience Oval, the Bulldogs will need to bring plenty of intensity and simply must make the most of their opportunities entering forward 50. Ineffective entries inside attack will be easy pickings for a Glenelg side that loves to transition aggressively from its defensive half. The Bulldogs will need a huge improvement across the board this week when it comes to an even spread of contributors, which there was a lack of against the Eagles last week. Midfielder Justin Hoskin was certainly missed last weekend, but is no guarantee to return against the Bays with a hand injury. Glenelg are playing irresistible football at the moment, and look set to continue on their winning ways this weekend.
