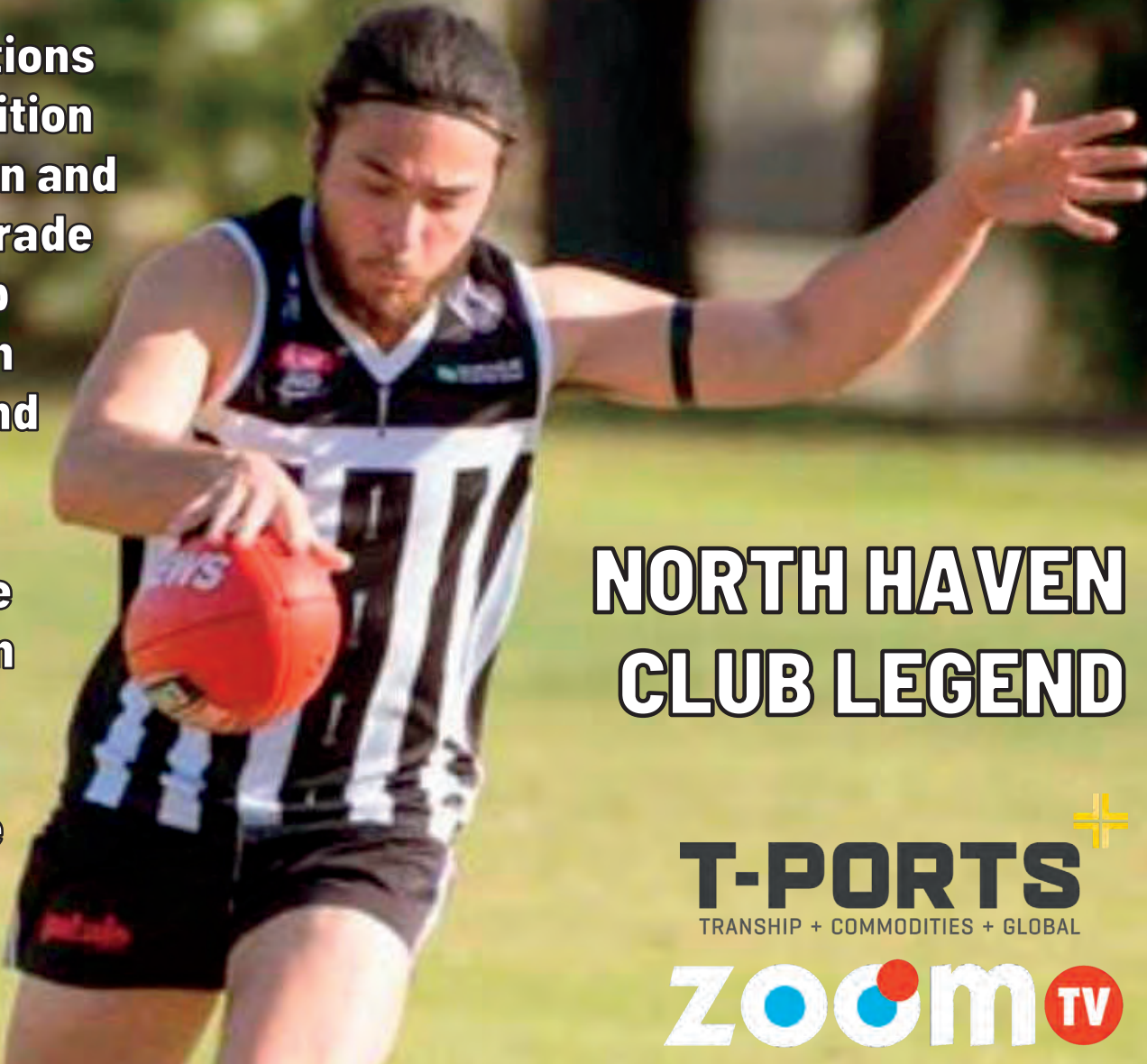

REVIEWS AND PREVIEWS

ROUND 10

Prince Alfred 15.13 (103) def Payneham 6.12 (48)

After a slow start that saw the home side trailing by two goals at quarter time, Prince Alfred stormed home aided by a huge second half to defeat Payneham by 55 points. The Magpies couldn't make it two in a row on Saturday as they ultimately ran out of gas after half time, conceding ten goals while kicking just three themselves. Chris Curran led his group from the front, picking up best afield honours as his side picked up their fourth win of 2022. It seems the long weekend break was exactly what Prince Alfred needed, and hopefully moving forward they can string some good performances like this one together.

Goodwood 8.11 (59) def by Brighton 10.15 (75)

It was a disastrous return from the break for the ladder leading Goodwood, who were upset at home by a seemingly struggling Brighton outfit by sixteen points. It was first versus second-to-last coming into the round, and on paper the result seemed like a no-brainer, but the Bombers came to play. They opened up a fourteen-point quarter time lead, and then matched the home side with any runs they tried to make for the following three quarters, holding on for the win. Nigel Osborn (5 votes, 2 goals) and Harrison Boyle (4 votes, 1 goal) were Brighton's best in their best win of the season.

Old Ignatians 16.11 (107) def Tea Tree Gully 11.15 (81)

Old Ignatians moved into fourth position on the ladder after their pivotal win against fellow top four challenger Tea Tree Gully on Saturday, making the most of their opportunities in front of goal to win by 26 points. The home side led at every change and won every quarter except the last, en route to their potential season changing win. Hugh Ferrari and Jared Centenera were important for the winning side, while Tyson Breden gave it his all for the Gullies. After their fast start to the season, the Gullies all of a sudden sit sixth and in doubt for making finals.

Glenunga 5.10 (40) def by Port District 9.9 (63)

The Rams were faced with a difficult obstacle to overcome, and they were unable to do so against a well-oiled Port District side, going down by 23 points at home. The visitors got out to a fast start, kicking three goals unanswered in the first term, before Glenunga bounced back in a big way in the second, taking a small two-point lead by half time. Unfortunately, a goal-less third quarter and just one goal in the last did not help their cause, as Port District piled on the goals in the second half to run away with it. Cooper Gaffney was instrumental in the win, while Sam Gray and Gavin Shephard were also crucial, as Port District moved to equal top with seven wins.

Rostrevor 9.14 (68) def by St Peters 11.11 (77)

An inaccurate final term prevented an epic comeback from happening, as Rostrevor just fell short of St Peters by nine points. Down 32 points at three quarter time, the game looked over, but Rostrevor started mounting an unthinkable comeback. However, a 3.7 last quarter was all they could muster, and it fell agonisingly short, and with better kicking, it could have been a different story. Sam Dukalskis was St Peters best in the win, which sees them sit top on percentage after ten rounds with a 7-3 record.

ROUND 11

Port District v Tea Tree Gully

After a convincing road win against a strong opponent last week, Port District are back at home where they have been so formidable this year. They host Tea Tree Gully, who have been in some poor form considering how they started the year, and if the Gullies don't figure it out soon, this could get ugly. Port District should win anyway at home, but it is just a matter of how much.

St Peters v Glenunga

Another top clash sees ladder leading St Peters host Glenunga in an important game for standings. The Rams were beaten by Port District at home last week and need to win this week to get back in touch with the top three, who are all on seven wins. To do that, they must beat one of those three teams, St Peters, on the road in what will be a great challenge, but St Peters were almost knocked off by Rostrevor last week, so they are definitely beatable at the moment.

Old Ignatians were great against Tea Tree Gully last week and Prince Alfred were great against Payneham, so it will be telling to see who can follow through with that momentum this week.

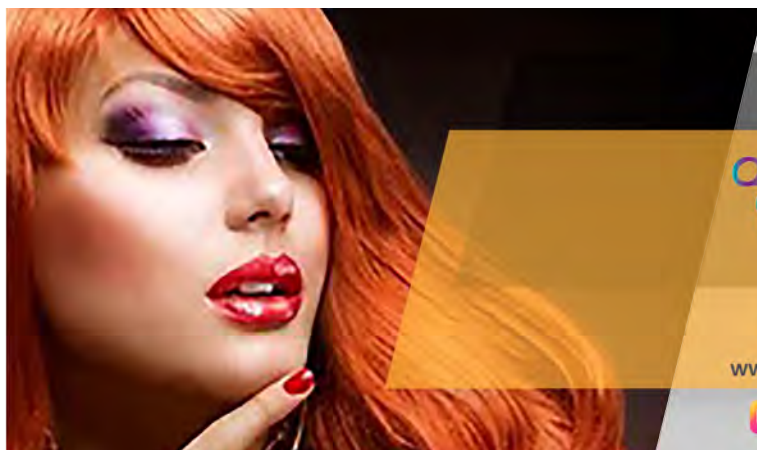
Payneham v Goodwood

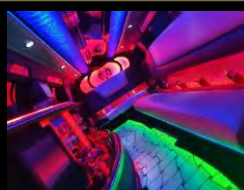

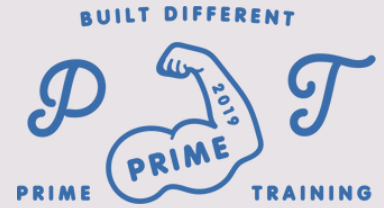

Unley Mercedes Jets v North Haven

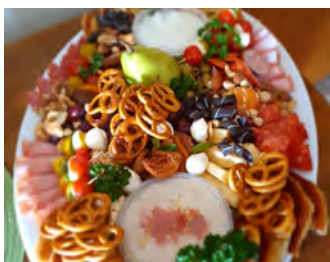

Reviews

CBC OC vs Modbury

Modbury has kept itself in finals calculations on the back of a strong 30-point victory on the road in a game where they were rarely challenged. Modbury got the jump on its opponents very early, taking a 19-point lead into quarter time. The game was very low-scoring despite the near perfect conditions, and with the margin at just 21 points at the final change, it was anybody's game. William Burrows and Liam Vasey fought very hard despite defeat and can hold their heads high despite a disappointing team effort from the Ramblers.
