

Giant Season of Mystery and Intrigue

The 2021 season seems like an extreme roller coaster ride for all teams. Some soaring unexpectedly high and some falling to great lows.

Melbourne who have in recent seasons been the 9th placed specialist until the weekend sat comfortably it appeared on the top of the table undefeated and expected to easily dispense with the out of for and lowly ranked Adelaide Crows. However, Melbourne who don't have a great interstate travel record found the young Crows too good and suffered their first defeat of the season and in so doing breathed life back into the Crows season who are now only one win out the eight. Melbourne currently look like a top four side and the Adelaide Crows possibly can sneak into the 8. Time will tell if both these sides are 2021 genuine finals contenders or not.

Fremantle who have be very inconsistent this season proved far to good for Sydney who early in the season looked like a strong contender to finish in the top 4. Both teams are improving but their unpredictable performances would raise doubts on their finals prospects.

Port Power expected to be a premiership contender only narrowly defeated a out of form under maned and wooden spoon contender in Collingwood. With that performance and failure to beat any top 8 side so far this season it would be extremely unlikely as we approach the half way point of the season will do anything more in the final series than make up a number in the top 8.

West Coast Eagles having struggled to beat the Crows convincingly two weeks ago had their wings clipped by an ever improving Giants side on the weekend. The Giants who have been a bit inconsistent this season to date again showed glimmer of hope that if they can play a consistently for the remainder of the season as they did on the weekend they may feature in September.

Geelong well what can you say they were true to form against bottom ranked sides for the first half of the game and looked like yet again the Gold Coast would be them. However, in the third quarter they brushed aside the Gold Coast and cruised to a comfortable victory and signaled that they will be a threat in September. The gold coast yet again as in many matches this season have shown what poor recruiting can do as the young playing group let again ran out of steam against a more experienced opponent. If they could recruit an experience couple of midfielders in the end of season draft they may have some home to avoid competing for the wooden spoon again in 2022 as this year they are a definite chance to win the unwanted position.

Richmond well their list isn't getting any younger and they have been a power house club in recent seasons with multiple Premierships but after another defeat on the weekend maybe they need to look at rebuilding and regrouping for 2022 season as they would appear to be on a down hill slide that all teams unfortunately go threw after a period at the top.

Essendon were very impressive on the weekend and probably can sneak into the final eight and will greatly benefit from finals experience as they are a very young inexperienced but rapidly improving side. They would not however be expected to go very far into the finals this season as their young developing bodies as all young players do will start to fade out at the end of their first season at AFL level football. They look a serious contender for 2022 season.

The Western Bulldogs have been going well and had a huge win on the weekend but seriously any team that doesn't win by a margin similar to that or even greater against St Kilda is just a finals pretender and not a contender. Hawthorn and North Melbourne well they are in a competition this year with Collingwood and the Gold Coast to try to avoid the wooden spoon.

Brisbane is currently without their last season Brownlow Medalist in Lachie Neale. It has probably been a bonus for them as in the early part of the season they appeared to be to reliant on him and looking for him as a first and not necessarily the best option. Now they seem to be playing a very positive and effective style and look a genuine premiership contender. When Lachie Neale does return they will be a serious player in September

Ten rounds down and thirteen to go before the finals. The current top 8 nobody would have expected it to look anything like it does at the start of the season. There are sure to be more surprises to come as the teams improve and injuries take their toll. It would appear on exposed form so far this season that the puzzle of the predicting the final 8 and the Premiership winner of 2021 is anything but simple. However, the Giants with the return of Toby Green from injury later in the season it would be no surprise at all to see them win their first Premiership with their likely Grand Final opponent being the Brisbane Lions. Time will tell.

Costly Near Misses

The year 2005 was a new year for the crows, new coach, new system, essentially new everything. Gary Ayers had finished at the helm halfway through the 2004 season when he was told his contract would not be renewed for the following year. Neil Craig took over as caretaker for the remainder of the season and was then appointed as the next senior coach. The back-to-back premierships of 1997-1998 were long gone but weren't that long ago that they faded away into distant memory because there were Jordan Sennett Perez still a handful players left from those years such as Mark Ricciuto, Andrew McLeod, Simon Goodwin and Ben Hart just to name a few. 2005 saw Adelaide have their best home and away season in the history of the club, finishing 17–5 and winning the club's first ever minor premiership for finishing atop the ladder after the home-and-away season. The Crows had started promisingly after the disappointment of 2004 winning 4 of their first 6 matches, and gathered momentum as the season progressed, winning 10 matches in a row from rounds 13 to 22. The last of these was a stunning eight-point victory over premiership favourites West Coast at Subiaco Oval, in a match that saw them leapfrog the Eagles into top spot.

The Crows were brought crashing down to earth in their First Qualifying Final against fourth placed St Kilda at AAMI Stadium. In a tough, low-scoring contest Adelaide missed the leadership of captain Mark Ricciuto, suspended for striking Adam Selwood the previous week, and despite a late fightback they lost by 8 points. The loss set up a sudden death Semi Final against Port Adelaide, the reigning Premiers. The Crows regained Ricciuto, and in front of a crowd of 50,521 they defeated Port by a Showdown record margin of 83 points. As a result, Adelaide faced a Preliminary Final match against West Coast at Subiaco, where they had won just three weeks before. In another tough game in windy conditions, West Coast broke away with five goals to one in a decisive third quarter, and again a final-quarter comeback was in vain as the Eagles ended Adelaide's season, winning by 16 points. West Coast would then lose the Grand Final to Sydney the next week by just four points. Adelaide joined Essendon (1999) and Port Adelaide (2002) and 2003) as recent AFL minor premiers who had failed to make the Grand Final.

2006 saw the Crows start the season in dominant fashion. Narrow losses to West Coast in round 2 and Richmond in round 8 - the latter noted for Richmond's controversial but successful "keepings-off" tactics were the only blips in the radar as Adelaide stormed to a 14–2 win/loss record, with eight of those wins by 50 points or more. At this stage, their percentage of 172.38 was the best since West Coast in 1991. Adelaide then faded by losing 4 out of their next 6 matches but recovered and finished the season strongly to record 16 wins and 6 losses, thus finishing 2nd on the ladder only behind West Coast in first. They beat Fremantle comfortably at home in the qualifying final and would then face West Coast again in the preliminary final this time in Adelaide. Missing club stalwart and captain Mark Ricciuto to illness the Crows were still favoured to win and started brilliantly leading by 22 points at half-time. West Coast eventually clawed their way back largely due to their star-studded midfield led by Chris Judd, Ben Cousins, Daniel Kerr and Dean Cox and even led halfway through the last term before withstanding a late comeback to again break Adelaide hearts. The crows finishing their season disappointingly after promising so much. All in all, these two years/seasons in 2005 and 2006 was a massive chance missed for the Crows to secure their 3rd premiership. The club is still today looking to win that elusive third premiership. Whether it be bad luck, missing key players or just not turning up on the day, the Adelaide Crows have since their first two premierships seem to threaten without fully following and claiming another flag. 2017 saw the club finally make the grand final again only to go down to Richmond by 48 points. This premiership drought is an interesting and mysterious one that will continue to intrigue many people for years to come unless it is broken.

They may only sit third on the AFL ladder, still one and two games behind the Western Bulldogs and Melbourne respectively, but the Brisbane Lions are the in-form team of the competition. Seven wins in a row has more than made amends for their average 1-3 start to the season. The seven games has also come against quality opposition with Richmond, Port Adelaide and GWS all legitimate premiership contenders in 2021.

This Friday night, they meet the ladder-leading Demons in what promises to be a blockbuster match-up against the Demons this Friday, no matter where it will be played in this COVID-19 interrupted part of the season.

The Brisbane Lions are currently flying, with every part of the field well covered for. They boast one of the strongest midfields in the game, with Hugh McCluggage (25 possessions ave), Mitch Robinson (20 possessions ave), Jarryd Lyons (27 possessions ave) and Dayne Zorko (24 possessions ave) all wreaking havoc at the ball, then adding dual All-Australian and 2020 Brownlow Medallist Lachie Neale, who despite having injury and form issues in 2021, will be expected to return to full fitness comes the second half of the season, it's hard to see any midfield (including the Western Bulldogs) beating them in the middle. Their forward line is functioning superbly, currently the second highest scoring in the competition with 154 goals. The twin towers of Eric Hipwood and new-recruit Joe Daniher combining for 40 goals at the half-way point, along with another 30 between Charlie Cameron and Lincoln McCarthy. The options are aplenty for the Lions, and even if injuries in their forward-50 do occur, they have the likes of Thomas Berry, Keidan Coleman and Daniel McStay to fill the void. Their defence is also extremely tight, with Daniel Rich, Harris Andrews, Grant Birchall and Brandon Sarcevich in particular working well to concede under 85 points on seven occasions.

This is however, going to come with pressure as the Lions continue to roar into the second half of the season. Since coach Chris Fagan took the role ahead of the 2017 season, they won the wooden spoon in his first season, improved slightly to 15th in 2018 and then with the acquisition of key recruits, soared to second on the table in both 2019 and 2020. Unfortunately, though, they were unable to capitalise on home-ground advantage and lost three of four finals they have played in that time, all of which at the Gabba. With these previous two seasons of finals-failures, the pressure begins to mount. While there is certainly still plenty of time for the Lions to win a premiership, with Cameron Rayner (21), Eric Hipwood (23), Daniel McStay (25), Charlie Cameron

(26), Lincoln McCarthy (27) and Lachie Neale (28), who all still have many years left in them, the issue isn't age, more-so the mental pressure to perform. The Lions are almost in the exact same position they were at the halfway point in 2019 and 2020, in the top four and looking strong.

Will the semi and preliminary final defeats of '19 and '20 impact their ability to win a final? There are many occasions where clubs go through so-called 'periods of would-be dynasties'. 





Match Previews

Old Ignatians 15.14 (104) def Scotch 7.7 (49)

After their first win of the year last week, it was back to reality for the lowly Scotch as they were pumped by the home side Old Ignatians by 55 points. Although, it took the winning team a quarter to get going, as Scotch got out to an early 20-point lead at quarter time, looking to continue their winning ways. That was a short-lived lead, as by half time Old Ignatians had taken back the lead, before never losing it again en route to the big win. 




This week in Division 2







North Haven v Modbury
