# Adelaide Crows v Fremantle

## Crows will be sitting inside the top four

Adelaide travelled to Marvel Stadium to take on North Melbourne with many predicting a comfortable Adelaide victory over the bottom placed Kangaroos. Understandable given North Melbourne was coming off a 128-point thumping at the hands of the Western Bulldogs the previous week. The Crows were dealt a blow before the game when Rory Sloane was ruled out for up to a month with an eye injury.

This opened the door for Darcy Fogarty who came in for his first senior game of the season. The first quarter went to plan for the Crows as they raced to an 18 point-lead. Taylor Walker booting two opening quarter goals. Losing Luke McDonald and Cam Zurhaar in the first quarter to injury was a massive blow for the Kangaroos but by half-time they had managed to make slight inroads, the margin cut to 15 points. The less said about the third quarter the better. A lot of skill errors and turnovers from both sides will not have many people all that keen to rush out and watch a replay. What could not be questioned however was North Melbourne lifted their work rate and intensity around the footy and the Crows suddenly looked rattled.

The reward for effort finally showing on the scoreboard for North Melbourne as they remarkably took the lead by four points going into the final change. After two disappointing quarters the response from the Crows in the final term was emphatic, booting eight goals to one to run out comfortable victors by 41 points. Matthew Nicks ecstatic with the response from his players in the final term.

"I am really proud of our group to finish the way they did. We have shown a couple of weeks in a row now that we have done the work during the pre-season and the guys are fit and can run games out". Despite some close tagging attention throughout the afternoon Rory Laird still managed to gather 31 disposals.

This was matched by Lachlan Sholl and his performance was rewarded with the round four Rising Star nomination. Darcy Fogarty only had five kicks but made the most of his chances kicking three goals along with Taylor Walker and Shane McAdam. The Crows host Fremantle next Sunday at Adelaide Oval and a win for Adelaide to go 4-1 might just have last season's wooden spooners thinking about finals football.

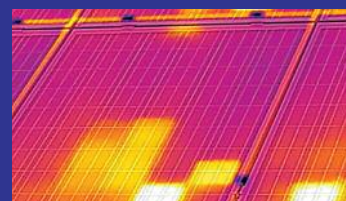

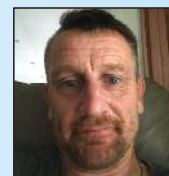

## Port make a point(s) against the champs

It was almost dejavu for the wayward-kicking-for-goal Port Adelaide Power when Robbie Gray handballed through for a rushed behind. Hearts were in Power fans' mouths but thanks to the ruling that the handball was done inside the goal square and under pressure from a probing Richmond forward line. Just minutes earlier, Gray booted the match-winning goal as an injury-riddled Port held on to a magnificent 11.13 (79) to 11.11 (77) win at Adelaide Oval.

Last year's bitter Kane Lambert-induced heart-che were somewhat erased after Lambert had goaled to put the 2017, 2019-20 premiers ahead before Gray's heroic mark and goal against Jayden Short. Port's young gun trio of Zak Butters (subbed off with an ankle injury), Connor Rozee (two goals and a corkie), Orazio Fantasia (ankle), Tom Clurey (corkie), captain Tom Jonas (corkie) and star Sydney Swans recruit Aliir Aliir (head clash), all laboured but all had key moments. Rozee pounced on a Richmond turnover and evaded a desperate Tiger defender to kick his second major in the third quarter.

The worst of the injuries was to youngster Xavier Duursma who suffered a knee injury late in the game after arguably a best-on-ground performance. Power coach Ken Hinkley said Duursma's injury may not be as bad as first feared. "There was a bit going on out there in the carnage. There'll be a couple we need to assess, so I can't give you updates," Hinkley said told AFL.com.au on Saturday. "Without being too optimistic, we're positive [Duursma] might not be the worst case with a knee injury, and we all know what that is, an ACL. It doesn't mean it's not, but at this stage, there's some optimism around that, because they do some tests initially."

Port's midfield of Ollie Wines, Travis Boak and Butters were brilliant as was ruckman Scott Lycett who had an enticing duel against Toby Nankervis. Karl Amon and Dan Houston hardly wasted a possession while Hamish Hartlett slowly found his touch and booted a towering 65-metre goal in the third quarter that gave the hosts impetus heading into the final term. Steven Motlop's two goals were most important and he's continuing a most consistent season. Motlop's Port Adelaide teammate Ryan Burton played his best game this season off half-back while debutant Lachie Jones celebrated his 19th birthday in style with a most impressive effort.

He's a cult following with the mustache and flowing mullet and aside from a couple rushed kicks, the Woodville-West Torrens 2020 premiership star was most at home off half back. For the champions, well, Dustin Martin probably got more Brownlow votes, Nankervis took key marks just like he did in that preliminary final, skipper Trent Cotchin was fearless again and Shai Bolton was nothing but class with his ball use. Like the lyrics from the Foo Fighters' latest hit Waiting on a War, both teams will be ready for their own 'war' because from what was shown by the Power and the Tigers on this Friday night, both will be there in the field of battle on the last Saturday in September at the 'G'.

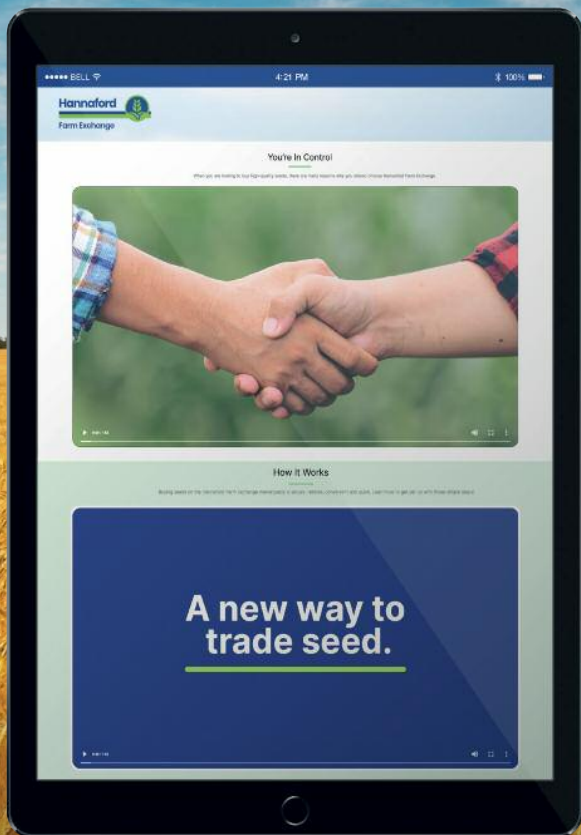

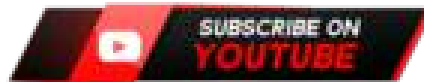

## Berry Energizes Adelaide

Unexpected, amazing, are both accurate descriptions of Adelaide's start to the season.

There are several new faces in the team this year and none have been more impressive or instrumental in Adelaide's rise from the bottom of the table last season to a top 8 contender than Sam Berry.

Berry at only 19 from Gippsland Power made his Afl debut for Adelaide in round 1 and has gone from strength to strength. At the end of round 3 Berry was ranked fourth in the league in pressure acts, sixth for tackles and ninth for, pressure acts in defensive half. highly impressive for a first season player

Taylor Walker has had an incredible start to the season kicking more goals in the first three matches than the entire season last year. There is no doubting that he is a power house forward and a very accurate kick. However, a major reason for the impressive start to the season is he has been getting the ball delivered to him from the midfield a lot faster and better-quality delivery than in recent years. This is due to a large extent of the new look midfield which is a lot more efficient and effective than it has been for several years Berry has been a significant part of this with the pressure he applies to opposition midfielders and at every opportunity he is always looking for an attaching option and to move the ball quickly forward. This is a significant change from the Adelaide we have been used to seeing in recent times where they were overusing the ball in the midfield and as a first option, they would look for a sideways pass the majority of the time instead of looking up the field. Thus, allowing the opposition, a huge amount of time to get into their defensive positions and shut down avenues to goal. The new look Adelaide moves the ball forward quickly and allows Walker and McAdam first use of the ball and the result of this is obvious with Walker currently leading the Coleman Medal on twenty goals and McAdam in the ninth on the top goal scorers list for the season with ten goals

Sam Berry has added a new dimension to the Adelaide, through his speed and pressure he generates with his high tackle numbers he has created multiple turnovers and scoring opportunities. The fortunes of Adelaide have without any doubt turned around in this current season as with only four matches played, they have won three which equals the total amount of wins they had for 2020. Maybe Berry is the spark to re-ignite Adelaide to once again be a genuine finals contender.

Taylor Walker, the man known as “Tex”. This season has seen the veteran key forward revitalise his career with 20 goals after just the first 4 rounds. Rewind the clock back to the end of last season and many were tipping that season 2021 was going to Walkers last as his spot in the team was going to be taken over by his successor Darcy Fogarty who was taken at pick 12 in the 2017 draft. Given the iconic number 32 worn by arguably the greatest ever Crows player Mark Ricciuto, Fogarty has been tipped as the Crows’ next big thing with Walker firmly looked at in the rear-view mirror as a has been player. Enter the 2020 off season and Tex hit pre-season training with a mission in mind, looking to make a stand that he is here to stay and won’t be squeezed out of the team by some plucky youngster. He returned this year looking leaner, more mobile and kicking with power and confidence and having a huge presence on the field as he started with a bang kicking 5 goals in a 12-point upset of last Grand Finalists Geelong. He then followed that up back-to-back 6 goal hauls in round’s 2 and 3 and a further 3 majors in the latest game. This is his best start to a season, and he is only the second player in 30 years to kick 5 or more goals in the first 3 rounds of a season after Jonathan Brown achieved back in 2010.

Many have pointed at the new “stand” rule change implemented at the start of the season which prevents the man on the mark from leaving his position to try and nullify the kickers next piece of play. This allows the ball carrier to play on more and break the oppositions line of defence therefore freeing up their forwards and playing to their advantage by hitting them with lead up kicks. This is where Walker is at his best because he never has been and never will be a high-flying crash and bash contested marker. He’s a leading forward in which he wants to ball straight out in front of him and benefits well from a well kicking midfield who know how to deliver the ball well. So far this season the Crows have done, and Tex has breathed new life into his career by doing so. The new “stand” rule change is by far not the only reason for Walker’s resurgence as his confidence is through the roof thus far, you can see it in the way he plays, he wants to be out there and not burdened with too many responsibilities that in his last years as captain he struggled to juggle. The burden of being the captain eventually took a toll on the power forward as in the 2018, 2019 and 2020 season’s his influence and performance were going downhill at a rapid rate. As the all-time Adelaide Crows leading goalkicker now he must’ve seen his career slipping right through his fingers as the rest of the footballing world did quite clearly. Whether it be a multitude of factors or just one simple rule change, Taylor “Tex” Walker is back and is not only leading the Coleman Medal thus far but is also leading the AFL Coaches votes too. This is one of the biggest stories of the year and it’ll only get better.

## The Dees With a Hint of 'Richmond 2017' About Them

On the eve of the season, no coach was under more pressure than Simon Goodwin, and no club had more critical eyeballs than the Demons. It may be early days, but the grand old flag is flying high... thus far.

The first four games have showed us a vibrant, fast-paced and exciting brand of football the Demons have lacked since their preliminary final season in 2018. Undefeated after the first four matches for the first time since 1994, with wins against finals-fancied Fremantle, St. Kilda, Greater Western Sydney and Geelong.

It has, however, been their ability to respond when challenged that has been the most notable difference. Fremantle clawed their way back to within 11 points mid-way through the third quarter in Round one, St. Kilda kicked five unanswered goals to lead by almost three goals in Round two, against an injury-riddled GWS outfit, Melbourne conceded three of the opening four goals, and Geelong is last season's Grand Finalists and have shown they are more than capable of contending again this year.

Each and every time, they have fought back to ultimately win. This is a sign of a maturing club to not fall by the way side, as they had done so regularly in the previous two seasons.

Ruckman Max Gawn is already staking his claims for a fifth All-Australian jumper this season, averaging 35 hit-outs (12 to advantage) along with 19 possessions in the opening four rounds, all considered elite by AFL standards. He was again pivotal against GWS, scoring two goals and taking five contested marks.

Christian Petracca has elevated his game to elite in every sense, improving on his previous breakout 2020. At 186 centimetres and an imposing 96 kilograms, he is strong through the core, almost impossible to tackle and finds his share of the football with ease, racking up 24, 30, 29 and 36 possessions respectively in the three outings, would certainly see him considered an early favourite for the Brownlow Medal. Consider this along with Clayton Oliver (32 possessions ave) and Jack Viney (six clearances, eight tackles ave),

The enjoyment and camaraderie amongst the players seems to be back, with laughs and smiles after the game more obvious and the significantly reduced injury list always helps, with players including defenders Jake Lever and Steven May getting a clear run allowing a tighter defence, with the Dees conceding less than 75 points on all three outings.
