



Crows on a high but now face raging Tigers

The Adelaide Crows have defeated Melbourne by one point in arguably their best win of the 2021 season. In a tight contest all day the scores were level at half-time before the Demons took a slender three-point lead into the final change.

When Melbourne led by 16 points in the final term it looked all over but Adelaide kicked the last three goals of the game, Taylor Walker booting his third goal to hand Adelaide a famous victory. The key forward is rightfully receiving plenty of plaudits for his clutch goal at the death, but Adelaide had many great contributors in a total team performance. Paul Seedsman continues to have a career best season. The 29-year-old is averaging a career high 26.2 disposals per match.

The Crows defence as a collective deserve great credit for the result. Melbourne dominated midfield stoppages 44-23 which normally spells trouble, but the Crows defence held firm handing the Demons their first loss of the season. The deliberate out of bounds non-call at the end of the match has sparked plenty of debate and the AFL has come out and acknowledged the decision was incorrect. It was one of many decisions that could have had gone either way on a day that the umpiring could best be described as sporadic.

After five consecutive losses it was an important victory against the top team to help give Adelaide some reward for effort and vindication they are on the right track. Adelaide Coach Matthew Nicks echoing these sentiments after the game.

"I think the guys will come out of this game feeling really good about the work we've done now for the past couple of months We haven't lost the belief - I know we'd lost too many games in a row, but behind closed doors the belief is there"



A Grundy production and Gray's brilliance the highlights

Sam Powell-Pepper and Ollie Wines booted goals firstly from a John Noble turnover and then Charlie Dixon read a throw-in better than Grundy to dish it off to Wines to make it 13 points but there was another twist in the tale. The Magpies' composed young gun Caleb Poulter cut off a hacked Darcy Byrne-Jones kick and his goal made it just one point and the Power held on grimly. The visitors were pathetic in the first quarter and were not anywhere near the intensity that a charged-up Collingwood Magpies were.

Grundy made most of a Scott Lycett-less Power to boot two goals in the first quarter and although his opponent Peter Ladhams lifted big time in the final three quarters, he and his 'Pies held sway. Gray booted two goals in the second quarter to keep his side in it and was the only Power goal scorer at half-time. His check-side second goal was a thing of beauty and of course - Gray was given a rest because 'that's what the sports science computers tell you too' according to FOX commentator Brian Taylor.

Port are at Adelaide Oval to face an unpredictable Fremantle Dockers in a twilight fixture on Sunday while the Magpies have a tough game against Geelong Cats.

South Adelaide is coming off a disappointing 40-point loss to league leaders, Glenelg, while Central District recorded their second win for the season against Sturt. Both sides sit at opposite ends of the ladders, with South Adelaide in 2nd and Centrals in 8th, however, this game shapes to be a closer than it looks judging by the recent form of the two sides.

Back-to-back home games for the Panthers as they return to Flinders University Stadium keen to get back on the winners list after a loss to Glenelg in what was a big opportunity to take top spot away from them. Glenelg dominated possession with over 100 more disposals than South Adelaide along with over 20 more tackles which shows how much more they wanted to win. Interestingly, the Panthers got the ball inside 50 a whopping 21 more times than Glenelg, however, they weren't able to convert their entries into meaningful opportunities and only managed to generate 17 scoring shots from their 59 inside 50s. They also had more clearances even after being smashed in the hit outs which was key to getting the ball inside 50 but unfortunately once it was in there, they couldn't hit the scoreboard enough. Bryce Gibbs was their best yet again with 31 disposals, 11 clearances and 7 tackles and worked hard all day to win the ball out of the middle. Joel Cross, Daniel Nobes and Jake Tarca all kicked 2 goals. Joseph Haines was also good with 10 marks.

Central District will be on a high after a good 10-point win over Sturt in Unley. It nearly wasn't to be, however, with Sturt kicking 7 goals to the Bulldogs' 4 in the last quarter to nearly steal a victory. The game was close throughout, but the Dogs kept Sturt goalless in the 3rd quarter which set them up with a 28-point lead in the last quarter which eventually came in handy late in the game. Similar to South Adelaide, Centrals got the ball inside 50 far more than their opponents but they managed to do damage while it was in there and scored off of half of their inside 50s. Also similar to South Adelaide, Centrals got smashed in terms of hit outs, but as has become the normality throughout footy, hit outs don't always translate to clearances and therefore Centrals won the clearance battle. Jarrod Schiller found plenty of the footy with 26 disposals and set the tone with 10 tackles as well. Travis Schiller was also good with 22 disposals and 5 tackles as the brothers won clearance after clearance through the middle of the ground. There was a good spread of goal kickers with Aiden Grace, Jackson Kelly, Connor Mclean and Chris Olsson all kicking 2 goals.

The last few times these two sides have played it has been a blowout in South Adelaide's favour. They haven't played since 2019 where in that year they played twice with both games going the Panthers way by 30 and 59 points respectively. In their most recent matchup South Adelaide won 79-49 away from home with Joel Cross the best on ground with 1 goal and 31 disposals. He'll be there again for this upcoming game and the additions of Bryce Gibbs and Matthew Broadbent continue to help South Adelaide as they try and hunt Glenelg down for top spot. Expect the Panthers to bounce back after their disappointing loss to Glenelg and have a big win in front of their home fans.

Redlegs to cage Eagles

The Redlegs will travel to Woodville this week to take on the Eagles in a mouthwatering top 4 classic. After the bye both teams looked rejuvenated and fresh allowing them to make light of their respective opponents, Adelaide and West Adelaide. As it sits Norwood are currently third and Woodville fourth with win loss ratios of 5/2 and 4/3. The match will be fascinating as there are several battles within the bigger battle, such as the one between coaches Jade Rawlings and Jade Sheedy. It will be interesting to observe the disparity in style the coaches want to play. On one hand, Norwood have shown they are defensively sound, as they have the lowest score against them this year, whereas the Eagles are very aggressive in offence, hence they have the largest score for them. This difference makes for an intriguing contest and begs the question, will the coaches be willing to lean away from their natural game, in order to nullify the oppositions strength?

One aspect of the reigning premiers, game which Jade Sheedy would be impressed by, is their ability to generate large numbers of inside 50's. In the last 6 weeks they have lost one inside 50 count. This has ultimately enabled them to reach the scores they have and provide opportunity for their forwards such as Daniel and Troy Menzel to score. Further, the Eagles ball use has been pleasing for fans. Woodville averages 77.12 per cent disposal efficiency. This is one of the highest in the league and it has enabled them to catch opposition defenses out of position, due to the accuracy in which the ball is being moved. However, arguably the greatest strength of Woodville, is their list. The AFL talent of the likes of Toumpas, Knight, Stengle and the Menzel brothers, culminated with their SANFL talent of James Tsitas, Matthew Goldsworthy and Jake Von Bertouch, makes for a very experienced list. This makes it incredibly apparent and clear to football observers why they were successful last season. Despite this, Norwood will be aware that elements of Woodville's game can leave the Eagles vulnerable. The most fundamental of these is the rebound 50's, as the Eagles are a very high scoring and aggressive team which means quick oppositional rebounds can hurt them. Additionally, the Eagles are yet to beat a top 5 team and have lost the clearance count every time they lose.

In contrast, Norwood have been the one of the form teams the last three weeks, defeating South Adelaide, Centrals and Adelaide. In the last three weeks, 52 has been top score against the Redlegs. 52. This is very low and a credit to Rawlings and Norwood's defense, who have set up well behind the ball. Rawlings was meticulous in his preparation on Thursday night, making it very apparent to the players that he wanted accountability. Evidently, this accountability has carried into game day form. Moreover, the Redlegs ability to control games through marking, has correlated with their last 3 wins as they have weathered opposition momentum surges with ball control. Red and blue supporters will also be excited by the young prospects of Jackson Callow and Jacob Kennerly, who have both recently exemplified their class at SANFL level.

To defeat the Eagles, I suspect Norwood will be heavily reliant on their defense and inflict damage onto the eagles through their rebound 50's. Whereas Woodville will look to overcome the fortress in the back 50 and continue their run of high scores. Yet, due to Norwood's recent form, I think the red and blue will knock off the reigning premiers and stake their top 2 claim. Norwood by 13-24 points

Dyson Hilder finished the day with three goals and Keenan Ramsey also booted two which was a shing light for the Roosters.


Sturt go into the game at Prospect on the back of two very close losses. The Tigers by four points in round 6 and Centrals by 10 points in last weekends clash.

Glenelg to run rampant against Adelaide

After a week off, the SANFL season was back in style with an enthralling Round seven that had everything. There were some two-goal thrillers combining with some absolute beltings to provide the weekend with a variety of results.

Round eight is ahead of us, and the ladder is starting to slowly take sharp with some teams attempting stamp to their authority on the premiership cup. One of these teams is the Glenelg Football club who are cruising at the top of the ladder. Glenelg coach Brett Hand would be delighted with the Bay's start to the season as they have not lost a game yet.

The Bays 7-0 start is the first time in five years where a team has gone unbeaten for their first seven games of the season. The last team to start the season 7-0 was the panthers in 2017. Glenelg defeated the second-placed Panthers by 40 points on Sunday, and It was the first time Glenelg had won at Noarlunga in eight years. The Bay's started with a bang kicking five goals to two in the first quarter and have led at quarter-time in every game this season. Glenelg smashed South Adelaide in the disposal count, having 77 more touches. Chris Curran had a standout game, collecting 33 disposals as well as first best. Curran also had a game-high 12 marks, and he leads the competition in the marking count with 62. Glenelg has scored the most points in the competition so far, and former AFL player Lachie Hosie has been helping the Bays get a score on the board. Hosie is equal first in the Ken Farmer medal with 19 goals and kicked two on the weekend. Glenelg has won the disposal count in every game this season which has been a key to their success. A player that has been helping the Bays winning the ball is former Magarey Medal winner Luke Partington. Partington leads the disposal count for the league with 196 disposals, averaging 28 a game. The Bays will be looking to be the first team since Norwood in 2012 to win their first eight games of the season.

Glenelg faces the Adelaide Football Club this weekend, who are sitting at the opposite end of the ladder. Adelaide is ninth on the ladder with two wins and five losses and is coming off three straight losses. Adelaide got off to a good start against the Redlegs on Saturday, leading at quarter-time and were right in the contest. A five-goal to one second quarter was the Crows downfall, with the Redlegs ended up winning the match by 48 points. Even though the Crows have only got two wins on the board, they have been the contest in just about every game this season. A positive for coach Mick Godden would be the tackle pressure Adelaide have produced this season with winning the tackle count in every game but one this season. The Crows have also won the Clearances in the last two weeks, with youngster Jordan Boyle having seven on the weekend. Will Hammill and Andrew McPherson were both solid for the Crows on Saturday, collecting 31 and 27 disposals respectively. Number 24 Josh Worrell keeps pushing for his AFL debut, collecting 21 disposals in the loss, averaging 18 touches per game for the season.

The last time these two sides met was when the Bay's won a nail-biter in 2019, winning by two points. It will be interesting to see if the crows can produce that intense pressure his weekend against Glenelg. I think the Bays will be too strong and will win by around nine to ten goals. Blood bath by Port rookies looms at Alberton

Port Adelaide Magpies are out of AFL induced isolation and nudged into fifth on the ladder, two games clear inside the final five. It is good to have the prison bars looking ominous in the SANFL again. West Adelaide sit tied for sixth place, tied with every team outside the five, on two wins and five losses. Alas, last week they were a little nearer to Woodville West Torrens on the ladder, before the Eagles consigned the Bloods to the biggest defeat by any team of Season 2021, an even 100-point drubbing.

Port had a streaky win at home while this unfolded. After half time, the magpies conceded the first four goals and the lead to North Adelaide, before Boyd Woodcock (five matches played) steadied them with back-to-back goals.

The rookie show rolled on, lighting up the fourth quarter. Corcoran (22 games) put them back in front, Schofield (seven games) picked up two goals and Wong (16 games) booted three. If you see a theme here, it is that all of Port's four multiple goalkickers had 40 games experience -between them. Isn't that a great sign of the talent to come?

Conversely, West Adelaide let half of the Eagles' 22 register goals against them, including defender Patrick Giuffreda in his 200th game. It was only a month ago that the Bloods defeated Norwood in the West. It may have come a week after the Roosters embarrassed the Redlegs at home, but West Adelaide took tackling pressure and applied it all day; then they maintained their run and carry past Centrals a week later.

That good fortnight of footy would precede a bad one. Now West Adelaide have conceded 20 goals, twice in two weeks, and not found half as many goals to boot in reply, against the inconsistent North and a persistent Woodville-West. West Adelaide let the Eagles dominate possession, to the tune of 120 extra touches, over 50 extra kicks and over 20 extra inside 50s. The Bloods earnt their two wins with far closer disposal gains in their good fortnight, but in this bad fortnight, they have been ripped to shreds on the stats sheet and punished on the field.

Their 0 and 3 start had been just about rectified but now they face tough opponent after tough opponent and an uphill battle to stay relevant in 2021. Port will play them in Round Eight at home once more. Last time these two sides met, in 2019, the Bloods managed only three goals. Round 1 of 2019 was the last time West Adelaide got close to Port Adelaide, before they pulled away late in the fourth quarter. It is worth mentioning that the Bloods women can give the proud club a boost with a berth in the 2021 SANFLW Grand Final. They play in a Preliminary final against Norwood on Saturday morning, before the men head to Alberton Oval.

Norwood were the team to beat throughout this women's season, and they have instead conceded the first spot in the grand final to Glenelg. West Adelaide and South Adelaide rounded out the top four. Only these two teams beat Norwood in the minor rounds, and West edged past South last week in the elimination final, with only a minute to spare.




