

DIVISION 1 REVIEWS AND PREVIEWS

Glenunga 11.6 (72) def Tea Tree Gully 8.9 (57)

Tea Tree Gully suffered their second loss on the trot after starting 3-0, going down to a resurgent Glenunga outfit on Saturday by 15 points. The Gullies started the game accurately, kicking five goals before a miss, but after half time they managed just three goals with nine behinds as the home side held on. The Rams can perhaps thank their lucky stars Tea Tree Gully were inaccurate, otherwise their 16-point half time lead might have been cut into. Zac Smith and Nicholas Egarr were pivotal in the Glenunga win, their third straight which puts them equal first on points, while Zak and Alex McKay were both among the visitors' best.

Port District 10.12 (72) def Payneham 4.4 (28)

The home side used a dominant second half performance to clean up their opponent Payneham on the weekend, winning comfortably by 44 points to claim top spot by percentage. It was a slow, inaccurate start for Port District, leading by just five with a 3.6 score line at the main break, but a 7.6 to 1.3 second half put the game to rest quickly. Gavin Shephard (3 goals) and Sam Gray were instrumental for the ladder leaders, while Payneham, who are one of two teams left on just one win, were led by Harrison Viney, who kicked three of their four goals, and Jack O'Leary.

St Peters 9.10 (64) def by Goodwood 12.14 (86)

A big upset took place at St Peters College on Saturday afternoon, with the visiting Goodwood Saints outplaying the in-form St Peters in a commanding 22-point victory. Kyle Kirk was best afield for the Saints, who like five other teams moved to 3-2, equal top, after five rounds. The visitors led at every change and could have stretched the margin further if they converted in front of goal, as the once ladder leading St Peters squad have been brought down to earth at 3-2. Jake Sutcliffe was the home side's best amidst the loss.

Rostrevor 11.15 (81) def Prince Alfred 9.7 (61)

Like many teams after five rounds, Rostrevor are starting to find their groove in 2022 and moved to a positive win-loss record to join their peers atop the ladder, after taking care of Prince Alfred at home. The 20-point win was bolstered mostly by a seven goal second half where they outscored the visitors 50-15, after Prince Alfred led by as much as 15 at half time. Lewis McCormack booted three majors for the winning side, with Tim Baccanello and Matthew Dnistriansky also strong performers. Prince Alfred are dwindling at the bottom with a 1-4 record and their chances at finals footy are slipping by the week.

Brighton 7.13 (55) def by Old Ignatians 10.11 (71)

It was a big game for both sides with a chance to level the pack with three wins, and the visiting Old Ignatians took it with both hands, stealing a win on the road by 16 points against an inconsistent Brighton side. The Bombers took a quarter to wake up, going scoreless until quarter time, before they kicked into gear with ten scoring shots in the second term. It was too little, too late by then, as the away side was able to fend off any runs the Bombers could produce to hold the lead. Brayden De Prinse is always in the game notes for Old Ignatians and again was among his side's best, while Blake Higgins led the charge in a losing effort.



Broadview v Unley Mercedes Jets

Broadview have moved to 5-0 on the season, defeating the Unley Mercedes Jets by 61 points at Broadview Oval. 





Gepps Cross 8.15 (63) def by Lockleys 14.14 (98)
