DIVISION 1 REVIEWS AND PREVIEWS

St Peters 13.11 (89) def by Tea Tree Gully 17.10 (112)

In the battle of the two unbeaten teams, it was the visiting Tea Tree Gully that flexed their muscles and took a stronghold on the top position with a 23-point win. The Gullies led at all changes and were fairly accurate in front of goals, putting together a complete road performance. Tyler West booted five for the winning side, while Brodie Latham and Matthew Stent were also vital. Jock McLeay (4 goals) and James Duncan were St Peters' best.



Old Ignatians 13.9 (87) def Goodwood 9.9 (63)

Old Ignatians recorded their first win of the season on Saturday, taking care of Goodwood at home by 24 points. Bradley Jones' 4 goals helped assist the drought-breaking win, as it sees the home side join the pack on the ladder after three games. Trailing by 14 at half time, the home side flipped the game on its head in the third, kicking seven goals to one in the third to break the game open. Will Abbott and Brayden de Prinse were among Old Ignatians' best, while Goodwood, who were led by Lou Whitelock and Ben Holzbauer, will be disappointed with their second half collapse, and will look to bounce back next week.



Port District 9.11 (65) def Prince Alfred 6.7 (43)

The second win of the season for either side was up for grabs, and the home side took it with both hands as Port District beat Prince Alfred by a healthy 22 points. They overcame a slow first half where they kicked just one goal, before piling on eight of their nine total goals in the second half to secure the home win. If it weren't for inaccuracy, this contest would have been over sooner, but the home side could not convert until the last quarter where they kicked four straight. Jason Nyskohus and Sam Gray led the charge for the winning team, while Sam Buckham and Adam Perryman were the best in a losing effort.



Brighton 11.9 (75) def Payneham 4.14 (38)

As the saying goes, bad kicking is bad football, and that was the case on Saturday for Payneham as they missed several opportunities en route to a 37-point road loss at the hands of Brighton. With the game in the balance, Payneham kicked 1.7 in the final quarter as the Bombers kept their distance. Brighton used a five goal to zero second term to obtain the breathing room, a lead that was never really challenged due to the visitors' poor accuracy. The home side shared their goalkickers, but Justin Evans was best afield, while Payneham had just the three goalkickers for their four goals. It was Brighton's second win from three games, placing them equal second, while Payneham have won just one of three, needing a bounce back win next week to get their season back on track.



Rostrevor 6.9 (45) def by Glenunga 15.14 (104)

Glenunga got their season kickstarted in emphatic fashion on the weekend, demoralizing a winless Rostrevor outfit on their home turf by 59 points. It was the road side's first victory of 2022, one that hopefully builds some momentum going forward, while the home side's third consecutive loss sees their season look bleak already. The game was tightly contested in the first half, with just eleven points separating the two sides, but six unanswered third term majors opened the floodgates, and Rostrevor were never able to recover. Michael McMahon booted four goals and was subsequently named best afield, while Daniel McCallum was the lone bright spot for a struggling Rostrevor side.

Payneham v Old Ignatians

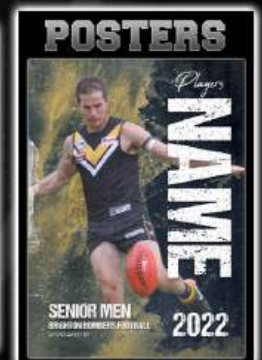

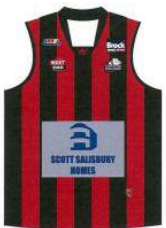

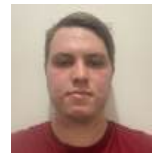
