DIVISION 1 DEVIEWS AND PREVIEWS

Broadview vs St Peter's:

A valiant St. Peters OC produced a spirited comeback after a first quarter blitz from Broadview. A 29-8 quarter time break scoreline detailed looming doom for the visitors, as a blowout began to appear possible. A fantastic second quarter from Broadview extended their lead to 28 at half time. Immense tackling pressure and commitment from the Broadview team kept St Peters to only 3 goals in the first half. From there, St Peter's came out swinging, booting an impressive 3 goal quarter while more importantly keeping their opponents goalless. Smelling blood in the water, the margin was reduced to just 2 straight kicks at the final break. Before a composed Broadview lineup kicked truly to extend their lead to 18 points and hold it there until the final siren. Broadview now sits 1 win outside of the top 5 and remains in the hunt for September.

Port Districts vs Glenunga:

A win for the optimists! Last week I said that Port Districts had something cooking, and decided to let the optimist in me take the wheel as I backed Port Districts to end Glengunga's reign. In one of the best defensively played games of the year, Glenunga are proven to be vincible. For Port Districts, this win cements their place in the top 5, sitting 1 win away from top spot. Furthermore, the room for improvement will also serve as even more of a confidence boost, as their wayward kicking almost allowed Glenunga back in the game. For Glenunga, they remain atop the ladder, however only by a miniscule 0.65% at the moment. A necessary reality check will keep them in the hunt for more wins as the season progresses.

Goodwood Saints vs Old Ignatians:

Goodwood hosted the lackluster Old Ignatians as they sought to earn a long awaited win. For them, a win was just about the only acceptable result this week, and frankly it was just getting the job done territory. Which they did, however not without a solid 3 quarter competition from the bottom of the ladder sitting Old Ignatians. Jade Cleeland led the scoring shots with 7, unfortunately only kicking 3 goals 4 in an otherwise very impressive display. The visitors managed to trim the margin from 26 points to a measly 15 at 3 quarter time as we were set for a grandstand finish. But it was Goodwood to pile on the pain in the last, as they slammed home 5 final quarter goals to Old Ignatians zero to run away 43 point victors.

Sacred Heart OC vs Tea Tree Gully:

Sacred Heart have made an absolute statement victory, taking the in - contention Tea Tree gully and dished up the equal third biggest winning margin of the 2023 season. The high scoring Tea Tree Gully lineup were dealt a defensive masterclass, being kept to only 3 goals, and a total of 25 points - by far their lowest score of the season. The straight shooting Sacred Heart OC converted 30 scoring shots to 18 goals and 12 behinds, and in this tipsters mind, earn the new title of most dominant team in division 1 football division at the moment. As they sit in second place by nearly the absolute barest of margins.

Prince Alfred OC vs Brighton Bombers:

Brighton provided half of a very competitive performance, as Prince Alfred ended up becoming convincing winners after a second half blitz. A pretty high scoring affair in the first half saw each team earn 5 and 4 goals respectively. The 7 point margin at half time would be the closest it would remain for the rest of the game, as a 10 goal second half saw Prince Alfred OC run away with a 54 point victory and keep Brighton further away from finals contention. The top 5 seems solidified at this point in the season, Prince Alfred will look to earn a top 3 finish to ensure a double chance come September.

Round 7 Review

Mitcham v Hectorville

Mitcham were able to control the game from the start of their round 7 clash against Hectorville at Price Memorial oval. If not for some wayward kicking they would have been further than 11 points in front at quarter time. They converted their ascendancy more effectively in the second quarter and by half time had control of the game and a 22 point lead. Hectorville found Mitcham's tall forwards difficult to deal with. Lochie Hall and Max Smyth kicked 4 each while powerful forward Lucas Spiniello kicked 3. Hall and Spiniello were also adjudged Mitcham's two best players. Running half back Luke Broadbent was awarded Hectorville's best continuing his good run of form. This could prove to be an important win for Mitcham as they strive to move up the ladder and away from the "danger zone". After the long weekend bye, they will have the opportunity to gain momentum with a table shaping contest against Walkerville while the challenges keep coming for Hectorville as they take on the powerful if not slightly inconsistent Plympton.

Morphettville Park v Pooraka

Pooraka showed why they are the most prolific scoring team in division 4 with a 126 point demolition of Morphettville Park at Kellett Reserve. Pooraka have kicked 87 points more than any other team and they have many forward line options as well as hard running midfielders who consistently hit the score board. This bodes well for them come finals time as they strive for "Preliminary Final Integrity". Morphettville Park were without influential midfielder Nick Hankin and this certainly did not help their cause. Half forward Brody Trembath was one of Morphy Parks few winners kicking 5 goals and gaining best player honors. For Pooraka midfielder Michael Baker kicked 8 while tall forward Luke Buckby continued his high scoring form kicking 5. Places 4 to 7 on the ladder are tight (as happens most years) and this makes the Kangas clash with CBCOC in round 8 critical. Pooraka will host Portland in what may well be another percentage booster for the flying Bulls.

CBCOC v Walkerville

This game promised to be a battle between two of the front runners in the leading goal kicker race. Playing coach Brett Simpson for CBCOC and Adam Proud for Walkerville. Both players did not let their team down kicking 4 and 5 respectively, but it was the other forward line options that proved decisive for the Dolphins. Half forward Aaron Marchioro has been a consistent contributor for CBCOC and he continued this good form kicking 5 goals and being awarded best player. For Walkerville wingman Daniel Callary received best player honours while Walkervilles prolific captain Sean Kuerschner was once again a ball magnet. This win keeps CBCOC in touch with the pace-setting top two as they strive for the double chance come September and prepare for a visit to Kellett Reserve after the bye. A crucial clash for Walkerville against Mitcham awaits them after the King's birthday.

Stuart Taverner showed why he could stake a claim for the title of best ruck man in the league and midfielder Darcy Rankin-Hooper gave considerable drive through the middle also. Fraser Goodes showed good form in the Kenilworth midfield while wingman Charlie uick also performed well. Plympton's performances must be keeping coach Mark Shutz up nights. Their best form is impressive but their season has been littered with poor form also. No doubt they are looking for more consistency as they move toward the second half of the season.

Portland v Lockleys

Their appears to be very little light at the end of the tunnel for a Portland outfit struggling for competitiveness and lacking in depth to call upon at the selection table. With the Portland defense undersized and with Dale Laslett playing forward Ben Haren loomed as a huge threat, and it proved to be so with the competition leading goal kicker finishing with 10 as well as best player honours. Small forward Adam Fazzlari was also a strong contributor kicking 4 goals. For Portland midfielder Terry Milera drifted forward to kick three while the sharp shooting ex ruckman Corey Evans kicked 2. Key defender Buchanan Bates provided some resistance for the Thunder and not surprisingly Ben Haren was awared best afield for Lockleys. Josh Fazzalari completed a good day for the Fazzalari boys by also being in the best while once again Bowen Hosking also made the "BP's". The bye comes at just the right time for the struggling Portland boys although they will have two weeks to consider their clash with a rampant Pooraka side while Lockleys will go back home to await Kenilworth.

Div 4 at the bye...

It isn't quite the midpoint of the season...but it is pretty close! The bye seems a pretty good time to reflect on what the data from the first part of the season may tell us about what will happen for the remainder of the season. Generally, the premiership table only tells part of the story, and this season is no different. In fact, this author would hypotheses that there is more than one "ladder" that the coaches would be looking at when deciding their training strategies in the next two months. It has been proven over time that being in the right part of the reserves, points for and points against laddersas well ashaving a good spread of goal kickers is imperative for September success. So, here is some observations of how Division 4 looks after 7 games.

Lockleys and Pooraka sit atop the ladder with 6 wins from 7 games. The Bulls have proven to be the most potent forward line with a good spread of goal kicking options inside 50. They have kicked the most points in division 4 by quite some distance. In fact, they have kicked 87 points more than any other team in the competition and have averaged 123 points per game so far. What would be stressing coach Shane Hickey is the "points against" ladder. Pooraka sit 6th on that ladder, and this is not, historically the profile of a premiership team. The good news is they still have 11 minor round games to improve in this area and knowing the hard work and footballing smarts that Shane brings they will no doubt improve in this space.

Lockleys rely heavily on leading goal kicker Ben Haren (34 goals) for scoring. He is a full 10 goals in front of the rest of the competition and Lockleys next highest goal kicker is Adam Fazzalari on 13 goals. But this does not tell the full story. Lockleys are in fact the best defensive team in the competition and have averaged only 64 points against so far. A profile of second-best offense and best defense maps well for finals success.

CBCOC are also mapping well with a strong forward line that is led well by playing coach Brett Simpson, who is third on the goal kicking with a total of 23 and a strong defense who are second on the point against ladder. Worryingly for CBCOC their reserves are third to bottom and they will be hoping that depth doesn't become an issue as the run into the finals begins. The other teams at the pointy end of the table all have reserves squads that are competing well and this bodes well for them when depth is tested in the challenging, winter months.

At the other end of the table, it is difficult to see how Portland can work their way out of the difficult predicament they find themselves in. With out a win in the A grade and a reserves team that has a percentage of 3.7%, they will be needing an unprecedented turn around after the bye to get out of the relegation zone. The other two teams in the relegation zone (at the moment) are Mitcham and Walkerville. Interestingly both of their B grade teams are currently in the top 5. This suggests a good depth of talent, but they haven't gotten the results they would have liked so far in the A grade.

Its not really going out on a limb to suggest that Lockleys and Pooraka are currently the favourites to fight it out in the big dance in September. Plympton are the sleeping giant (for mine) and it wouldn't surprise if they made a charge in the second half of the year if they can get some continuity and consistency from their group.

Of course, injuries and form fluctuations play a huge part. For most teams it is the "who" of injuries as well as the "how many" that can dictate a team's September fate. Ben Haren is unquestionably favourite to win the leading goal kicking with a 10 goal gap to Walkersville's Adam Proud. Injuries could also play a part here. If both players remain fit they will undoubtedly continue to kick bags for their respective teams. In terms of the medal Bowen Hosking of Lockleys is the early favourite with club captains Daniel Fairbrother and Sean Kuerschner both performing exceptionally for their respective teams. It is also expected that Frank Timpano of Pooraka will poll well as he is an exceptional, eye catching player.

All in all, it will be an interesting watch now that the bye is in the rear-view mirror. Some wintery weather is generally accompanied by upsets in this middle part of the year. The jockeying for position will continue and it promises to be an exciting second half of the Division 4 year.






