Adelaide lacked. Intensity, intent, they have lost by far greater margins this year but at least on those occasions you could not question their intent throughout the game. However, Sunday game was different their appeared flat.

Carlton had several great performances on the day and Eddie Betts performance in the first half was a major influence on the result of the match. Watching the game it was hard to determine what defender for Adelaide was meant to be standing Betts as he seemed to have plenty of space to work in and move around the forward line basically unchecked.

Time and time again whether it was an Adelaide free kick or a kick in after a Carlton score they Adelaide player having the kick had very limited options to pass to as there was rarely an Adelaide player moving or making a lead they were more like statues fixed in place making it easy for the Carlton players to incept the pass.

Adelaide had three tall forwards and it could be said that they that combination didn't work and they they were too tall. However, when the deliver to the forward line was poor as they were more like half shots for goal and half an pass than a genuine attempt at either. There were lots of blind kicks and players trying to do too much rather than looking for the best team option.

Adelaide appeared to have no run, no system, they were out positioned and generally outplayed all over the ground. Carlton in the last 10 minutes of the second quarter owned the centre square as they turned on a goal blitz with very little pressure from the crows midfield they easily and quickly got the ball from the centre bounce to their forwards and scored far too easily.

Adelaide did have patches in the second half where they looked like they could have a chance but at boundary throw ins or bounces at stoppage if they did manage to win the tap there was rarely an Adelaide player at the fall of the ball.

It is one thing to have a bad day all teams do that but when it is lack of effort that beats you and not skill errors then there is a serious questions to be answered as to what went wrong and why

It would appear that Adelaide has a lot of work to do on team structure and playing effectively as a team before the weekend if they any hope of being competitive against Brisbane.



# TERM TALK with JORDAN

## The Apple Isle Bid

Australian rules football has been played in Tasmania as long as the mainland states with the first clubs formed in the early 1860s. The state hosted the national football carnival in 1924, 1947 and 1966. In 1960, the Tasmanian state side defeated a Victorian state side made up from some of the best players from the Victorian Football League.

On 24 June 1990, Tasmania's state team defeated the Victorian state team in front of a full house at North Hobart Oval fuelling the first calls for the state to house its own AFL team. Colin Alexander kicked 4 goals for Tasmania during the match. In 1991, Fitzroy played three games in Tasmania.

In 1992 Roger Curtis, then president of successful Tasmanian State League side Clarence, flagged the inevitable decline of Tasmanian football without the presence of its own AFL side. Curtis said that "The only way to get the kids playing football here is to give them access to the best product available and that, of course, is AFL football...You would have to call the side 'Tasmania' as fans simply won't follow a relocated side with its traditional name, even if it was Collingwood". In April 1994 the Tasmanian Sports Minister, Peter Hodgman, spoke to the AFL about the possible introduction of a local team to the league and had raised the possibility of state funding.

Between 1994 and 1997 the bid was prepared for a Tasmanian team that involved the construction of a 30,000-capacity stadium at the Hobart Showgrounds in Glenorchy, at the cost of approximately \$30 million. The AFL's continued rejection of the Tasmanian AFL team has raised significant controversy, with the Government of Australia launching a Senate inquiry in 2008 which AFL Commission CEO Andrew Demetriou and chairman Mike Fitzpatrick both declined to attend. At the enguiry, Tasmanian senator Kerry O'Brien brought into question the AFL's commitment to the game in Tasmania, and stated that he believed that with continued neglect, the popularity of soccer could overtake Australian rules football in Tasmania. There are already more children playing soccer than Australian rules football in Tasmania.

The AFL argued that the New South Wales based participation numbers were in excess of that in Tasmania, furthering their argument that a team in Western Sydney was a higher priority. The Senate enguiry found that insurmountable cultural barriers would make such a move non-viable. Several media commentators have strongly speculated that the AFL Tasmania as somewhat of a soft target for relocation of struggling clubs particularly for Melbourne. Clubs such as North Melbourne and Gold Coast in recent years have been flagged to relocate but this would be quite disrespectful to the footy mad state of Tasmania as they deserve their own team as they have been playing football for as long as anyone else in the country. With the recent Covid 19 crisis significantly affecting the AFL financially, new Tasmanian premier Peter Gutwein has adopted a noticeably more aggressive stance on the need for an AFL club based in Tasmania and has said that now is the best opportunity for the state to be granted a license and that will not only help the AFL monetary wise but further make the competition truly national. This is long overdue; Tasmania arguably should've had a team in the AFL ages ago but the AFL have continuously poured money into non-traditional football states to varying degrees of success. They must reward a state that is as footy mad as anyone with their own team, the time is now.

In the history of the Afl only 256 players have played 250 games or more for the one club and all on the list are some Great past and presents Champions of the game.



# THE DIVISION 2 Match Previews

#### Broadview 19.9 (123) def Old Ignatians 10.9 (69)

It was a bounce back of unforeseen proportions, as the Tigers were a completely different side on Saturday in a 54-point demolition of an in-form Old Ignatians squad. They were good on all fronts, kicking accurately as they got back on the winner's list, led by six multi-goalkickers and a best-on-ground performance by Christian lannella. Old Ignatians were rattled from the get-go, as Broadview came out the gates firing with a six-goal opening term, and from there the visitors could not catch them. Mathew Brunoli gave it all he could for the losing side, as he was Old Ignatians' best for a third straight week. The win gives Broadview hope, tying them up with Henley at 5-5, a game-and-a-half back from fourth spot.

#### Scotch 10.7 (67) def by Glenunga 12.10 (82)



## THE DIVISION 3 Match Previews

#### Edwardstown v CBC Old Collegians

CBC Old Collegians collected their 3rd consecutive victory and their 4th on the season after downing Edwardstown by 14 points at Edwardstown Oval on Saturday. The 10.9 69 to 8.7 55 result saw the Dolphins improve to 4 and 7 and sit equal with Westminster in 8th position and are now 1 game clear of avoiding relegation. CBC, leading at every change by 8, 16, 3 and 14, were too strong for the 'Towns' who fall to 5 and 6 after suffering their 6th defeat in their last 7 games and 2nd loss in succession. Daniel Alpin was as influential as ever for the visitors as his 2 goal performance was enough to earn him best on ground honours. Jonty Rutai and Michael Gabrielli booted 2 goals each for the Dolphins. Edwardstown's Joshua Holliday and Andrew Hyland combined for 6 of their side's 7 goals as they helped George Cornish to try and lead a 2nd half come-from-behind-victory against an 8th-placed side. George Cornish kicked 1 goal as his efforts around the ground did not go unnoticed as he was named his side's best player on the ground. Edwardstown, who began the season winning the first 4 matches in a row, have now only won once in their last 7 matches, with that victory coming against Portland 3 weeks ago. Edwardstown sit in 6th position, 1 win outside of the top 4, whereas CBC Old Collegians sit only 1 win outside of 6th.

#### North Haven v Westminster OS

North Haven bounce back from their shock loss to CBC last round to record a percentage-boosting 40 point victory against lowly Westminster at Largs North Reserve over the weekend. Golden Grove kicked 7 goals to none in the opening stanza to lead by 43 points at the first change. Plympton rallied hard in the second quarter however, kicking 6 goals to zero to trail by 8 points at the main break. Much like the first quarter, Golden Grove kicked 7 goals to 4 in the 'premiership quarter' to lead by 26 points at the final changeover. Judd Morris (four goals) and Michael Walters (six goals) were major key contributors for Golden Grove as they

Jake Pitman was everywhere all throughout the afternoon and as the match progressed, he got better and better earning the best on ground honours with his impressive 3 goal performance. Benjamin West, Wilson Otto and Lachlan Hampton kicked 2 goals each for Plympton who suffer their 8th defeat of the season and fall to 3 and 8 and are in a tight battle with both CBC and Westminster to avoid being relegated at the end of the season. Corey Cox was the best player on the field for the Bulldogs.

#### Gaza v Portland

A 7 goal to none opening quarter was all that was needed as Gaza took easy care of lowly Portland, belting them by 219 points at Klemzig Oval in Round 11. The 35.14 224 to 0.5 5 result was the biggest winning margin for the Eagles against any side this season and is the most goals kicked in a game in 2021, beating the Eagles previous record of 31.21 set in Round 2 against Portland. Gaza kicked 7 goals in the first quarter, 8 in the second and 10 each in the third and fourth guarters to set up the massive percentage-boosting victory. Todd Culley booted 10 goals, Benjamin Beioley, 7, Jackson Elmes, 6 and Damon Hill, 5 for Gaza, who now sit equal with Modbury on 6 wins and 5 losses but are 4th with a percentage of 64.7 after the massive victory. The win now means that Gaza are only 2 wins outside of the top 3, and with 4 of their remaining 7 games against teams fighting for a spot in the top 5, the Eagles will be looking to maintain some confidence and string together a few big wins in order to secure a spot in the top 4 over the next few weeks. Portland suffer their 11th consecutive defeat and their 9th of more than 100 points. #### Flinders Park v Modbury

The final match of Round 11 was played between 3rd-placed Flinders Park and 5th-placed Modbury on Saturday at Flinders Park. Modbury came away with their 6th victory of the season and 2nd in succession when they defeated Flinders Park by 19 points. The 12.11 83 to 9.8 62 result sees The Reds fall to 8 and 3, only 1 game behind 2nd-placed North Haven. The Hawks kicked 3 goals to 2 in the opening term to lead by 3 points at the first change, Flinders rallied back in the 2nd quarter, booting 4 goals to 2 to take a slim 5 point advantage into the sheds at the main break. Modbury responded well in the 2nd half, kicking 7 goals to 3 to set up the 19 point victory away from home. 2 goals each from Dylan Mclean and Dan Horsnell along with a 4 goal performance from Liam Verity proved to be more than enough for the visitors who set up a date with 4th placed Gaza at Modbury Sports Reserve in Round 12. Modbury's Samuel Taylor was pivotal in his sides victory as he was named the best player on the ground. Izak Richards and Bradley Young (3 goals each), combined for 6 of Flinders Parks' 9 goals as they suffer their 2nd loss in 3 weeks and fall out of the top 2, into 3rd. Jay Hansen, who has named best on ground, did all he could as he unsuccessfully tried to singlehandedly lead his team to yet another come-from-behind victory. Despite the defeat, The Reds are sitting comfortably inside the top 3 having been 3 games clear of 4th-placed Gaza.





#### Gepps Cross v Mitcham





## THE DIVISION 5 Match Previews

#### **Hectorville v Fitzroy**

Hectorville secured a 52-point win at home over Fitzroy; however, the Lions will take many positives out of the match. Hectorville stormed out to a three-goal lead in the first quarter but were pegged back in the second by a resilient Lions side. Unfortunately for Fitzroy, they were unable to sustain their level of play and began to fall behind in the second half. J. Goudman-Glasson bagged six for the Hounds, as he looks to chase down Pooraka's L. Buckby on the leading goalkicker's list. Goudman-Glasson's form continued alongside the likes of Z. Stephenson and J.
