ROUND 9

Brighton 8.11 (59) def St Peters 4.10 (34)

In a massive upset, the Bombers defeated the top placed St Peters by 25 points to register their third win of the season. Alarmingly, it took the visitors until the fourth quarter to kick a goal, managing just ten behinds until three quarter time, while by that point Brighton had kicked eight majors of their own. A four goal to zero last quarter by St Peters made the end result seem better than it was, but in all this was a good old fashioned reality check for the ladder leaders. Nigel Osborn was best on ground for the Bombers, and they will be hoping to kickstart their season with this upset victory.

Rostrevor 5.5 (35) def by Port District 12.10 (82)

The fast-starting Rostrevor ran out of legs in the second half, as the visiting Port District ran over the top of the home side to win by 47 points. Rostrevor got out to an eleven point quarter-time lead, but that was quickly evaporated as Port District dominated from there on out. They outscored the home side eleven goals to two after quarter time to run away with the win, leaving them third on the ladder after nine rounds. Tom Gray booted six goals for the winners, while Sam of the same namesake was also pivotal.

Glenunga 8.9 (57) def Old Ignatians 7.14 (56)

The Rams held on in an absolute nailbiter to win by one point against an inaccurate Old Ignatians side on Saturday to re-enter the top four. This game was tight the whole way through, with six points the largest quarter break deficit. The visitors led by six points at the final change and looked primed to cause the upset, but a six behind last quarter cost them this match as Glenunga kicked two goals to steal the win. Jack Matchett and Michael McMahon were the Rams' best in the vital win.

Tea Tree Gully 11.13 (79) def by Payneham 12.9 (81)

The bottom placed Payneham have completed perhaps the biggest upset of the season, holding on after a furious second-half comeback by the home side Tea Tree Gully to win by two points. The game seemed over by half time, with the Magpies cruising to a 31-point half-time lead, but the Gullies weren't going away easily, mounting a massive fight back that fell just short as Payneham scraped through for their second win of the year. This will surely lift the spirits at Payneham's camp, as they have struggled mightily this season, while oppositely the Gullies confidence has been shattered. After starting the season on fire, Tea Tree Gully now sit in fifth place, while Ethan Haylock (5 votes) and the Magpies finally have something to cheer about.

Prince Alfred 7.10 (52) def by Goodwood 12.9 (81)

The Goodwood Saints broke away late on Saturday to win comfortably on the road, claiming outright top spot after nine rounds. The 29-point win was aided by a four goal to one last term after the game was within reach for the home side still at three quarter time. With just three wins on the season, Prince Alfred desperately needed a victory here to get them back on track, but the Saints proved far too good once again and are suddenly a real contender to win it all come September. Goodwood shared their goalkickers nicely, while Reece Slape and Nick Favretto were among their best performed.

ROUND 10

Prince Alfred v Payneham

This lower-end matchup sees Prince Alfred (3-6) host Payneham (2-7) in round ten, with the potential for this match to go either way. The long weekend will give both sides a chance for a break, after mixed results in round nine saw Prince Alfred lose to the ladder leading Goodwood and Payneham upsetting Tea Tree Gully by two points in an epic win. At home, Prince Alfred will probably be the favourite, but going off last week, the Magpies are every chance of stealing a road win again.

Goodwood v Brighton

First placed Goodwood will enjoy a home game in round ten after winning on the road last round. A game clear on top, the 7-2 Saints have claimed a stronghold on a finals spot, and it will take a lot to upset that momentum now. Although the Bombers were very good in round nine, upsetting St Peters at home, I cannot see them repeating that feat against a well-oiled Goodwood side.

Old Ignatians v Tea Tree Gully

With both sides coming off a loss, the long weekend break might be the best-case scenario for the two clubs. Old Ignatians were heartbroken by Glenunga in a one-point loss, while the Gullies were outplayed at home by the bottom placed Magpies, so a win in round ten would do wonders for both sides' confidence as they slowly start to slip away from finals contention.

Glenunga v Port District

The Rams escaped at home with a one-point win against Old Ignatians last round and will host for the second straight week. Their opponent in round ten, however, is a much stronger outfit in Port District, who were clinical in their round nine victory against Rostrevor and will be looking to pick up another win to stamp their mark in the top four. At home, the Rams are every chance, but I think Port District are too strong at the moment.

Rostrevor v St Peters

The last matchup of round ten sees the two worst performing sides from round nine battle it out. Rostrevor kicked just five goals while St Peters managed just four in their respective losses, so a long weekend break will hopefully replenish both sides' momentum. St Peters are a chance to reclaim top spot with a win and a Goodwood loss, so they will be playing with a chip on their shoulder, while Rostrevor must win to stay in touch with finals. Lots to play for in this one.

Reviews

Westminster OS v Golden Grove







Pembroke OS 19.15-129 def Pooraka 9.12-66


