Prince Alfred O vs Sacred Heart O

An incredible ripple has been shot through the competition as Sacred Heart O traveled to the cauldron that is Prince Alfred's home ground and taken potentially the biggest scalp of the season so far. Houghton v Mitchell Park

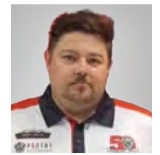

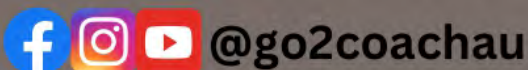
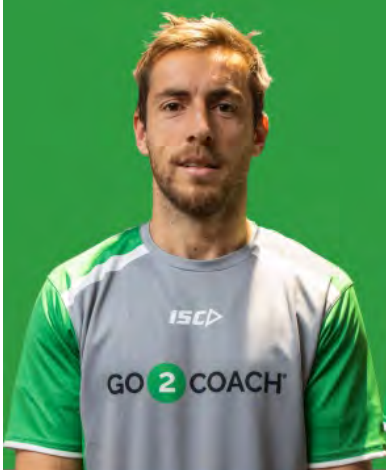
