#### Crows positive start to season has gone

The Adelaide Crows have suffered their fifth consecutive defeat going down to West Coast by 30 points at Optus Stadium. A young and enthusiastic Crows outfit started the match brightly to trail by only two points at quarter time before the Jack Darling show saw the Eagles take a commanding 29-point lead at half-time. Adelaide continued to battle away in the second half but could not get close enough to seriously challenge a strong West Coast outfit at home.

Statistically Adelaide will take some positives out of the game despite the result. The Crows finished with more inside 50s and won contested ball but lacked polish and composure to create more scoreboard pressure. Darcy Fogarty started the game brightly with six disposals in the first quarter before fading out of the game while Rory Laird and Ben Keys were once again the major ball winners for Adelaide. Shane McAdam made a strong return to the senior line up with three goals and an underrated performance was that of James Rowe. While the small forward only kicked the one goal he had six score involvements and 22 disposals which represents his highest disposal tally at AFL level.

Another who managed to better his previous best at AFL level was Chayce Jones who played his first game of the season and gathered 19 disposals. The Tasmanian has struggled to make his mark at AFL level since being drafted with pick nine in the 2018 draft so Adelaide fans will hope this performance gives the 21-year-old the confidence to show he belongs at the top level. Taylor Walker and Ned McHenry should be available for selection this week in another difficult assignment, the top of the table Demons at Adelaide Oval.

#### Power fail top 8 test again

Port Adelaide's much vaunted credentials as a top-4 side took a Western Bulldogs hit to the tune of 19 points at Adelaide Oval on Saturday night. Aaron Naughton starred for the Doggies with 4 goals including a Mark-of-the-Year contender when he soared on top of Port captain Tom Jonas. Western Bulldogs won 15.6 (96) to 12.5 (77).

Naughton's resultant goal proved telling and swayed the game well in the visitors' favour because moments earlier the Power's Todd Marshall decided to be too unselfish after a great juggling mark. His wayward kick failed to hit either Ollie Wines or Charlie Dixon and the Western Bulldogs whisked the ball away leading up to the Naugton hanger

The Bulldogs' midfield brigade of the brilliant Marcus Bontempelli, Tom Liberatore, Adam Treloar and Bailey Smith sliced through the middle of the ground to help set up a handy quarter-time lead. Coby Weightman was a nuisance all game and his three goals were pivotal in the win. Weightman sealed the game after Port had booted the opening two goals of the final quarter, via Dixon, with a snap over his head while facing away from the goals.

For the Power, Wines endured an enthralling battle with Bontempelli and was Port's best player. Mitch Georgiades had his moments with two goals and midfielder Travis Boak and winger Karl Amon both used the ball well and got plenty of it again. The jaw injury to defensive pillar Tom Clurey is a concern and he was subbed out before half-time. Port face a struggling Collingwood this Sunday at the MCG in a tricky crunch game if the Power are to be a top 4 contender.

#### **Double Blues in a Blue**

Unley oval will host a blockbuster this weekend between Sturt and Central Districts. Both teams are coming off losses and have failed to generate any momentum this season. With current win loss records of 1-5 and 2-4, it has not been the dream start to the season the teams envisioned. Therefore, if the bottom sitting dogs want to turn their season around, they will have to do it this week. Conversely, if Sturt are to play finals this year, this is a must win game they cannot afford to drop. This will likely make for great viewing as the teams grapple to assert their dominance and grind their way to finals.

While Double Blues fans can feel disheartened by their team winning only two games, they are a undoubtedly a better team than the record suggests. In their six matches this year, Sturt has played the top four teams and lost. Yet, they almost defeated the barometer of the league, Glenelg, last round losing by only 4 points in a lead changing match. This suggests that their best football is good enough to defeat anyone. However, there appears to be one reoccurring theme in their games. Accuracy. Simple as it is, they have kicked their way out of games. The Double Blues have not converted more goals than points since the opening round, kicking a collective 46 goals and 58 points in their last 5 weeks. Further, in the games they have lost, teams have been able to control the ball. This was apparent against Glenelg, as the tigers had 110 marks to Sturt's insignificant 65. Fortunately for the Double Blues, their dominant midfield and rebound off half back has given the forwards adequate inside 50 entries, which has allowed them to score.

In order for Centrals to get the desired result this Saturday, they will be very reliant on their clearance work to surge the ball forward. This has been an aspect of their brand which is beginning to flourish, as they have won 3 of their last 4 clearance counts. The doggies will need to nullify the influence of Battersby and Lewis around stoppages, as they average a respective 6.2 and 6.8 clearances per game. Battersby and Lewis are also in the top six leading clearance winners in the competition. This prolific stoppage work is complemented by the tall timber in the forward line with the likes of Ashley Johnson providing a target and converting with a scoring accuracy of 77 per cent.

Similar to Sturt, Central fans would not be too disheartened with the dogs performance so far, as Paul Thomas has been able to inject youth into the team. As a result of such youth, the dogs have been able to match it with the best, but ultimately not uphold a four quarter brand. As it sits Centrals currently have one win, after receiving their latest loss to Norwood last round. In this game Centrals smashed Norwood in inside 50's 46-35, but had an atrocious scoring accuracy of 41 per cent. They also got exposed by their poor skill and opposition rebound 50's, as they were going at 70 per cent by foot, and failed to apply enough pressure allowing easy end to end scoring. Central fans will need the clearance powerhouse of Travis Schiller and Darcy Pisani to play massive roles to help rectify these mistakes and win. Schiller averages 23 disposals and Pisani 19.2, making these players fundamental instruments to the game. Furthermore, if the dogs midfield gains control, youngster Aiden Grace, will be their chief target and if he can convert, Sturt will have a massive headache.

Despite the Centrals recent poor form, loosing their last five games, if they play four consistent quarters of football, they will win. Similarly, if Sturt, who are not in bad form, can convert their scores they will likely muzzle the dogs bark.

Nevertheless, I think Centrals will win in an upset on Sturt's home turf.

#### Norwood far too good for Adelaide

Well, after a week off, SANFL footy is back this weekend, with the halfway point of the minor round season starting to loom. It's this part of the season where wins on the board become so vital for finals aspirations. This weekend there are some cracking games, with some teams eager to keep the wins rolling and other teams hoping to get back on the winners' list.

The Redlegs sit third on the ladder with four wins and two losses and are coming off two consecutive wins.

The Adelaide Football Club, however, have the exact opposite win-loss ratio than the Redlegs, with two wins and four losses.

The Crows are second to last on the ladder but are only one match outside the top five. Norwood and Adelaide Face each other on Saturday at Norwood Oval, which will be the first time in 686 days since they have met.

After an up and down start to the season, the Redlegs are starting to find their straps, recording two consecutive wins. Arguably their best win of the year would have to be the nine-point thriller at Cooper Stadium in round five against the Panther's to end a two-game losing streak. Norwood recorded their second win on the trot defeating Central District by 32-points. The Redleg's broke out of the blocks against the dogs, kicking the first three goals of the match and five goals for the first quarter. The first quarter was a good platform for the Redlegs as they won every quarter in the match. Jackson Callow was the best player on the ground for Norwood, kicking three goals and recording 17 disposals. Cameron Shenton kicked the most goals for the game, slotting four from the half-forward flank. For the second week in a row, the Redlegs won the disposal, tackle, hit out and marking counts. Despite losing the clearances in their last two matches, their ability to win the ball has been a highlight. Skipper Matthew Nunn has been a tackling machine for the Redlegs this year and is second in the league for tackles with 50. Star forward Paul Puopolo could be back this weekend which will be a valuable inclusion, with his goal sense and pressure acts.

The Adelaide Football Club are coming off two close losses going down to the Magpies by 14 points in round 6 and Sturt by one point in round 5. Despite the losses, Coach Mick Godden would be happy with the progression the side has made since there 83-point loss to the Eagles in round 3. They defeated Central District in round four by 23 points, being their most impressive win of the season. Big Billy Frampton kicked seven goals in that game, along with four against his former side of Port Adelaide, which resulted in a re-call to the AFL side. Ruckman Kieren Strachan has been a highlight for Adelaide, leading the league in Hit-outs with 216. Youngsters such as Chayce Jones, James Borlase, Ronin O'Connor and Josh Worrell have all had standout games in the Red, Yellow and Blue this season. A positive for Adelaide has been their ability to win the Inside 50 count the last three weeks, giving their forwards an opportunity to kick a winning score. Another positive has been their second halves, outscoring their opposition in the previous two matches after Half-time.

I am intrigued by the Ruck Battle between Matthew Knoll and Kieran Strachan, with both outstanding years so far. The Crows could potentially cause upset, but I think the Redlegs will be too good and win by about four goals.

#### Magpies to fly high in battle of the birds

After both teams had the weekend off due to the SANFL state game, the Magpies and Roosters will provide us with a mouth watering clash at Alberton on Saturday.

Both teams had comfortable wins prior to the break with Port Adelaide winning the SANFL Showdown and North Adelaide destroying West Adelaide.

North full forward Lewis Hender was the star of the show against West Adelaide with 8 majors, was an excellent return in front of goals. He was supported nicely by Dyson Hilder, who was also a multiple goal kicker with 3.

What will please Jacob Surjan the most, was the spread of the Roosters goal kickers. Nine different goal kickers hit the scoreboard which is a very positive sign that roosters have multiple avenues up forward which make them a very dangerous team.

The Roosters managed 54 Inside 50's and scored 19 goals, this is a very strong return. The Roosters also managed 117 marks (+40) compared to West Adelaide which highlights again, the dominance in their ability to win the footy and then use the ball effectively.

Both sides are coming off tight wins in Round 6 which shapes this game to be another close one.

South Adelaide head into this game after an 8-point win over the Woodville-West Torrens Eagles. The
Eagles had more scoring shots on this day, however, the Panthers' accuracy and their ability to kick 15.9 was a major
contributor in helping them secure an away win. South also recorded 18 less hit outs than the Eagles, but this didn't
hinder their midfielders who still managed to get more clearances than their opposition and get fist use of the football.

Overall, the Eagles led most statistical categories which showed how crucial it was that the Panthers were able to kick
relatively straight and make the most of their inside 50s. Bryce Gibbs continued his great start to the season with 20
disposals, 10 tackles and 2 goals and led the midfield with 5 clearances as well. Mitchell O'Neill was just as good with
21 disposals, 8 tackles, 1 goal and a game-high 7 clearances which, along with Gibbs was crucial in getting first use of
the ball from stoppages. Matthew Broadbent used the ball well of half back with 27 disposals whilst Jake Tarca was good
up forward with 4 goals.

Glenelg are coming off a 4-point win against Sturt courtesy of a very late goal to Luke Reynolds to get them across the line at home. The Tigers had a whopping 55 more marks than the Double Blues with a total of 110 which showed exactly how they wanted to play this game. They wanted to kick the ball far more and try and pinpoint their way through Sturt's defence through uncontested possessions which ultimately worked for them. They were good in the contest as well with only 1 less clearance and 5 more tackles than Sturt. The Double Blues got the ball inside 50 more times, however, weren't able to capitalise, ending with 10.10 from 44 entries. Glenelg had less inside 50s and scoring shots and still ran out winners which shows how dangerous their forwards can be when they are on. Luke Partington was great again with 29 disposals and set the tone from the outset in the midfield. Matthew Allen (23 disposals and 2 goals) and Matthew Snook (27 disposals and 1 goal) were also very good getting plenty of the footy and using it well. Lachie Hosie and Luke Reynolds continue to find the goals with both kicking 3.

The last 4 encounters between these two sides have been separated by less than a goal including a draw in 2019. Glenelg have won 2 of those games with South winning the other one. Last time they played was in last year in Round 2 with Glenelg winning by 5 points. They led by a comfortable margin all game and even had a 45-point lead at 3 quarter time. That was until South Adelaide decided to go up several gears and kicked 7.4 to Glenelg's solitary goal in the last quarter. Luke Partington was outstanding with 3 goals, 34 disposals and importantly kicked their only goal of the last quarter which was the difference. This upcoming game should be close again and this is South Adelaide's chance to break Glenelg's unbeaten start to the season and jump to the top of the table.

Last Sunday against the Adelaide Crows again Kennedy put on a masterclass performance. He was simply too strong, too fast and too smart for his opponent and finished the game with three goals.

Josh Darling had and incredible 10 minute period in the second quarter when he kicked 5 goals and was the leading goal scorer for the day with 5.2. Three of the goals that Darling kicked were as a direct result of Kennedy skill off the ball through out maneuvering, and holding off not only his direct opponent but Darling's as well.

Kennedy is not a player who will win a Brownlow medal as full forwards rarely win the medal and when you are in a star studded forward line such as the West Coast Eagles the chance is even further reduced as the votes will get shared amongst the forwards.

Kennedy's value to the forward line is also shown through what occurred on Sunday with the Crows on several occasion when the ball was coming into the West Coast forward 50 having 3 defenders on him at any one time. This obviously some what reduces Kennedy impact on the game by physically being able to get his hands on the ball and contribute that way but it does allow Darling, Allen and Waterman far more freedom and room to operate in forward line. They did so very effectively with the trio kicking 11 goals between them on the day.

The very fact that Kennedy can draw multiple opponents for any marking contest in the forward 50 shows how much other clubs highly rate and respect his talent as when you have a forward line as potent as West Coast does that you use 2 defenders on Kennedy and let another champion forward be un guarded is a huge compliment to his playing ability.

Powerful, high marking forwards that put on a show regularly as All Australian Josh Kennedy did on the weekend is one of the major reasons West Coast get such good crowd numbers to their matches every week to see their Star in action.

He may well be getting on in years but the way he played on Sunday both as an individual performance and an unselfish team player you would expect this true Champion of the game to play on for several years to come.



# TEAM TALK with JORDAN

The AFL Grand Final is each year held at the iconic MCG which is short for the Melbourne

#### Location, Location

Cricket Ground. The Stadium is a showpiece of not only Melbourne but of Australia and the world. The ground can hold just over a 100,000 people and when achieving that, it is a Colosseum like no other with the atmosphere and noise beyond overwhelming it's difficult to not have spine tingles knowing first-hand what it is like. For all the plaudits and success that the MCG has had for continuously hosting the Grand Final there has been and there still is an ongoing debate regarding equality and fairness of the location of the Grand Final since Melbourne is home to 10 out of the 18 AFL clubs and 6 out of those 10 clubs are permanent tenants of the MCG. There is the main reason being that the premiership decider should be shared around each year with the benefits being farer on the interstate teams that have to travel and to continue to cultivate the game outside of the Victorian heartland. Those on the other side of the fence point to tradition that the MCG has and always will be the home of the Grand Final. Outdated is the word that first comes to mind when hearing that it is a "tradition" yes, a VFL tradition to host the Grand Final not an AFL one.

Prior to the game going national in 1990, when local suburban grounds were still in regular use, the MCG made sense as a largely neutral ground with no team being a regular permanent tenant of the ground. Since the AFL went down the centralisation road which saw imbalance within the competition rise, playing the Grand Final at the MCG which as mentioned before is home to several Victorian based clubs is the single biggest hindrance on the 8 non-Victorian clubs in the AFL. Since 2003, just 5 interstate teams have claimed the premiership and 3 out of those 5 were against fellow non-Victorian teams. Seven Victorian teams to go with 4 more who play their home games elsewhere in Melbourne have claimed the other flags, some against teams who were not only interstaters but the higher ranked team. Did home ground advantage play a part in it? Absolutely 100% yes and should the higher ranked team host the Grand Final wherever they are based in Australia? Absolutely yes again.

One is example is Richmond who have arguably or unarguably been the best team in the competition for the past few seasons but their charges towards their 2017 and 2019 premierships make for much closer analysis than what was originally given. In 2017, the Tigers did not once leave the MCG and even unofficially hosted the qualifying final against Geelong even though the Cats were the higher ranked and the game really should have been played at Geelong's actual home ground (Kardinia Park) located in the city of Geelong located 75km south-west of Melbourne and also played host to and beat the higher ranked Adelaide in that year's Grand Final where home-ground advantage was a huge factor. Even more noteworthy is in 2019 where Richmond played at the MCG for 7 consecutive weeks and only leaving once thereafter to play Brisbane in the qualifying final in Brisbane which they won therefore heading straight back to the MCG on route to the flag. These outcomes and circumstances cannot go unnoticed, these things can't be simply brushed aside as a footnote, it must be brought to attention as a flaw and a huge inconsistency and fixturing within the AFL. The MCG has the contractual agreement to hold the Grand Final until 2057 which is a long time away... Too long. Come the year 2058 there must be change and the AFL will become a true national competition.
