In a round full of close games, we were treated to a brilliant road upset by the Broadview Tigers on Saturday, as they took down the Phantoms by one point in a high scoring thriller. Pooraka v Eastern Park

Pooraka have swiftly ended Eastern Park's impressive run of form with a commanding 31-point at home. Pooraka cemented themselves as the Division's top team, pulling one win ahead of second-placed Kenilworth after their loss this weekend. Mitchell Park vs Brahma Lodge






