Port Adelaide to book a finals berth for the first time since 2021 South Adelaide (5-11) v Port Adelaide (8-8)

South Adelaide return home to take on Port Adelaide as Round 17 action commences in the SANFL from Flinders University Stadium at the weekend. With both sides coming off of a loss last time out, against Norwood and Glenelg respectively, they would want to bounce back.

South Adelaide, who, at one point, were trailing by as much as 39-points early in the fourth quarter, kicked the final six goals of the match, only to fall short by two points in what was a very emotional day, as Norwood survived a late surge to claim their fifth victory of the season, winning 12.11 83 to 12.9 81, on a day where the reigning premiers honoured and remembered 2022 Premiership midfielder, Nick Lowden, who tragically took his own life two weeks ago after a long battle with depression.

South Adelaide, despite being down by 35-points at the half, came storming back, kicking 8 goals to 3 in the second half, including the last six of the game, to send a scare to the Norwood faithful. Ben Shillabeer and Zachery Sproule each booted three goals for the Panthers, while Oliver Davis had 31 possessions, 11 clearances and 7 tackles. Former AFL-listed, Sam Skinner had 13 possessions and a game-high 9 marks for the visitors.

Norwood Co-captain, Jacob Kennerley had 15 disposals and 10 tackles as well as kicking a goal, while the in-form, Nik Rokahr collected a game-high 32 disposals to go with 1 goal and five clearances.

Port Adelaide took on top-of-the-table, Glenelg, in the late game on Saturday afternoon at Alberton Oval, going down by 9 points in a 9.12 66 to 8.9 57 defeat.

Although it was not the Tigers best football, it was enough for them to move one step closer to claiming the minor premiership, as they go one game clear of 2nd-placed Sturt, with two rounds remaining.

Hot favourite for the Ken Farmer Medal, Lachlan Hosie, was everywhere at the weekend, picking up 17 possessions, including ten marks while kicking 2.4, had Hosie been able to kick straight, he would have claimed best afield honours.

Glenelg's Corey Lyons (28 disposals, seven marks and five tackles) and Darcy Bailey (21 and 4 tackles), were influential as always.

Port Adelaide's Jackson Mead (29 and 10 marks) and Nick Moore (3 goals) were workhorses for the hosts in the defeat.

For Port Adelaide, a victory would see them all but consolidate a spot in the finals if they were to defeat the Panthers. As for South Adelaide, with finals out of the equation, a victory here would see them gain some confidence heading into the 2024 SANFL season.

Prediction: Port Adelaide by 12 points.

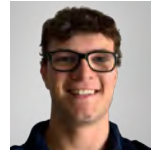

Despite having the same scoring shots, the Roosters came out victorious on the road on Sunday, fending off the Eagles by 15 points. The Eagles held a two-goal lead at the main break, before a third quarter Roosters explosion of six goals, backed up by a further four in the final term, sent Woodville-West Torrens packing.

North Adelaide controlled more of the possession (361-298) but weren't as effective out of the stoppages getting the ball forward, losing out on inside 50's and tying in clearances. Still, their experienced crop delivered when they needed to.

Ex-Power Sam Mayes led all players in disposals (29), adding two goals and eight clearances to a best-on-ground performance, while ex-Crow Harrison Wigg added 28 possessions and seven inside 50's. Dyson Hilder (4.0) and Noah Casalini (3.0) combined for seven majors to lead their attack.

Woodville-West Torrens would have been happy with their stoppage work, matching one of the league's best midfields in clearances and inside 50's, but they couldn't put it all together to find the goals more often than their opponent. Their first half was fantastic, but the third quarter is where it all unravelled for the home side.

Ex-Crow James Rowe had one of his best ball-winning games of the season, registering 27 touches, a goal, and eight clearances, while Adam D'Aloia had a very effective 17 disposals, recording six clearances and six inside 50's. Ex-Lion Connor Ballenden booted four majors to power the Eagles' attack, but it wasn't enough to salvage their second half collapse.

With Central District losing to Sturt and North winning, both sides are locked at a 7-8 record for fifth, with the Bulldogs just edging the Roosters out on percentage. The Eagles' slight finals hopes are now gone, sitting two games out with two to come.

Round 17 is full of big games with the potential to shake up the ladder, but perhaps none are bigger than the 2v3 clash on Saturday afternoon between the Double Blues and the Crows. It has been a successful season thus far for both sides, ramping up for a premiership tilt, and this could potentially be a finals preview. If the Crows (third) knock off Sturt (second), then Adelaide will jump into second with a round to play thanks to their huge percentage, so there is so much to play for this weekend.

Luckily for Sturt, the Crows have been hampered by injuries to their senior side over the past few weeks, meaning they have had to call on some of the established, integral members of this strong Adelaide SANFL side, leaving them weaker and without continuity. Sturt must take advantage of the weaker Crows side they will face this week, with a chance to lock in a top two spot up for grabs.

Since losing their top two ball winners in Matt Crouch and Harry Schoenberg to the senior side, where they have performed at a high enough level to sustain their place in the side for the foreseeable future, Adelaide have still had a strong midfield group consisting of Jackson Hately, Tyler Brown and Sam Berry – all littered with recent AFL exposure – among others. However, Sturt have boasted a talented, gritty midfield group of their own this year, led by Patrick Wilson (who missed last week), James Battersby and Tom Lewis. It will be fascinating to see the two powerhouse engine rooms go head-to-head on the weekend, with both groups not afraid to tackle and win the ball inside.

A fairly even contest in the middle looms, which brings the two forward lines into the game. Lachlan Gollant is in arguably career best form after his six goals straight on the weekend, while veteran Matthew Wright continues to find the goals for this surging Crows side, and the Sturt defence will be in overdrive all game to ensure those two don't break the game open with their goalkicking. At the other end, Joshua Hone – who kicked 3.5 last week – and Lachlan Burrows have led the Double Blues attack all year, and will need to match the Crows' pair, if not better them, if Sturt are to win this game. With the Crows defence stocks at a season low due to James Borlase and Mark Keane being brought up to the senior side in place of the injured Nick Murray and Jordon Butts, Sturt's forward line could have a day out.

It should be a cracking contest on Saturday afternoon, with the winners almost certain to claim that coveted second position come finals time.

The penultimate round of the SANFL home and away season has arrived, with the Woodville-West Torrens Eagles taking on Glenelg Tigers. This match is destined to have it all. 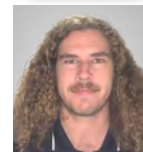

With their backs hard up against the wall, the Roosters managed to fight back with a strong response, kicking the next three goals of the game to keep it within arm's length. A second league goal to Jordan Lukac broke the run of goals for North Adelaide, before they then ended the quarter as strongly as they started it, kicking the last three goals of the term to cap off a 30-point turnaround and take a 10-point lead into the final break. With their backs now against the wall, Woodville knew a response was needed not only to stay in the game, but to stay in contention for finals.

As they left their huddles and got into position, it only took 27 seconds for Sam Mayes to put one through the big sticks and send a dagger through the hearts of the Woodville players and supporters. It was only early, but you got the feeling that the game was over just as quickly as the quarter began.

Dyson Hilder and Connor Ballenden exchanged goals for their respective sides, both kicking their fourth goals of the match. Woodville kicked two of the last three goals of the match, however it was too little too late as North Adelaide ran out eventual 15-point winners to hold onto 5th place and be a game clear in the top 5.

Connor Ballenden had 4 goals from his 11 disposals and Jordan Lukac had 2 goals from his 4 touches to be the only multiple goal scorers for Woodville.

Glenelg remain flag favourites after another victory on the road, this time at Alberton against Port Adelaide in a Saturday twilight fixture. Glenelg started the evening strong, kicking two of the first three goals of the match, before a run of behinds by both sides was broken by another Glenelg goal to end the quarter, giving them a 14-point buffer at the first break.

Port Adelaide started the second term strongly, kicking the opening goal within two minutes, before Glenelg kicked their only goal of the term not long after to keep the quarter at 1 goal each, leaving Glenelg with a 10-point margin heading into halftime. Glenelg come out after halftime and put their best foot forward early, kicking a goal within the opening two minutes, before Port Adelaide answered with one of their own not long after.

Glenelg then had plenty of opportunities to stretch the margin out however couldn't capitalise, before Port kicked another goal on the stroke of three-quarter time to cut the margin to 7 points heading into the final quarter.

Port knew they were in with a sniff in this crucial game and wanted to give Glenelg a run for their money. Glenelg however knew it was coming and come out prepared, kicking the opening two goals within two minutes to seemingly put the game to bed early. It was starting to look grim for port, until they answered with two goals of their own against the flow of play to cut the margin back to a single kick just before the halfway mark of the term.

Roosters finals redemption remains alive

A finals spot is up for grabs when North Adelaide hosts Central district at Prospect Oval on Saturday in Round 17 of the SANFL season. North Adelaide's dream for Grand Final redemption remains alive, following its 15-point win over Woodville-West Torrens last Sunday, whilst Central District will have to snap a two-game losing streak after being overrun by a fast-finishing Sturt to lose by four-points in Round 16.

A second half blitz of ten goals saw the Roosters overcome a 14-point deficit at half time in their clash against the Eagles, securing a 12.8-80 to 9.11-65 win. Sam Mayes starred for the Roosters, collecting 29 disposals along with two goals, whilst Harrison Wigg (28), Jack McCann (26), Campbell (23) and Mitchell Harvey (22) were also influential. Dyson Hilder kicked four goals to lead the Roosters in attack, alongside Noah Casalini who kicked three.

A tight first term saw the Eagles hold a one-point lead at quarter time, with Hilder and Eagles key forward Connor Ballenden kicking two goals each. Troy Menzel goaled one minute into the second term to hand the Eagles a seven-point margin, as goals became scarce, with Eagles star James Rowe kicking the second major of the term in the 18th minute.

It took the Roosters 23 minutes to record their first scoring shot of the term, a behind to Andrew Moore as they trailed 2.5-17 to 4.7-31 at the main break. Ballenden converted his third goal of the day within the first minute of the third term as the Eagles skipped to a then game-high 20-point margin, before three consecutive Roosters goals trimmed the deficit to a mere three-points. Following a goal to Eagle Jordan Lukac, the Roosters would own the remainder of the quarter, through majors to Keenan Ramsey and Aaron Young, before Casalini converted for his second goal to hand them a 10-point lead at the final change.

North Adelaide began the fourth quarter emphatically with a goal to Sam Mayes within the first 30 seconds, both sides would exchange three goals each for the remainder of the quarter as the Roosters recorded a crucial eighth win of the season. North Adelaide owned possession with 361-298 disposals, but was edged in inside 50s 45-39, the Roosters were more accurate from the same amount of scoring shots (20).

It's a poor time of year to be losing consecutive games and the Bulldogs must bounce back on Saturday following the disappointment of their nail-biting four-point loss to the Double Blues. The Bulldogs were seemingly safe 22 minutes into the final term last Saturday, holding a 20-point lead before Sturt staged a miraculous comeback to kick four goals in-a-row to steal a four-point win. Harry Grant had 31 disposals to lead all possession winners for the Bulldogs whilst Isaiah Dudley was pivotal up forward kicking three goals.

The first quarter saw a wasteful Sturt register five behinds before the Bulldogs kicked three goals in the space of five minutes, with Marcus Barreau, Shay Linke and Dudley all converting, handing the Bulldogs a 13-point at quarter time.

The Double Blues started the second term strongly with five consecutive scoring shots, with Lachlan Burrows kicking two goals, before Central District went on an inspired run to half time, kicking three unanswered goals through Tyson Richard, Jarrod Schiller and Kyle Presbury, leading by 18-points at half time. Sturt continued to waste opportunities at the beginning of the second half, kicking two behinds as Dudley kicked Central District's seventh goal of the day in the 17th minute.

Goals to Sturt's Chad Reschke and a third major to Burrows brought the Double Blues back within reach however, trailing by nine-points a three-quarter time. Back-to-back goals saw the Bulldogs drift out to a 22-point lead on the 14th minute mark of the fourth quarter. As the Double Blues failed to convert from their next three scoring shots the game looked all but lost, before a stunning turnaround saw them kick the last four goals of the game inside 10 minutes, dragging themselves over the line for a thrilling 8.14-62 to 9.4-58 win.

The Bulldogs lost the possession battle 281-319 and were edged in clearances 33-35. They were also comprehensively beaten in inside 50s 29-43, which led to Sturt having nine more scoring shots 22-13.

The remaining fixtures loom as elimination finals for both North Adelaide and Sturt, with both also facing tough opponents in Round 18 (Central District v Port Adelaide and North Adelaide v Sturt). Central District whilst only losing to second-placed Sturt by four-points, were also aided by Sturt's inaccuracy in front of goal, and could easily have lost by more.

North Adelaide will take one step closer to a September berth on Saturday with a win over Central District. **North Adelaide by 13-24 points**

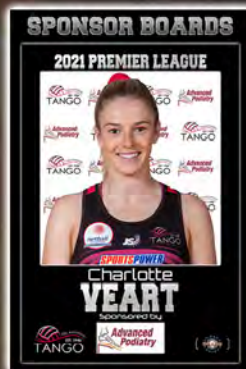

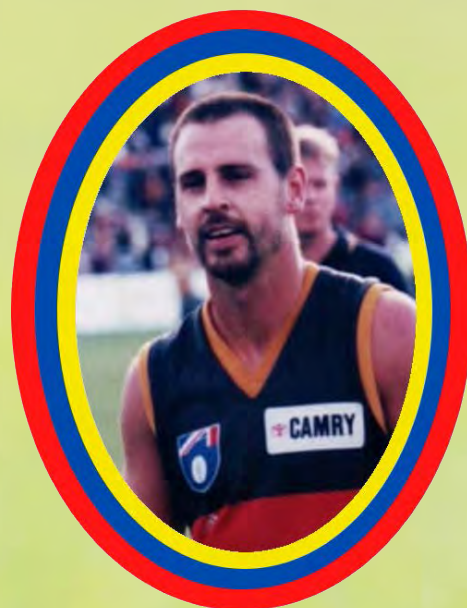

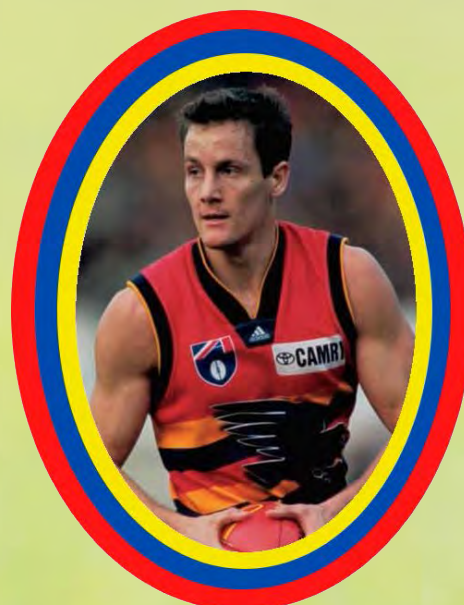
