

Crows to finish the season with a win over big birds

West Coast

Sometimes in life you get what you deserve. Many a football and sporting coach will use this saying to highlight that over the course of a game or a season, there are many opportunities that haven't been taken, and the final wash up sees that generally, everything evens out at the end.

Whilst I broadly agree with this sentiment, you can't help but think that our officials that make important decisions during every match should be able to make the relatively easy call of weather the ball was a goal, or simply it wasn't. What I don't accept is that professional umpired who have access to technology, don't use it, to ensure the right decision is made.

I don't completely blame the goal umpire for the Ben Keys behind decision last Saturday night. Whilst the ARC wasn't used to review the decision, surely if they can see that the on-field decision was wrong, they can communicate with the field umpires, and advise them of the error, and the appropriate fix. Whilst I know that all goals are reviewed, clearly the behind was a goal, and the impact this has had not just on the result of the match, but the outcome of the Crows season, and that of other club's challenge for a finals berth, is significant.

The Crows should have kicked more accurately in that last quarter to put the result beyond doubt, I suggest the moment Luke Pedlar was substituted into the game, the Crows started winning contested ball particularly for the center square. The Crows themselves can reflect on where they can improve, but the officials need to ensure this never happens again. The ramifications are otherwise massive.

The Eagles have won three matches all season with a percentage of 52.5. 

Sturt's gritty midfield match up well with most midfields in the competition, but they will need to muster a herculean effort to keep up with the experience and skill of the likes of Crouch, Hately and co. One thing Sturt will have as an advantage will be Adelaide's lack of continuity in recent weeks, as several players have been in and out of the senior side. Will they be able to recapture their scintillating mid-season form, which included a big win over Sturt?

Burrows and Hone may be in for tough outings on Sunday, as the return of Borlase and Keane will make things difficult back there for the Double Blues forwards, while at the other end, Gollant has been causing headaches recently, while livewire Tariek Newchurch is always a handful to deal with. With Elliott Himmelberg out for the season, it releases a little bit of pressure down that end.

The ruck battle will be interesting, with Doyle coming off one of his better games for Sturt this year, but Kieran Strachan is AFL-calibre when it comes to his ruckwork, so it will be a massive test. All areas of the ground will be of great importance on Sunday, and although the Crows dealt with Sturt earlier in the season, this contest should be as close as it gets. The winner of this match should inevitably earn themselves a spot in the 2023 Grand Final with a double chance up their sleeve. Who wants it more?

The home and away season has come to an end and the first week of finals are locked in. The second term started with another Port Adelaide goal, before the Bulldogs proved that there was a preferred end for scoring, as they slotted the next three goals of the term to win the quarter and draw closer at the half, only trailing by 7 points.

The halftime break bought plenty of chatter amongst supporters, with both teams cemented in finals, the fire could have easily been taken out of the game. However, both coaches gave their speeches at the break in hope of firing their sides up in the fight for fourth place. The second half began with a bang, both Port Adelaide and Central Districts were scoring heavy in the third term combining for seven goals in the term. Port Adelaide started the quarter strongly, kicking the first three goals in the opening 10 minutes to jump out to a 25-point lead, putting the pressure back onto the Bulldogs to respond and stay in the contest. Central Districts did just that, kicking two quick goals to cut the margin back to 13 points, before a gaol to each side extended the margin at the final break to 15 points, leaving Central Districts with plenty of work to do to not only keep themselves in the contest, but to have any hope of recording a win in the final home and away game.

Again, Port Adelaide began the quarter with a goal to extend the margin to 21 points early, putting tremendous pressure on the Bulldogs to stay with the Magpies in the game. Needing a response, Central Districts found a goal through first year player Shay Linke, before Hugo Munn and Nick Lange kicked truly to both become multiple goal scorers for the game, while also cutting the margin back to 3 points, bringing life to the contest again. Nick Moore also put his talent on display heading into finals, amassing 20 disposals, 6 inside 50s and laying a game-high 9 tackles. Jase Burgoyne did his chances of being recalled no harm at all, finishing with 25 disposals and 6 rebound 50s. Jed Hagan kicked 3.2 up forward, while Orazio Fantasia continued his strong run of form kicking 2 goals of his own.

Looking forward to the elimination final, both teams have a real strong chance of advancing in this finals series. Port Adelaide used their run and carry through handball chains to their advantage on the weekend and really limited the defensive impact of Central District, especially early in the contest. When they didn't have the ball, Port also tackled well and limited the cleanliness of the Bulldogs in the first half. They finished with a +19-tackle count. However, the match can most certainly be won in the midfield. Central District dominated the stoppages on the weekend, winning clearances 34-24. They got their hands to the ball first and had first opportunity at the contest, and this went a long way to them winning the game in the final term.

Whatever the result, it is set to be a cracker at Adelaide Oval come Saturday afternoon.

Crows edge Double Blues in fierce battle

It's crunch time for Sturt and Adelaide as they face off in a Qualifying final at Adelaide Oval on Sunday. It comes only two weeks after their Round 17 encounter, which saw the Crows triumph by 16-points at Wigan Oval in Unley.

Finishing the season second and third on the SANFL ladder, both sides have had strong campaigns that have seen them remain in top three since Round 4, alongside minor premier Glenelg.

SUN 03 SEP 03:15 PM - Adelaide Oval

The Double Blues head in to Sunday's final off the back of a 27-point win over North Adelaide, whilst the Crows will be looking to rebound following a disappointing 19-point loss to Norwood last Saturday. Sturt had a plethora of contributors in its win over the Roosters, led by midfielder Tom Lewis who amassed 31 disposals, and Lachlan Burrows and Oliver Grivell who kicked three goals each. Defender Casey Voss also collected 24 disposals, including nine rebound 50s.

The Double Blues were comprehensively beaten in clearances, but won the possession battle 311-284, they were edged in inside 50s 41-44. Sturt controlled its game against North Adelaide from the outset, kicking the opening four goals of the game on its way to a 27-point lead at quarter time. The Double Blues continued to apply scoreboard pressure in the second term, kicking three of the next four goals to stretch their lead out to game-high 37-points, eventually taking a 31-point lead at the main break. The first two goals of the third term saw the Roosters begin to mount a mini revival, trimming the margin to 13-points before a steadying goal to Sturt's Amos Doyle ensured the Double Blues led by 19-points at three quarter time.

The fourth quarter began with both sides unable to hit the scoreboard in the opening five minutes, before Mitchell Harvey started a run of three consecutive goals to the Roosters, reducing Sturt's margin to just one-point. Two final term goals to Grivell proved crucial, as Sturt held its nerve, with four unanswered goals steering the Double Blues to the safety of a 15.10-100 to 11.7-73 win. It wasn't the ideal finish to the season for Adelaide, who were overrun by a spirited Norwood outfit at Coopers Stadium.

Luke Nankervis (31 disposals), Billy Dowling (28 disposals, 10 tackles) and Lachlan Sholl (26 disposals, two goals) were all strong performers for the Crows, who had a stranglehold on the game at three quarter time.

The Crows lost the disposal count 321-354, the clearances 27-36 but were still able to generate opportunities in their forward half with a 52-40 ascendency in inside 50s. The Redlegs burst out of the blocks with the opening three goals of the game, setting up a 15-point lead at quarter time. Three goals in-a-row to start the second term saw the Redlegs stretch out to a game-high 30-point margin, before two late goals to Crows' midfielders Jackson Hateley and Sholl reduced the gap to 17-points at the main break. An incredible third term saw the contest flipped on its head, with the Redlegs not registering a single scoring shot for the quarter, as the Crows piled on six goals from nine scoring opportunities to lead by 22-points at the end of the third term. Norwood's Ben Jarvis kickstarted a Redlegs' revival to begin the fourth quarter, as the Redlegs went on to kick seven unanswered goals to set up a see-sawing 19-point victory.

Adelaide's loss against the Redlegs snapped a six-game winning streak for the Crows, whilst Sturt's only loss in the past month of football came against the Crows.

Both sides are one win apiece in their head-to-head battles so far in 2023, with Sturt taking the points in the Round 6 clash at Wigan Oval, 10.6-66 to 8.8-56. The Double Blues and the Crows are two of only three sides to score a win against Glenelg in 2023, with the winner of Saturday's Qualifying final set to take on the Bays who wait in the second Semi-final. The loser will head to the first Semi-final, to take on the winner of the Elimination final, between Central District and Port Adelaide on Sunday. Adelaide will be boosted by the availability of a number of AFL-listed players, including rejuvenated midfielder Matt Crouch, who starred for the Crows in the closing rounds of the AFL season.

It looms as a massive Qualifying final and the ramifications are huge, with a victory providing a shot at Glenelg in the second Semi-final – win there and a spot in the Grand Final is secured. It's a tough one to predict, but the Crows should have too much firepower for the Double Blues, and take their first step toward a Grand Final appearance.






