



Who Will Be The Sixth 400-Gamer?

In what has been a difficult time for the game in the previous two weeks, with COVID-19 once again causing havoc on the AFL Season, it was a weekend of celebration for the great Shaun Burgoyne. On Saturday night, 'Silk' became the fifth player in the game's 163-year history to reach the 400-game milestone, and the first Indigenous player to notch the quadruple century.

For just five players to reach this incredible achievement in almost two centuries goes to show what is required; a strong work ethic, dedication, resilience and a hint of good luck with health and injury along the way.

There are many players currently in the league who are somewhat within striking distance of the 400 game mark. However, with form issues, injury concerns and the possibilities of game-time and/or positions on lists being compromised in the future due to rebuilding and money-saving, some are more likely than others.

I have identified three players who are the most likely to reach that elusive 400 game milestone;

1. David Mundy

Current Games Played: 347

Games Required: 53

For so long many out of Perth would barely give David Mundy a mention, but now the Victorian-born midfielder is certainly up there as one of the finest footballers to ever come out of a Western Australian club. From his first season in 2005, Mundy has held an unquestionable position in Fremantle's best 22 and has rarely disappointed. A best and fairest in 2010 and All Australian in 2015, and a selection in Fremantle's 2013 Grand Final are among his greatest achievements on field. At the age of 35, the former captain is playing as well as ever, averaging 25 possessions, five clearances and four tackles, all of which are considered above average for AFL standard. For David Mundy to reach 400 games, he would need to play majority of this season's remaining games at least two more full seasons, a final or two would help boost those games up. It seems far-fetched, but if he continues at the rate he is now... why couldn't he?

Only seven games away from over taking Matthew Pavlich's club record for most games played.

2. Joel Selwood

Current Games Played: 325 Games Remaining: 75

The captain of the Geelong Football Club has been the epitome of hard work, dedication, and an unbelievable success rate. Since debuting in 2007, where he won the NAB Rising Star award, he has played in five Grand

Finals, won four Premierships, three best and fairest awards, six All Australians and four times the most courageous player, he has also only ever missed the finals on one occasion in 2015. Only once in his fifteen seasons has he played less than 20 games a year, he has been able to escape serious injury for so much of his career and has never been dropped.

However, Selwood's courage to go back with the flight of the ball and unflinchingly dive into packs has resulted in concussions and head injuries. His biggest strength is also his biggest weakness, and this is the only concern in not reaching 400. With Geelong's premiership window wide-open for the next few seasons and with Selwood form still certainly apt to remain in the side, he would certainly be expected to at least get very close.

For Joel Selwood to reach 400 games, he would need to play until at least another three seasons, playing at least 20 games every campaign. By that stage he would be 36 years old, if he stays injury free and avoids anymore concussion issues, there is absolutely no reason it cannot happen.

3. Dustin Martin

Games Played: 258 Games Remaining: 142

This one may, but should not, come as a surprise. While Dustin Martin still has at least six seasons plus a few finals required to reach 400, he has proven to be one of the most consistent and durable players we have seen... possibly ever.

Since debuting for the Tigers in 2010, Martin has never played less than 20 games in a season. From round one 2010, he has always been one of Richmond's most important players and a main stay in the midfield. He has avoided injury through most of his career and become one of the greatest players in the game's history. Three premierships, three Norm Smith Medals and a Brownlow Medal put him in the elite category in every sense. Football is his life, he loves the game of there does not seem to be any obvious reason why he would give the game up until he exhausts everything he has, and he still has many years to come with a lengthy contract not expiring until 2024, which would be expected to be extended.

For Dustin Martin to reach 400 games, he would need to play until at least 2027. At this stage he would be 36 years of age and I cannot see any reason why this is an unrealistic prospect. He is arguable in career best form, tearing up the midfield with his strength, ability to shake players of and that powerful, penetrating kick.






Unley Mercedes Jets vs St Peters OC / 4.10-34 vs 14.16-100







Match Previews

Seaton 15.7 (97) def Broadview 12.10 (82)

Broadview's finals chances took a hit on Saturday as they were beaten by the Ramblers in a tight contest. A last quarter surge saw the home side take control of the match, winning their fourth game of the season while the Tigers dropped to 6-1-8. Brett Harland (5 goals, 5 votes) was instrumental as always up front, while Bradyn Wild continued his hot form with 4 votes. Jake Hodby (5 votes) and Callum Flanagan (3 goals) were Broadview's best in the losing effort. Scores were level at quarter time, before Broadview led by two at the main break, followed by a lead change with Seaton leading by three at three quarter time, showcasing just how close this match was.



Athelstone 11.5 (71) def by Old Ignatians 17.11 (113)

Old Ignatians have all but secured fourth spot on the ladder after a dominant second half display saw them win by 42 points on the weekend. With just five points in it at half time, the Raggies looked capable of completing the upset victory, before the visitors stormed ahead with an 11-goal second half en route to the win. On the other end of the spectrum, Athelstone's finals chances are slowly dwindling away by the game, and at 5-10, they cannot afford to lose another game. Matthew Brunoli (5 votes) and William Abbott (4 goals) were integral for the winning side.



Sacred Heart 12.14 (86) def Henley 5.15 (45)

Needing to win to jump a game clear into finals contention, Henley failed miserably on the road, managing just five goals as the home side Sacred Heart moved into second position on the ladder with the commanding 41-point win. Henley were in it early, leading at quarter time and half time, before the visiting Sharks were run over in the second half, conceding nine goals while kicking just two themselves. Accuracy also proved an issue for Henley, as they squandered multiple opportunities in front of goal to finish with a dismal 5.15 score line, and at 6-1-8, they are equal with Broadview for fifth spot with just a few weeks left.



Salisbury North 14.18 (102) def Scotch 11.9 (75)

In a statement game for the Hawks, they proved they are still in the running for finals footy with a 27-point win over the bottom-placed Scotch. At home, Salisbury North enjoyed the eventual comfortable win, though they were pressed early and found themselves trailing at quarter time, and only led by two at the final change. Domenico Costanzo (5 votes, 1 goal) was named best afield for the victors, while Jack McCafferty booted four majors for the Hawks. Usual culprit Max Marslen kicked four goals for Scotch to take his season tally to 37 goals in 10 games, while Louis Heard was the losing side's best.

In the battle of the titans, Glenunga flexed their muscles and proved they are the best team in the competition - and by some margin too. The Rams were dominant from the first bounce, jumping out to a 37-point half time lead while keeping the Phantoms to just nine points, before cruising to the win at home by 54 points. Lincoln Bennett (5 votes, 3 goals), Michael McMahon (4 votes, 3 goals) and Michael Wundke (2 votes, 4 goals) all played key roles in the win, which sees Glenunga sit four games clear on top and unable to lose top spot heading into finals, an important advantage come September. 






Woodville South v Pulteney

Morphettville Park by 71 points.






Walkerville v Hope Halley





West Croydon v Salisbury



Fitzrov v Pooraka

As expected, the Pooraka forwards had a field day, booting a total of 180 to defeat Fitzroy by a margin of 153 points. The result was certainly expected, but the effort from Fitzroy wasn't.
