In scenes reminiscent of a Gordon Ramsey restaurant, things are heating up... with three games remaining the finalists are not settled, nor is the much sought after top three spot. In a match crucial to determining these positions, Adelaide will make the commute to Johnstone Park to play West Adelaide this Sunday. This is expected to be a battle of two contrasting sides. They suffocated the Crows and therefore had more marks, disposals and better disposal efficiency than Adelaide.

Fortunately for Adelaide fans, their current style makes them incredibly difficult to beat, due to their effectiveness inside forward 50. As such, their current form suggests they will not lose.

After a scoreless first quarter for both sides, the Panthers kicked 3 goals to 2 in the second quarter to lead by 10 points at the main break, they would then kick a further 5.7 to the visitors 4.1 after half time to win by 22 points, 8.11 59 to 6.1 37. Jack Delean (10 disposals, 2 goals and four tackles), Zachery Sproule (9 disposals, 2 goals and five tackles), and Damon Freitag (9 disposals, 2 goals and five marks), were ruthless up forward for South Adelaide, combining for 6 of the 8 goals.

South's Oliver Davies was influential in the middle of the ground as he racked up 29 disposals, including six marks and 14 tackle, to be voted best afield. Eamon Wilkinson had a game-high 11 marks to go with his 15 possessions.

West Adelaide's Kobe Ryan had 25 disposals including a whopping 16 tackles and six clearances, Michael Mattingly had 21 disposals and 10 tackles while the usual suspects of Callum Park and Thomas Morrish were kept busy. With the defeat, West Adelaide fall to the bottom of the ladder sitting in 10th with a 3 and 12 record, one result behind Norwood, who are 9th with a 4 and 11 record. This match-up between Norwood and South Adelaide is a must win as the Redlegs could climb to 8th and sit equal with The Panthers at 5-11 if they were to leave victorious.

A win for South Adelaide will see them stay put but have a two-game buffer between themselves and Norwood. This match could easily go either way, but with emotions running high and this being played at the Parade, I can see Norwood winning, for a plethora of reasons but the main reason is for Nick Lowden.

Prediction: Norwood by 5 points.

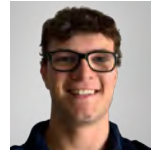

ROUND 15 REVIEW

South Adelaide 8.11 (59) def West Adelaide 6.1 (37)

In a low scoring affair, the Panthers kept an unrealistically small finals chance alive with a 22-point win at home over the Bloods on Sunday afternoon. A goal-less first term for both sides set the tone for the game – scrappy and tough – before Owen Mulady’s goal five minutes into the second term opened the account for West Adelaide. Ex-Giant Zachary Sproule evened things up just two minutes later and the floodgates had seemingly opened. Just fourteen goals combined for the match meant goals were hard to come by, and West Adelaide’s unwavering accuracy (6.1) kept the margin to a respectable final deficit.

South Adelaide recorded an astonishing 83 hitouts to West Adelaide’s 12, with Keegan Brooksby (59) and Damon Freitag (24) working in tandem to demolish the Bloods’ tall timber. This is where the game began to be won, as it led to first use of the footy for much of the day for the Panthers, who were happy to own possession of the ball (319 disposals to 246). However, just one inside 50 (39-38) separated the two sides, with South Adelaide converting scores at a higher percentage per inside 50.

Oliver Davis (29 disposals, 14 tackles, 5 clearances) was a standout for South Adelaide, while Kobe Mutch was integral for getting the ball forward out of stoppages all game long, making the most of his 19 disposals to register 9 clearances, 6 inside 50’s and a team-high 16 tackles. Sproule, Freitag and Jack Delean each kicked two goals to pace the Panthers’ attack. For West Adelaide, Kobe Ryan was the pick of the bunch with 25 touches, 16 tackles (equal game-high), 6 clearances and 4 inside 50’s, while Callum Park (19 disposals, 7 rebound 50’s) did his work on the defensive side of the footy for the Bloods. Jonathon Beech, former Crow, was the side’s only multiple goal kicker (2.0).

Both sides will head into a week off with mixed feelings. With the win, the Panthers sit two games outside the five with three rounds remaining and will believe there is a chance of finals footy, albeit needing a miracle to sneak past Central District for fifth, while West Adelaide are firmly entrenched in last place at the back end of 2023, with only pride to play for now.

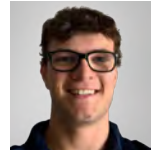

ROUND 16 PREVIEW: Woodville-West Torrens V North Adelaide

Round 16's clash between the Eagles and the Roosters can have massive implications on the standings with just two rounds remaining after this week. The hosts enter the clash two wins outside the five, needing to win their last three and hope for outside results to go their way to have a chance of sneaking in, whilst the visitors sit just percentage points outside the five with a 7-8 record, tied with Central District. With the Bulldogs versing Sturt, and a loss highly possible, North Adelaide must win on the road this week to cement their spot in the five, as a loss could derail their revenge season after coming runners up in 2022.

The Eagles have had an on-and-off last month of form, suffering large losses to the Magpies and Crows, while beating Norwood and leading for most of the game against Sturt last round before dropping off in the last quarter. Their best form can stack up against most clubs, and if they can find that for a full four quarters on Sunday, they are every chance of ruining the Roosters' finals aspirations for 2023.

North Adelaide have won three of their last five, with a narrow win in the grand final rematch against Norwood paired with an upset win over premiers Adelaide their highlights of the past month. Their top-end talent matches every top five side and then some, they just haven't been able to put it all together this year like they did last season, but their recent form suggests they're trending upwards at the right time. A road win this week will do wonders for their finals chances, especially with a tough fortnight (Centrals and Sturt) to follow. Their cut-throat clash with the Bulldogs next week could be the deciding game as to which club plays September footy.

Winning the footy hasn't been an issue for the Roosters', as they won that count against Glenelg last week but were dominated in the clearances and inside 50's, something they cannot allow against the Eagles. The likes of Campbell Coombe and Aaron Young will need to be at their clinical best to avoid a deficit in that area again. If they tighten up their stoppage work, there is no question they can get the job done this weekend. As for Woodville-West Torrens, they were beaten in almost every major area against Sturt, albeit the scoreboard looking as respectable as it did. They recorded 40 less disposals and subsequently lost the inside 50 count by 20, allowing Sturt to go inside 53 times, a number that North Adelaide would love at their disposal this week if given the opportunity. Based on recent form, the Roosters should make easy work of the Eagles' midfield and create ample opportunities for their forwards to tally a winning score, and set them up for a late run at finals footy this year.

Almost every game matters at this stage of the season, and this game is no different. Are the Roosters up for September action in 2023, or will the Eagles take North Adelaide down with them?

Sturt surpass Central District to continue September charge

Sturt heads to Elizabeth on Saturday to take on Central District, as the Double Blues look to remain in striking distance of top spot on the SANFL ladder heading in to finals.

With both sides resuming following a week off, Sturt will be looking to build on its 15-point win over Woodville-West Torrens in Round 15, whilst the Bulldogs are locked in a three-team scrap for the remaining two spots in the top five, following a five-point loss to Norwood at Coopers Stadium.

The Bulldogs mounted a late charge that saw them reduce a game-high margin of 17-points to under a goal within the final minutes, but fell short to lose 9.5-59 to 9.10-64. Gun midfielder Harry Grant was the standout performer for the Bulldogs, accumulating 32 disposals (eight tackles, eight clearances), whilst Aiden Grace and Jarrod Schiller were effective in hitting the scoreboard for two goals each. Lewis Cowham (six tackles) and Billy Iles (16 kicks, eight rebound 50s) were also influential with 19 disposals each. The Bulldogs led by six-points at quarter time but were aided by Norwood's inability to convert when going forward, as the Redlegs piled on six behinds to trail 3.0-18 to 1.6-12 at the first break.

The Redlegs responded to kick the only two goals of the second quarter through Ben Jarvis and Jacob Kennerley, with the Bulldogs only able to muster two rushed behinds, handing the Redlegs a five-point lead at half time.

A goal to Schiller saw the Bulldogs regain the lead early in the third quarter before three consecutive goals saw the Redlegs stretch their margin back out to 19-points. Shay Linke kicked the Bulldogs fifth goal of the day, as the Redlegs took a 10-point lead into three quarter time. Both sides exchanged goals at the beginning of the fourth quarter before successive Redlegs' goals helped push the margin out to a seemingly match-winning 17-points. Two late goals to Grace and Isaiah Dudley threatened to steal the game for the Bulldogs, but they weren't able to run over the top of the Redlegs, handing Central District its eighth loss of the season.

Sturt surpass Central District to continue September charge

Central District won the clearance battle 48-38 but weren't able to convert that to inside 50s, losing the inside 50 count 32-49.

Sturt kicked four goals in the last quarter to overcome an eight-point three quarter time deficit in its 10.15-75 to 9.6-60 victory over the Eagles last weekend. Captain James Battersby led the way for the Double Blues with 31 disposals alongside Josh Hone who was influential with three goals from 23 disposals. Tom Lewis (11 tackles) and Casey Voss (17 kicks) also had 23.

It was a strong start for the Eagles who kicked the first two goals of the game as Sturt struggled to make its mark on the scoreboard, registering five consecutive behinds before an opening goal came through Chad Reschke. A goal to Max Beattie handed the Eagles a nine-point lead at quarter time.

Both sides missed opportunities at the beginning of the second quarter before Josh Hone kicked the first of three unanswered goals for Sturt, pushing them out to a 10-point lead. The Eagles dominated the rest of the quarter however, kicking four consecutive goals, before a late goal to Sturt's Josh Rentsch brought the margin back to nine-points in the shadows of half time.

The opening ten minutes of the third quarter saw both sides unable to impact the scoreboard, with Sturt's Lachlan Burrows finally breaking the deadlock in the 13th minute, his goal trimming the Eagles margin back to one-point. A goal to Jimmy Toumpas steadied the Eagles before three quarter time, as they took an eight-point lead into the final change. Sturt had the first three scoring shots of the final term, including a goal to Steven Slimming before Will Pearce hit back for the Eagles, stretching their margin back out to six-points.

The Double Blues maintained their final quarter charge however, kicking the last three goals of game, with Josh Hone kicking the match-sealing goal, his third of the day. Despite only running away with the game late, Sturt dominated all key areas, winning disposals 313-273, clearances 36-28 and inside 50s 53-33. The win over Woodville-West Torrens saw Sturt remain at second spot on the SANFL ladder with twelve wins.

The last time these two sides met it was a three-point win to Sturt at Unley Oval in Round 4 of this season. The Double Blues kicked 10.15 in its Round 15 clash against the Eagles, and if they bring a similar intensity but convert their opportunities, they will be too strong for the Bulldogs.

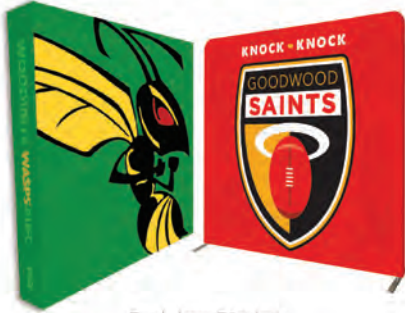

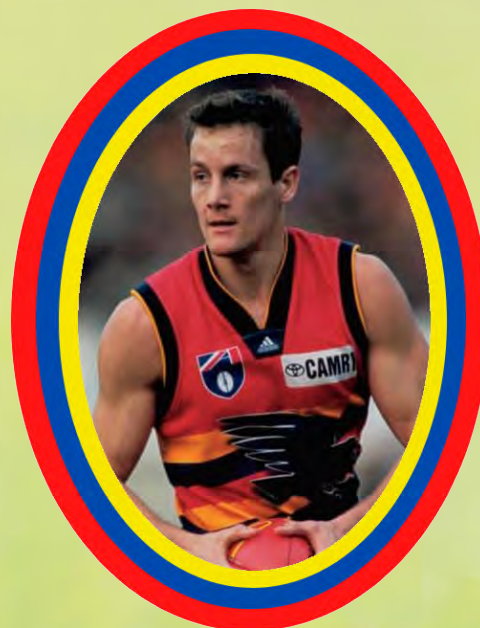

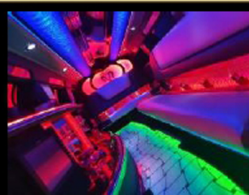
