

### **The Clemente Code**

### Will we see a flag or another Power outage?

As we see in every commencement of an AFL season, we see an emergence of favourites to claim the flag at seasons end. This has become a formality for all footy experts and enthusiasts, not just an activity to keep the punters enthused. A club that is always thrown into the pool of possibility is South Australia's own, Port Adelaide. Even though they have played a great brand of football and have an impressive list, they have always fallen short. Every new season puts past

woes behind, and it is an immense opportunity for a footy club to make their mark in the competition. The Power have once again been hailed as a potential contender to bring the flag back to South Australia, will we see this happen when the seasons draws to a close in September.

In 2020's COVID struck season, the Power finished strongly claiming the title of 'Minor Premiers' and it gave the Port Adelaide faithful a lot of optimism. It was for the Power to lose they the possibility of claiming their second AFL premiership in the palm of their hands, however; as we all know they suffered a gut-wrenching defeat to the hands of eventual premiers, Richmond at the Adelaide Oval in the preliminary final.

Even though the 2020 season came to a close of extreme disappointment for the Power, there is still a lot of optimism surrounding the club and their faithful. The Power are currently sitting in fifth position on the ladder after nine rounds and in what is looking like an extremely competitive top four, Port is within fingertip distance. With six victories and three defeats so far, the ladder position forecasts a fruitful season ahead for the men in teal.

However, the contents of their three defeats are extremely worrying for the Power and their large die-hard support base. Their defeats have been ay the hands at the Eagles in Perth, the Lions in Brisbane and most recently the Bulldogs at the Adelaide Oval which has been described as Port's fortress in recent seasons. These defeats are extremely concerning because they have occurred against three sides who are positioned in the top eight. The only victory they have attained against a top eight outfit was a two-point victory against the Tigers at the Adelaide Oval in round four who are still searching for stability in their premiership defence. In a recent story published by Fox Sports News in their aftermath of their Bulldogs defeat, they have been hailed as the 'great seducers'.

Why is this? Why have a club of favouritism for the flag potentially claimed this title? It is because the Power fail against sides of extreme quality even though they are a side of quality themselves, respectively. With a powerful, dominant midfield lead by Ollie Wines and Travis Boak, and a commanding defence lead by Darcy Byrne-Jones and Aliir Aliir; their contest against the Dogs highlighted their struggles offensively. When their power forward who was last seasons runner up to Coleman Medal, Charlie Dixon does not fire they struggle for goals. Dixon remained goalless against West Coast, Brisbane and Richmond and he scored a couple of constellation goals in the final term against the Bulldogs. Against quality top eight sides who possess sound structured defences; the Port Adelaide forward line struggles to apply the scoreboard pressure.

It is an open season as they all are, and we are still enduring the early stages. The Power thus far again shown that they fail to reply when their brand of football is found out. They have the season to work on it and to progress. The Power will be there competitively in September without a doubt, but will the flag return to Alberton? Let's just say that pigs can fly!

A dual Coleman medal winner, Leading goal kicker at West Coast Eagles an incredible 7 times. 3 time all Australian and Premiership player which is simply an amazing record of achievements in a stellar career. He has also to date kicked a total of 645 career goals in his career spanning 16 years.

Last Sunday against the Adelaide Crows again Kennedy put on a masterclass performance. He was simply too strong, too fast and too smart for his opponent and finished the game with three goals.

Josh Darling had and incredible 10 minute period in the second quarter when he kicked 5 goals and was the leading goal scorer for the day with 5.2. Three of the goals that Darling kicked were as a direct result of Kennedy skill off the ball through out maneuvering, and holding off not only his direct opponent but Darling's as well.


Kennedy is not a player who will win a Brownlow medal as full forwards rarely win the medal and when you are in a star studded forward line such as the West Coast Eagles the chance is even further reduced as the votes will get shared amongst the forwards.

Kennedy's value to the forward line is also shown through what occurred on Sunday with the Crows on several occasion when the ball was coming into the West Coast forward 50 having 3 defenders on him at any one time. This obviously some what reduces Kennedy impact on the game by physically being able to get his hands on the ball and contribute that way but it does allow Darling, Allen and Waterman far more freedom and room to operate in forward line. They did so very effectively with the trio kicking 11 goals between them on the day.

The very fact that Kennedy can draw multiple opponents for any marking contest in the forward 50 shows how much other clubs highly rate and respect his talent as when you have a forward line as potent as West Coast does that you use 2 defenders on Kennedy and let another champion forward be un guarded is a huge compliment to his playing ability.

Powerful, high marking forwards that put on a show regularly as All Australian Josh Kennedy did on the weekend is one of the major reasons West Coast get such good crowd numbers to their matches every week to see their Star in action.

He may well be getting on in years but the way he played on Sunday both as an individual performance and an unselfish team player you would expect this true Champion of the game to play on for several years to come.



## TEAM TALK with JORDAN

The AFL Grand Final is each year held at the iconic MCG which is short for the Melbourne

### Location, Location

Cricket Ground. The Stadium is a showpiece of not only Melbourne but of Australia and the world. The ground can hold just over a 100,000 people and when achieving that, it is a Colosseum like no other with the atmosphere and noise beyond overwhelming it's difficult to not have spine tingles knowing first-hand what it is like. For all the plaudits and success that the MCG has had for continuously hosting the Grand Final there has been and there still is an ongoing debate regarding equality and fairness of the location of the Grand Final since Melbourne is home to 10 out of the 18 AFL clubs and 6 out of those 10 clubs are permanent tenants of the MCG. There is the main reason being that the premiership decider should be shared around each year with the benefits being farer on the interstate teams that have to travel and to continue to cultivate the game outside of the Victorian heartland. Those on the other side of the fence point to tradition that the MCG has and always will be the home of the Grand Final. Outdated is the word that first comes to mind when hearing that it is a "tradition" yes, a VFL tradition to host the Grand Final not an AFL one.

Prior to the game going national in 1990, when local suburban grounds were still in regular use, the MCG made sense as a largely neutral ground with no team being a regular permanent tenant of the ground. Since the AFL went down the centralisation road which saw imbalance within the competition rise, playing the Grand Final at the MCG which as mentioned before is home to several Victorian based clubs is the single biggest hindrance on the 8 non-Victorian clubs in the AFL. Since 2003, just 5 interstate teams have claimed the premiership and 3 out of those 5 were against fellow non-Victorian teams. Seven Victorian teams to go with 4 more who play their home games elsewhere in Melbourne have claimed the other flags, some against teams who were not only interstaters but the higher ranked team. Did home ground advantage play a part in it? Absolutely 100% yes and should the higher ranked team host the Grand Final wherever they are based in Australia? Absolutely yes again.

One is example is Richmond who have arguably or unarguably been the best team in the competition for the past few seasons but their charges towards their 2017 and 2019 premierships make for much closer analysis than what was originally given. In 2017, the Tigers did not once leave the MCG and even unofficially hosted the qualifying final against Geelong even though the Cats were the higher ranked and the game really should have been played at Geelong's actual home ground (Kardinia Park) located in the city of Geelong located 75km south-west of Melbourne and also played host to and beat the higher ranked Adelaide in that year's Grand Final where home-ground advantage was a huge factor. Even more noteworthy is in 2019 where Richmond played at the MCG for 7 consecutive weeks and only leaving once thereafter to play Brisbane in the qualifying final in Brisbane which they won therefore heading straight back to the MCG on route to the flag. These outcomes and circumstances cannot go unnoticed, these things can't be simply brushed aside as a footnote, it must be brought to attention as a flaw and a huge inconsistency and fixturing within the AFL. The MCG has the contractual agreement to hold the Grand Final until 2057 which is a long time away... Too long. Come the year 2058 there must be change and the AFL will become a true national competition.

### Broadview 4.7 (31) def by Glenunga 8.8 (56)

In a low scoring affair, Glenunga kept their unbeaten streak alive, taking care of Broadview on the road by 25 points. #### North Haven v Flinders Park













#### Westminster v Portland

Westminster are back on the winners list after a triumphant 168-point thrashing of Portland at Glandore. The 29.18 192 to 3.6 24 win ends The Dragons 4-game skid and gives them their second victory of the season. Westminster flew out the gates early piling on seven goals in the opening quarter to lead by 38 points. Westminster then added a further three goals before halftime to extend their already massive lead out to 55 points. Portland managed to kick only one goal up to halftime. #### Plympton v Gaza

Previously winless Plympton had to come from behind twice to record their first victory of the season against Gaza at Plympton Oval. The Bulldogs trailed at both quarter-time and three-quarter time on their way to a momentous 11 point win, 12.19 91 to 11.14 80. Klemzig Oval is the venue for Gaza v North Haven when the two teams do battle with each other on Saturday. North Haven are coming off of a very impressive 6 goal







#### Pembroke OS v Morphettville Park



#### Kilburn v SMOSH West Lakes



second half and record their fourth victory of the season. Mitcham by 23 points.





### Flinders University vs Central United






