

Gold Coast Suns v Adelaide Crows

TIO Stadium, NT - 3Jun 7.00PM (Saturday)

Crows to make it two in a row over rising Suns.

The Crows returned to their brilliant bestlast Sunday evening. Four solid quarters of football enabled the Crows to record a hard fought 17-point win over second placed Brisbane.

Despite the difficult conditions, the Crows had winners all over Adelaide Oval. I ak Rankine played his best game for the Crows. He scored 2 goals of his own and had 23 disposals. This is an outstanding return for the Crows' small forward. Some commentary experts ranked him as best on ground.

It really was the Rachelle and Rankine show across the half forward line for the Crows. Both players were dominant inside forward 50. They were ably supported by Riley Thilthorpe, Taylor Walker and Jake Soligo. The Crows defense was under extreme pressure all night. The Lions amassed 66 inside 50's which is well above their season average of 57. To restrict the lions to only 10 goals from those 66 entries, is a great reflection on how the team defense of Adelaide, work together to create turnovers, and apply pressure to opposition forwards.

Adelaide's disposal efficiency washeavily critici ed after their loss to the Bulldogs. Pleasingly, this was much better against the Lions with 70 percent of Adelaide's disposal hitting a target. Brisbane was restricted to just 63 percent. Luke Pedler was influential throughout the match. 



Central Districts have not played finals since 2017. Fortunately for Doggies fans, their club posts a genuine threat if they can make it to September as Centrals sit one spot outside the top 5, having won three games. This is set to eclipse last year s horror season, where the Dogs won only four matches. This success has largely been due to the Dogs attitude that they are never out of a game. For example, Centrals have lost disposals, disposal efficiency, tackles and scoring accuracy three out of the last four weeks. Yet, they have won inside 50's three out of the past four weeks. As a result, Centrals largest losing margin this season has been 26-points. This has been a major improvement as their biggest losing margin at the same time last year was 98-points. Coach, Paul Thomas' strength has largely come through his sides defence. In 2022 Centrals were ranked eighth in defence. This season they are ranked fourth. Through Kendall, Illes and Buechner, Centrals have been able to repel the ball out of their defensive half and transition it forward into the hands of Grace and Munn.

While Centrals have been ultra-competitive this season, Norwood have not. In 2022, Norwood won 12 matches in the home-and-away season, as well as the grand final. This season, Norwood have been dismal. They have not won a game and have an average losing margin of 33. Their strength last season was their defence (number one ranked team). This year, they are the second worst defensive team in the competition. Likewise, they were ranked fourth in offense last year, whereas they are now comfortably the worst offensive team. Fortunately, for premiership coach, Jade Rawlings, his side has progressively improved. In the last three weeks, Norwood's average losing margin has dropped to 14. In addition, the Redleg's have won clearances every week (in this period) and disposals, disposal efficiency and inside 50's two out of three weeks. However, Rawlings will be disappointed in his sides inability to apply elite pressure onto the opposition, as Norwood has had less tackles than their opponents for the past four games. This has meant opposition sides have been able to control the ball (Norwood have had less marks than the opposition every game this year) and therefore score, due to the lack of pressure (opposition sides have had a higher scoring accuracy than Norwood six out of the last seven matches).

If Norwood are to win this match, they will need to rectify their lack of pressure. Conversely, Centrals will have to uphold theirs. nfortunately for Dogs fans, I feel Norwood's continual improvement will see them hungry for an upset win. Having played in every final's series since 2016, the cliche *you cannot keep a champion team down for long* has never been truer. Round 8 of the SANFL heads down to Stratarama Stadium in Glenelg to host what is anticipated as the matchup of the round. The in-form Glenelg Tigers host the third place Adelaide Crows in a match that has all the makings of a classic, with the winner taking the reigns for number one contender to league leaders Sturt. After losing the opening game of the season, Glenelg have won six in a row to charge into second spot on the SANFL ladder to end round 7, while the Crows have a 5-2 record after dropping a game two weeks ago however sit third on the ladder. We have been ever so lucky with the amount of top three battles so far this season, this one may just be the best of the lot.

Glenelg had a strong and gutsy win last week against an eager Central District side, scraping across the line by 9 points come the final siren. Glenelg started strong taking a 3-point lead into the first break, mainly due to an inaccurate quarter from Centrals, finishing with one goal from their seven scoring shots. The second quarter indicated that there was a favoured end for scoring at the ground, with Centrals scoring two goals to Glenelg's one behind in the second, giving Glenelg a 8-point deficit heading into the main break. It only took 90 seconds to generate a response after halftime, with Lachlan Hosie kicking a goal to open the third quarter and bring Glenelg within two points early on, followed by two goals from young forward Matthew Coulthard to give the momentum to the Tigers. Two more goals for the quarter saw Glenelg surge to a 15-point lead heading into the final term, with Central District having the scoring end to finish the game. After a standoff to begin the guarter, Centrals eventually kicked the opening goal some eight minutes into the quarter to bring it to single digits, bringing a collective roar around Convenience Oval, before following it up with another just minutes later to leave the margin at three points with over half the quarter to play. While the Centrals fans were cheering on their boys, the Tigers fans were sitting on the edge of their seats chewing fingernails, fearing the game would soon slip out of their grasp. Enter the hero for the day, Matthew Coulthard. A handball from Liam McBean allowed Coulthard a clean snap at goal, sinking the hearts of Centrals fans as Glenelg fans rose from their seats. It was only halfway through the quarter however, the game was played between the 50 metre marks for the remainder, with not another scoring shot for the whole game, resulting in a season defining win for Glenelg, Matthew Coulthard finished with four goals from his eight disposals. Luke Partington led the team in disposals (36) and marks (8), in what was a strong performance across half-back. Matthew Snook was prolific in the midfield, collecting 27 disposals of his own while having 8 marks and 10 tackles to cap off an all-round performance.

Adelaide bounced back strong on the Friday Night stage after a close loss to Sturt two weeks ago, defeating a struggling Norwood outfit by 24 points. The first quarter was a tight contest with neither team recording a goal in the opening term, with the Crows winning the behind battle, leading 3-1 at quarter time. The struggle for the Crows continued into the second quarter, with a further five behinds being recorded to bring their total to 8 behinds for the half. Norwood however found their kicking boots in the second, kicking three goals straight to take a 5-point lead into halftime after the Crows recorded their first goal late in the quarter. After a rev up about their kicking, the Crows come out and opened the scoring with a major at the six-minute mark to get the side back on track. The Crows kicked two more majors for the quarter to record the only goals in the quarter and take a handy 13-point lead heading into the last term. All hope was knocked out of Norwood in the opening two minutes, with Lachie Gollant kicking a goal to open the quarter. If they had any slight glimmer of hope, it would all be lost by halfway through the quarter with two more Crows goals, extending the lead beyond five goals. Just minutes later, two quickfire Norwood goals saw some hope restored amongst fans around the stadium that the impossible may just be possible, but a late Sam Berry goal put the game to bed, with the Crows running away 24-point winners. Lachie Gollant had a big night, finishing with 21 disposals and 7 marks.

Although the winning margin was only eight points, North Adelaide controlled most key areas of the game, dominating possession 372-290and winning the clearances 36-28.


