

### 2023 Score Review System



Another week another score review controversy in the AFL. This week is arguably the worse error of them all, with Ben Keays being denied a crucial goal to not only cost Adelaide the game but also ended their finals hopes for this year.

The AFL has come out and admitted it was an error and stood down the umpire, but this will be little consolation for Adelaide and its fans.

It's been more than 10 years since the AFL brought in the review system and yet it still hasn't been able to get it quite right. Port fans are still smarting after the Josh Jenkins kick in the 2018 showdown was ruled a goal, and there were numerous occasions when the cameras were not in the best position for on the line touched calls. And of course, it was only last week when Christian Petracca's kick to win the game for Melbourne was deemed to be in conclusive after a review, leaving the score as a behind.

And now this decision has revealed perhaps the biggest hole in the system yet. That human error can not be overridden. As it stands a review is only called if the goal umpire asks for one. Even if everyone else can see the call is wrong, no one can say anything and the decision stands. Originally the call for a review system came because there were too many wrong decisions being made by umpires and there needed to be a away to correct this but in all the racket of getting clear outcomes on 50/50 decisions the AFL has let this slide. It could be argued that onus is on the umpire to use the system available, but the goal umpire said he felt confident in his decision and thus had no reason to go upstairs.

Of course, it's all well and good to point out that there's a problem, the more important thing is how to fix it. Previously the AFL has done quite well at responding when a controversy has occurred. Only one year after the Jenkins 'goal' the 'edge' technology was introduced to determine when a post had been hit and there are many more cameras now in place on the goal line.

One would hope that the AFL is already thinking about another overhaul next season when it comes to the borderline calls, but Gill's words of 'people understand that there are many mistakes during the course of the game' seems to suggest that this particular error will not result in changes.

### 2023 Score Review System (cont'd)



The reason why is obvious. Reviews slow down the game and that's not something anyone wants. Every goal is reviewed because there's the 30 seconds break while the ball goes back to the middle, if we had to have a 30 second break every time there was a behind the game would last 5 hours.

The rule was changed a few years ago so that players no longer had to wait for the flags to wave before taking a kick in for much success, and we don't want to go back on that rule, yet some failsafe needs to be introduced for scenarios such as these. We have one for goals, we need one for points.

Leigh Montagna and others have suggested that perhaps every behind should be reviewed as well, and simply allow play to continue while this happens. Then if it is decided that the score was a goal, play would stop and the ball returned to the centre for a ball up as per usual. Yet this comes fraught with risk.

What if the other team goes down the other end and kicks a goal while the review is being undertaken? What if a player becomes injured or concussed in that time? What about the all the other statistics, do they still count where the betting companies are concerned?

Play cannot continue if there is a review going on. Instead there needs to be some sort of power given to the ARC to stop play to have a review. Give a stipulation that the review call needs to be before play has cleared out of the 50 from the kick in or something similar, but it needs to happen. A team needing to retake a kick in, or having the kick in delayed, is less harmful than ruling a clear goal a point as proven this weekend.

One thing is clear, no Gill, the fans are not ok with the 'many mistakes' and it's time for a proper review system in the AFL, with rectification of human error, proper technology and conclusive outcomes.




