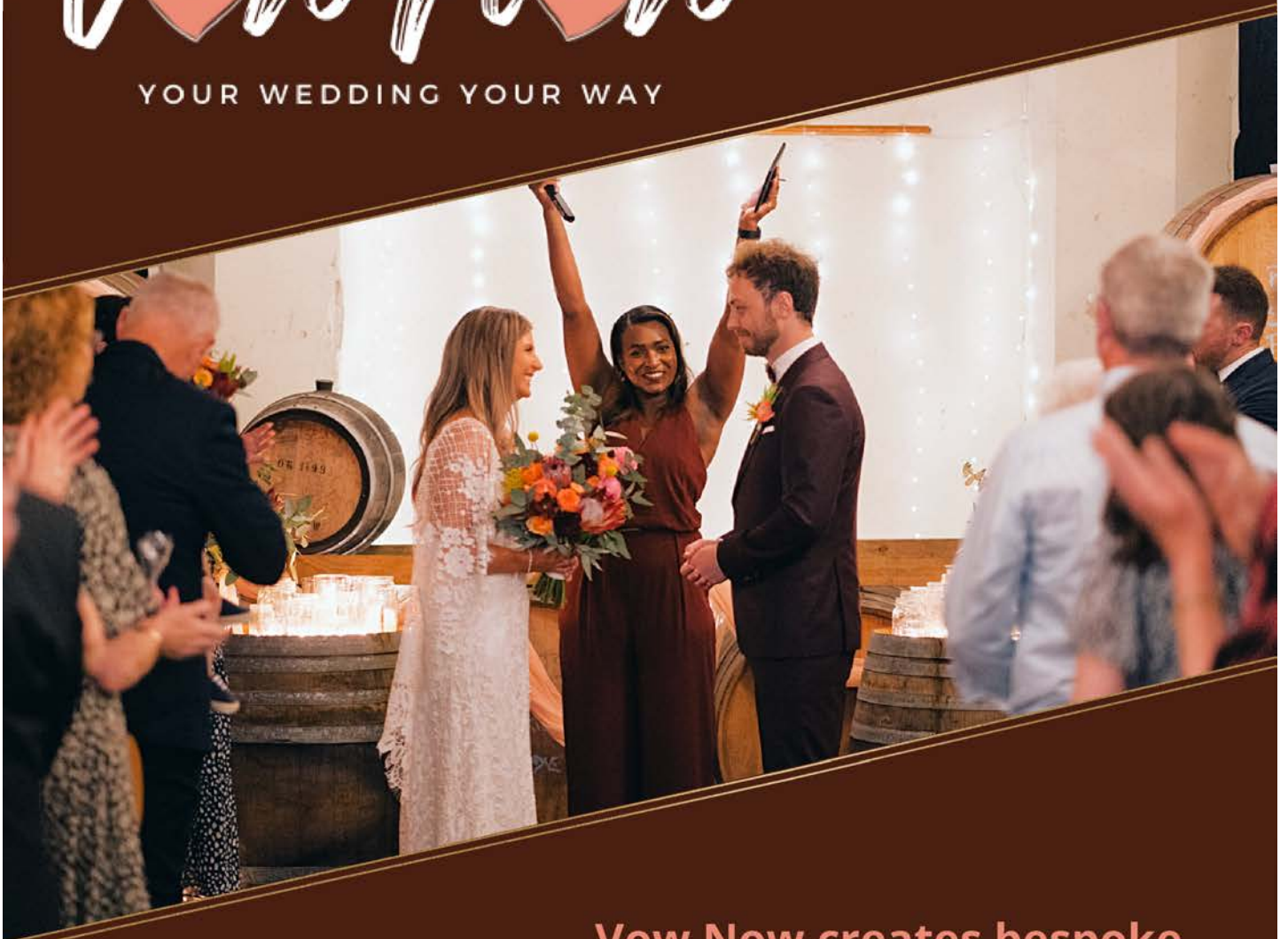

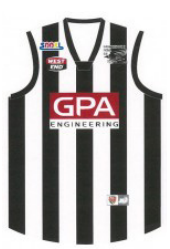

REVIEWS AND PREVIEWS

SEMI FINALS

Port District 14.12 (96) def Goodwood 4.7 (31)

Port District booked their ticket to the 2022 Division 1 Grand Final on Saturday with a dominant 65-point drubbing of their top two counterpart Goodwood. The game was dead and buried by quarter time, as a 29-0 first term saw the home side dominate from the first siren, and it was a deficit the Saints could not recover from. The visitors were outscored in every quarter and it was a statement performance by the top team, who will be hoping to replicate that showing in a fortnight's time when the Grand Final rolls around. Dale Pearce led the frontline with four majors, kicking as many goals as their opponent's total. He was joined by Tom Gray and Gavin Shephard, who both snagged two goals respectively to further the damage inflicted on Goodwood. Mitchell Gaffney, Tom Corcoran and Zac Hawkins were also influential for the home side in a complete four-quarter performance by the premiership favourites. As for Goodwood, they have a second chance in next week's Preliminary Final to avenge their dismal loss, as they will face last year's premiers Prince Alfred for a chance to meet Port District again. But they will need to produce a much better standard than what they displayed on Saturday if they are to knock off a surging P.A.C, who have seemingly found form at the right time. Kyle Kirk (2 goals), Angus Rana and Tom Anderson were the Saints' only goal kickers, while Kirk, Scott Blessing and Oliver Johnson were their team's lone standouts.

Glenunga 10.4 (64) def by Prince Alfred 9.14 (68)

The reigning premiers continued their finals surge on Saturday, upsetting third placed Glenunga in the cut-throat Semi Final to advance to next week's Preliminary Final against Goodwood. The match was tight the whole way through, with the 19-point three quarter time margin the largest of the game, and the Rams even led at half time. A five goal third term from the visitors opened the game up, and although Glenunga clawed their way back in the last quarter, it was not enough as P.A.C held on by four points. The winning side shared their goalkicking, with three players – Tom Bartlett, Finn Heard and Sam Buckham – kicking two goals each and three others slotting one each, and given they kicked fourteen behinds – with ten coming in the second half – they probably should have won by more. Mackenzie Slee, who was among their best last week as well, stepped up again when it matters most, while captain Lachlan McNamara was just as integral. All Prince Alfred had to do was make the top five, as their finals experience was always going to come into play, especially against a newer division 1 side in Glenunga, and that is exactly what happened. Conversely, the Rams' season unfortunately came to an end, but there is a lot to take away from this year for Glenunga, who advanced from division 2 last year to compete in the highest division in 2022. To finish third among established division 1 sides is an encouraging accomplishment, one they can take with them through to 2023, when a return to division 1 finals seems imminent. Tom Langford led their scoring with three goals, while Zac Smith and Michael McMahon were standouts.

PRELIMINARY FINAL

Goodwood v Prince Alfred

This week's Preliminary Final sees the Saints host Prince Alfred for a chance at a Grand Final berth next Saturday. With the loser eliminated, there is everything to play for. Goodwood, who finished second throughout the home and away season, were beaten badly last week by Port District, who showcased the clear difference between first and second place. Their recent form is not something to be overly confident of heading into a Preliminary Final, but as a whole their season has produced a high level of footy, one that needs to be on display this week if they are to make the Grand Final. Medal favourite Nick Favretto and his dominant peer Tom Carter were held well on Saturday, both not having major impact on the game, and their leading goalkicker Nicholas Burgess was held goal-less. All three must lift in Saturday's match, as the team's standard lowered when their leaders were not in the game, something they cannot afford with no second chance. Prince Alfred, who finished fifth, have been superb so far in the finals series, taking care of St Peters in the Elimination Final before narrowly edging out third placed Glenunga in last week's Semi Final. Last year's premiers have shown their experience thus far, and are a real chance at knocking off the Saints and making the Grand Final once again. Their form has been better than Goodwood's of late, and their most recent meeting could foreshadow Saturday's result - P.A.C beat the Saints in round 17. Retired AFL player Jack Trengove, along with Mackenzie Slee, Finn Heard, Hayden Jolly and captain Lachlan McNamara, have led from the front in the last month, guiding P.A.C to a finals spot and even further, a crack at another Grand Final. It will be a tough ask, but with Goodwood coming off a 65-point loss, they are a vulnerable opponent and one that the premiers can take advantage of. With all guns firing, P.A.C are a juggernaut, and although Goodwood have been better this season, it doesn't bode well against a seasoned finals side that time and time again steps up when it matters most. In an upset, I think Prince Alfred knock off the Saints in a clinical display of finals footy and book a date with Port District for the 2022 Division 1 premiership.

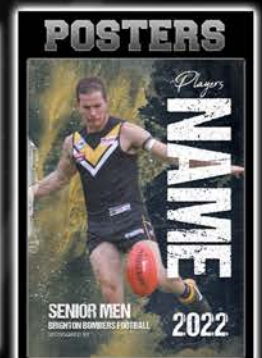

The best two sides all season lock horns at Norwood Oval when Broadview do battle with Sacred Heart. Both sides all season were tipped to meet on the last Saturday in September, and we've a showdown of epic proportions due on Saturday. So far this season, Broadview lead the head-to-head battles 2-1. The two combatants met only a fortnight ago, where Broadview jumped out of the blocks and couldn't be caught. It was a game of two halves as Broadview jumped to a 5 goal lead at quarter time and extended that to an unassailable 45-points at half time. The game was gone at half time, but nobody told Sacred Heart. In the second half they flew home. The old scholars reduced the half time deficit to 34-points at three quarter time. The final term Sacred Heart put an almighty scared into the Tigers as they kicked 8 goals to 1, as they only failed by 14-points to cause a second half boilover. In fairness however, Broadview had put the cue in the bag late in the game. The upside for Sacred Heart was the way they flew home and the knowledge they've been the team to beat all season, with their fantastic forward power and the best defence in the league. His inclusion to the second semi-final team will be a major boost to Sacred Heart. Harrison Morgan with 32 goals, Henry McAuliffe with 23 goals, Darcy Le Cornu with 21 goals along with Cameron Rankin, Harrison Morgan, Clayton Symonds and Josh Koster gives the old scholars the most potent firepower for any side in the competition. Broadview don't have a big focal point like Tristan Carcuro who kicks swags of goals. Kobi Russell has been dominant of late up forward and will be the main offensive tag for Sacred Heart. Russell has been extremely dominant of late, which won't be lost on the Sacred Heart coaching staff. Jacob Rillotta and Josh Sheppard are others who kick multiple goals on a weekly basis, but after that the Tigers will struggle against Sacred Heart. They will need to play Jesse White more time up forward, for the Tigers to kick a winning score, but then they lose from around the ground contests. Jared Petrenko will need to hit the scoreboard more. Alex Cailotto has been in brilliant form all season after returning from South Adelaide and he will give the Sacred Heart on-ballers first use of the ball. Jack Koster, Jack Bridgland, Oscar Lovelock, Clayton Symonds, Tom McDermott and Doug Proud will get enough of the ball all day to be a threat. Petrenko was in great form in the second semi-final and showed his class after playing at the highest level. Both Petrenko and Gotch in the midfield will need to be watched and one of them heavily tagged. You can't tag two players, as the mindset will become too defensive but one of them will need a heavy tag. The biggest difference in our opinion however, will be Alex Cailotto. He's given the Sacred Heart on-ballers first use of the ball all season. His ruck work in the forward half is also extremely dangerous for opposition defenders, as his tap work to his forwards is brilliant. His form of late has been brilliant and last week was dominant against North Haven. Broadview don't have a match up for Cailotto who can beat him. Being able to nullify Cailotto is the best they can do. The lack of a big ruckman who gives their on-ballers first use will be their undoing on a day when there will be lots of stoppages due to expectant wet weather. The bad news for Broadview fans, is that this writer has picked all the winners this finals series. This Broadview side is full of top end talent, but overall it's the depth of Sacred Heart along with the best offence and defence in the competition, plus Cailotto, that points to a Sacred Heart premiership and for the two sides to end up 2 all in head-to-head battles this season. **Sacred Heart OC by 13-24 points**

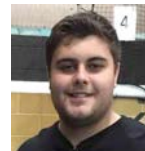

Preview:

Grand Final: Pembroke OS v Hope Valley
