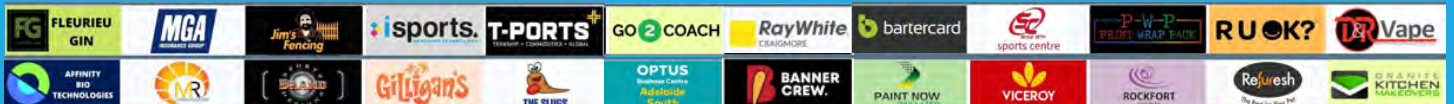

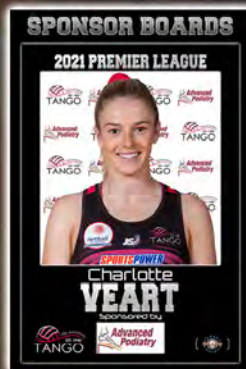

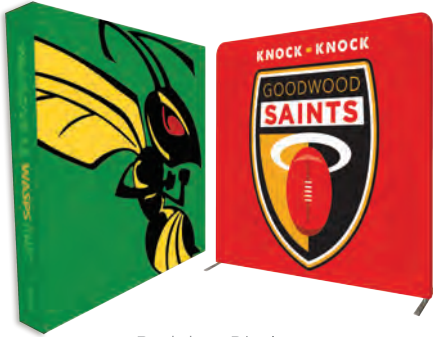

Football can be a very frustrating game to watch at times. The team you follow passionately is ahead on the scoreboard at all the brakes in play. Enter the last quarter with a comfortable 17-point lead and momentum. Within 10 minutes of game time, the lead has evaporated and suddenly, the realization you are going to lose sets in. It ensures your brain has many different emotions, sometimes all at once.

This was me on Saturday night. Whilst I knew the game would be close and high pressure, I was disappointed how the Crows lost their run from their back half, particularly after half time. I understand the ball was greasy, the number of fumbles and execution by hand was the worst I have seen all season from the Crows. This was partly conditions, but mostly the pressure applied by the Giants on the Adelaide ball carriers.

It felt that when Adelaide went inside forward fifty, it was a kamikaze entry devoid of system and structure, which allowed the Giants to withstand repeat entries and ensure the Crows were not able to score. Then on the transition play, the overlap run from the Giants was impressive to watch as their goals came easily.

The final quarter of five goals to the Giants was impressive to watch, Josh Kelly was excellent all night and suggested why he is a leader within the Giants midfield.

Uncharacteristically, Josh Rachele was not focused on winning the footy. For a young player in his second season to be checked so tightly by opposition players suggests you are a good player, and your opponent rates you highly. For Rachele to try and punch his Giants opponent was a lapse in concentration and focus. Rachele played angry all night and I felt he was distracted by doing what he does best, finding the footy, and make your opponent hurt on the scoreboard.

There is a spot in the top eight for the Crows. That door is still open even if it is now only ajar. They need to walk through that door, rather than just knock on it, and see if someone will let them in. The next fortnight will define the Crows season, Melbourne who are coming off an amazing victory over Brisbane, and a home Showdown in what will be the biggest game of the Crows season.

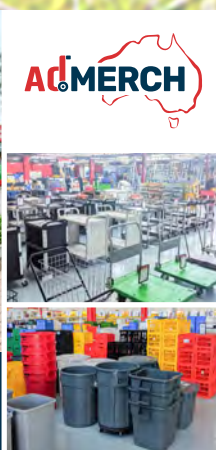

As the saying goes, bad kicking is bad football, and that was certainly the case for North Adelaide, as they recorded more scoring shots, more inside 50's and more clearances than their opponent, but could not convert the six points, as Port Adelaide were sharp and efficient with their forward entries.

The Roosters preferred a contested, handball game, moving the ball by hand but not gaining loads of ground, while the Magpies were happy to get the ball moving by foot, resulting in a 217-98 kick-to-handball ratio. As a result of this, they recorded 29 more marks than North Adelaide, controlling the ball a lot better than they have in previous weeks.

Riley Bonner was the standout for Port Adelaide, recording 32 disposals (28 kicks) and 15 marks, and he added 2 goals to complete arguably his best ever game at the club. Hugh Jackson (26 disposals, 3 goals, 7 tackles) and Cam Sutcliffe (28 disposals, 6 tackles, 5 rebound 50's) also added to Port Adelaide's weaponry. Nick Moore provided the grit for the Magpies, laying a game high 14 tackles, and fallen senior player Orazio Fantasia kicked 3 goals and had 4 clearances, making the most of his 9 disposals.

Aaron Young was outstanding for North Adelaide against his old club, amassing 26 disposals and kicking 3.3, doing everything he could to will his side to victory, while ruckman Mitchell Harvey (27 disposals, 10 clearances, 31 hitouts) was everywhere for the Roosters. The duo combined for 53 damaging disposals and 14 clearances but were short of help from their peers.

The win sees Port Adelaide steer a game clear of North and Centrals in fourth position with a positive 7-6 record, while the Roosters fell under .500 at 6-7 to join the Bulldogs, with percentage keeping their finals hopes alive.

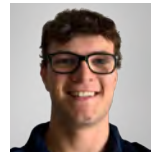

Saturday's contest between the Bulldogs and the Panthers will define both clubs' seasons, with South Adelaide vying to keep their season alive and Centrals sitting just percentage outside a finals position as we approach the pointy end of the season.

Following a thumping at the hands of Adelaide a fortnight ago, the Bulldogs responded in emphatic fashion, winning on the road against the Bloods on Saturday to keep their chances alive, especially after North Adelaide went down. Now, just 0.6% separates the Roosters and Bulldogs, and with North Adelaide hosting Norwood and a chance of an upset brewing, Centrals must take care of South this week and fifth spot is theirs. Contrastingly, South Adelaide's season seems all but done, with a 4-9 ledger keeping them two games outside the top five. Going without star Bryce Gibbs for a lengthy period hurt, but even since his return they have struggled to find some momentum, losing two on the trot to the Eagles and the Double Blues.

The Bulldogs earned their road win last week on the back of stoppage work, registering 40 more hit outs, 7 more clearances and 19 more inside 50's, working the ball forward and creating chances for their forwards to get the game on their terms. These wins will come a lot harder this week, as stoppage work has actually been South's biggest asset, albeit their losses. Whoever can win the contested game and get the ball out to their users, will win this game.

South Adelaide have lacked consistency up forward, an overbearing theme across their most recent two disappointing losses. Their leaders must step up and drag them over the line. The Bulldogs haven't been convincing of late, so an upset is certainly on the cards. The Panthers have actually won the clearance battle in their two losses in as many weeks and have got the ball forward and created as many chances as their opponents both times. They have just lacked that spark inside their 50 – converting goals has been a recurring issue, as highlighted by their 3.12 performance a fortnight ago against the Roosters.

What can they muster this week against finals aspirants Centrals? An upset win would only just keep their season alive, but other results would also need to go their way. 2023 is hanging by a thread for South Adelaide; the Bulldogs can put their season to bed with a home win on Saturday.

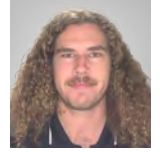

Hugh Jackson also had a standout game with 26 disposals, 7 tackles, 9 inside 50s, 6 clearances and 3 goals. Nick Moore brought the pressure all day, finishing with a game-high 14 tackles, along with 19 disposals. AFL listed player Orazio Fantasia put his hand up for a recall, having 3 goals from his 9 disposals.

Sturt also had a convincing win on the weekend against South Adelaide, who have been stuck down the bottom of the ladder all year. Sturt began the game in scintillating fashion, kicking the first two goals of the game before a quick reply from the Panthers. Sturt then kicked the next five goals in the quarter to run out with a huge seven goal quarter before Eamon Wilkinson kicked two quick goals at the end of the quarter to cut the margin to 24 points at the first break.

Following an 11-point win over Norwood in Round 13, the Eagles will need to produce another strong performance at home against a Crows side that defeated top of the table Glenelg last Saturday. Despite trailing by 13-points at quarter time in their match against the Redlegs, the Eagles fought back to level the scores at half time 4.5-29 to 4.5-29.

It was a massive win for the Adelaide who put an end to Glenelg's 11-game winning streak at Stratarama Stadium in Round 13. The Crows led at every change, with a five-goal third quarter setting up their 11.15-81 to 15.11-101 win. The Crows got off to a strong start through Lachlan Gollant who kicked two first quarter goals, with the Crows taking a 16-point lead into quarter time.

Round 9 was the last clash between these two sides earlier this season at Adelaide Oval, where the Crows ran out 23-point winners. The margin could have been a lot bigger as well if the Crows had kicked straight, registering 13.17 on the day to the Eagles 11.6.

End result aside, the Eagles trailed by just four-points at three quarter time of that clash before the Crows broke away in the last quarter, and the Eagles can take confidence from elements of that game and last weekend's win over Norwood.

A win to the Eagles could see them back inside the top five at the conclusion of Round 14, but it is a huge task against an in-form Adelaide side that seems to be hitting its straps at the right time of year. The Crows will be too strong for the Eagles on Sunday.
