



# Amato's 5th Quarter

### Sam Jacobs: The Most Underrated Ruckman Of The 2010s

Brodie Grundy, Dean Cox, Max Gawn, Nic Naitanui, Todd Goldstein... some of the finest ruckman we have seen in the past ten years. They all have Australian jumpers to their names and are sighted as being the best in the business. One name frequently left out of this mould however, is Sam 'Sauce' Jacobs.

Forever the team-man, Sauce played over 200 games for Carlton, Adelaide and GWS, won three showdown medals and was part of the All-Australian nominated squad of 40 on three occasions, but never truly received the recognition he deserved.

In this one-on-one chat, I sat down with the 203cm big-man as he took me through his career.

Sauce comes from a small coastal town, located on the eastern coast of the Yorke Peninsula. "Adrossan has a very small community. I had a very eventful upbringing, being in a small town my life revolved around sport; basketball and cricket in summer and football in winter."

Recruited by Carlton with pick one in the 2007 Rookie Draft, Jacobs spent four years at the Navy Blues and played alongside superstars Chris Judd, Eddie Betts and Bryce Gibbs. "I was very fortunate to spend four years at Carlton. I didn't know many people when I went over there, but over the four years I made a close group of friends. Four years is your typical working apprenticeship and that's what gave me the springboard to play some good football when I came home to South Australia."

After 2010, Sauce requested a trade back to South Australia. As the Crows farewelled several club legends, this opened an opportunity for the big man who instantly established himself as a regular in a struggling side. "2011 was good personally, I felt coming back home I was ready to play regular AFL football. Neil Craig was a very hard working, high standards coach and I really enjoyed that side of it. A lot of the stuff Craigy taught was bout resilience and he pushed us hard mentally and physically, I was very fortunate to have nine months with him."

The following year stands as one of the most underrated seasons in recent time, with Adelaide rising from 14th to a single kick away from a Grand Final. "When Sando came across, he instilled immediate belief and we all hung off every word he said because he came from Geelong who had been so successful. We had a lot of guys in the right demographic and in 2012 it just all came together. Unfortunately we didn't cash in on that team in the following years."

The 2012 Preliminary Final against Hawthorn was a tight affair, with Adelaide taking an unlikely lead with five minutes remaining, only to fall short to a star-studded Hawthorn team. "It was a special game with a lot of tense moments, when Stiffy kicked that goal the crowd went mad. But as soon as that siren goes, it's very disappointing."

Two seasons of disappointment would follow with the Crows missing the finals on both occasions before parting ways with Brenton Sanderson. Phil Walsh was appointed as senior coach for season 2015, but on



# Amato's 5th Quarter

#### Sam Jacobs: The Most Underrated Ruckman Of The 2010s

3 July, the darkest day in Adelaide Crows history struck with Walsh losing his life in the most tragic circumstances. "Walshy thought a lot differently to a lot of other coaches I had. I was at home, it was about 5:30 in the morning when Scott Camporeale called me and told me he'd passed away. It was just the raw emotion and trying to get your head around it was a really difficult thing to do. There were so many support mechanisms at the club and we all felt we could work through it together. A lot of credit must go to Scott Camporeale."

The 2017 season was a season of dominance for the Crows, who stormed their way to a Grand Final for the first time since 1998, but for Jacobs was remembered for losing his brother, Aaron. "It was a really challenging and emotional time. 2017 was my most eventful year to say the least, but to be at a football club and have the support was warming at the same time. It would have been nice to have won the Grand Final and dedicate it to my brother."

Adelaide were hot favourites in the 2017 Grand Final, but fell over at the final hurdle to an underdog Richmond outfit who were at the start of their dynasty. "When you run out on the ground, it's an absolute cauldron and a moment I will never forget. It's the pinnacle of our game and to be part of it, you just can't replicate."

"We started the game well, but still weren't playing the way we wanted. We went in at half time nine points down but it felt like we were nine goals down. The rooms were really flat and everyone was a bit shellshocked, there probably wasn't enough conversation. Richmond played the game on their terms and as we know now, they are one of the greatest teams of the modern era."

After the disappointment of the Grand Final, the much-spoken about pre-season camp took place and Jacobs believes it may have played part in the club's on-field demise of 2018-19. "No doubt the external noise with the camp had an affect own our performance. There was some positives to come out of it, but there was a lot of stuff I didn't feel was relevant to what we were doing. I don't feel anything bad towards the club because we had to get better, so we tried something different and it didn't work. I just see it as a missed opportunity with the team we had (2018-19), because although we were getting older we were still at the peak of our powers."

After the Crows had missed their final opportunity to win a premiership in 2019, the club began cutting ties with many players. Jacobs however, was one that chose to leave on his own accord. "It was my call, the Crows were looking to rebuild and Riley O'Brien was ready. GWS offered me two years and the Crows could only offer one, and most of that would have been in the SANFL."

After the COVID-19 impacted 2020 and unexpected fall from grace from GWS, who had come off a Grand Final the season prior to miss the eight, Jacobs knew it was time to call it a day. "I was very comfortable with the decision (to retire) and grateful I got to play at the highest level for 14 years. I'm working at the Crows now in an engagement role off the field, and hope to keep spending more time with my family which is a positive to."

There is more that one occasion when Gray has been in the unenviable position of lining up for goal when the final siren has sounded knowing that whether his team would win or loose the game depended on his kick. There is no player a team would rather have take the other the siren kick to win a match that Robbie Gray as he has done that now on more that one occasion to pull of remarkable victories for Port Power. This is a great testament to the his ability not only as a footballer but the manner in which he conducts himself when his team needs him the most.

Port Power v Crows showdowns have played 42 times and Gray has one the Showdown medal for best on ground no less that 5 times and 2 more than any other Showdown medal winner.

There is really only one thing missing from his outstanding career achievements and that is a Premiership medal and with the current form the Power is in by season end he could well be adding one to his already impressive medal collection. The thirty three year old is contracted until the end of the season but you would expect that it is merely a formality that he will play on for Port Power next season.

He is a great crowd draw card and every defenders who has the job of standing him worst nightmare. A truly outstanding player of AFL Football as he is one of those rare players that regardless of which team you support when you seem him in action you can be nothing but impressed by the way he plays.




#### Payneham NU vs Unley Mercedes Jets





## THE DIVISION 2 Match Previews

#### Old Ignatians 17.9 (111) def Henley 9.7 (61)

The Sharks continued to freefall on Saturday, losing dismally to the rising Old Ignatians by 50 points. With just eight points the difference at half time, the contest was set up to be a good one, but the home side kicked away drastically in the back end of this game, snagging eleven goals to four in the second half to blow the game open. Will Ferrari (5 votes, 3 goals) again was integral for the home side and is putting together quite the season, while Matthew Brunoli (6 votes) picked up his second straight best on ground honours for the winners. Jack Calabro was Henley's best, as the losing side now sees itself in fifth spot (5-1-4), two games behind fourth.

#### Athelstone 7.16 (58) def Scotch 6.9 (45)

It wasn't pretty, but a win is a win, and Athelstone will be relieved to have finally broken the drought for their third win of the season behind a 13-point win against Scotch at home on Saturday. Some accurate kicking from both sides helped set up a cracking contest, and it was the home side who drew level on the ladder with its competitors Plympton High & Camden and Old Ignatians at 7-3. After six goals in his last outing, Shaun Tapp added two more on the weekend and was named best afield for Sacred Heart, while Henry McAuliffe and Oscar Lovelock (3 goals each) were also instrumental. Henry Papatolis was the Phantoms' best, and this result sets up a photo finish for the finals spots leading into the back end of the season.

#### Salisbury North 19.14 (128) def Broadview 7.2 (44)

The Hawks continued their resurgence on the weekend with an 84-point drubbing off the plummeting Broadview, who are losing more hope each week of a potential finals berth. The home side were always in control from the first bounce opening up a four-goal lead at guarter time before that margin ballooned to just under fifty by the main break. Matthew Sharpe led all goal kickers with four majors, while the Wagner's - Brodie and Jake - were Salisbury North's best. Cooper O'Leary was the rare shining light for the Tigers, who sit in sixth place after their strong start to 2021 has fast disappeared.

Both teams started the year hot but have seriously fallen to the point where both teams may miss finals. The Raggies finally got back on the winners list last week and will be hoping for a similar result this week at home, but you would think the Sharks are too good to have the same number of losses as they do wins. I think Henley will regain their early form and make a bid for finals.

The top dogs are on the road this week, as Glenunga travels to Scotch to play the bottom feeders of the league. On paper, this looks like a typical big Rams' win, but the team sitting at 1-9 have been more competitive in the last month, and stranger things have happened. Still, I think Glenunga wins easily and moves to 10-1.

# THE DIVISION 3MatchPreviews

#### Modbury v Edwardstown

Modbury played host to Edwardstown at Modbury Sports Reserve over the weekend, soundly defeating them by 72 points in very wet conditions, 17.8 110 to 5.8 38. Modbury looked in control from the opening bounce, kicking the first goal of the match within the first minute. The Hawks were dominate all over the ground in the first quarter, having had the first six inside 50s before Edwardstown were able to kick their first goal. At quarter-time, Modbury had 19 inside 50s, but could only account for four goals as they failed to capitalise on their opportunities as they struggled to find a target when inside their attacking 50. Modbury continued to dominate both the clearances and the inside 50s in second quarter as they managed to rack up 31 inside 50s to 20 by halftime.
