Turnovers are killing the Crows chances

The Adelaide Crows have gone down to Richmond by 28 points in an entertaining round 11 clash in Sydney. The match was moved to Giants Stadium from the MCG due to the current spike in Covid cases in Victoria. Adelaide started full of confidence after their impressive victory over Melbourne the previous week.

Booting five of the opening six goals of the game the Crows looked impressive before Richmond took control of the contest. The Tigers kicked 13 of the next 16 goals and despite an Adelaide fight back to bring the margin under two goals in the last quarter the Tigers steadied through Jack Riewoldt who kicked the last three goals of the contest to finish with five. Despite limited supply for large portions of the game Taylor Walker still managed to kick four goals which has the key forward sitting second in the Coleman Medal.

Darcy Fogarty again made the most of his limited possessions kicking three goals from six disposals, but Adelaide only managed eight marks inside 50 compared to 20 for Richmond. The Adelaide midfield battled hard with Ben Keays, Rory Sloane and Rory Laird the major ball winners. Callum Coleman-Jones playing only his second AFL game proved a handful for the Crows defence as he kicked four goals for Richmond. Matthew Nicks pleased his young side fought out the game but lamented turnovers which is currently hurting Adelaide badly.

"I think we leaked seven goals from our attacking mid zone. This week, and across the last four to six weeks, teams are scoring over 100 points against us and the turnover score is the one that's really hurting us"

Sam Berry started the game brightly with a goal and five score involvements but was subbed out of the game with concussion and will now face the AFL concussion protocols that will have him in doubt for the upcoming clash with Collingwood. A return of three handballs for Shane McAdam may also have the small forward under pressure to hold onto his spot in the senior team.

Port Adelaide v Geelong

This game is on June 10th at Adelaide Oval after bye

Powerful first quarter sets up win

A sublime first-quarter goal-fest from Port Adelaide Power was key in a 46-point win against a slow-starting Fremantle Dockers at Adelaide Oval. Karl Amon had 16 possessions in a dynamic Port first quarter in which the hosts led by 40 points. The Power's best quarters was obviously its first and final quarters in which that term was highlighted by an Amon long bomb as the hosts ran away 18.7 (115) to 9.15 (69).

Sam Powell-Pepper (three goals) booted two goals while Charlie Dixon (three goals) started in the ruck but finished with a brace of majors at the first change. 1988 Brownlow Medallist and Fox Sports commentator Gerard Healy said it was a total blitz early.

"In four minutes, Port Adelaide have kicked 3.1 and Fremantle have touched the ball on three occasions," Healy said.
"This is a shellacking of the highest order and if it keeps going like this they're going to have an increase of percentage by about 15."

However, the Dockers lifted in intensity, and had to, in the second quarter as captain Nat Fyfe and young guns Adam Cerra and Caleb Serong were the main men. It was somewhat of a Jekyll and Hyde summation from the first quarter to the second and the first half of the third quarter as Freo more than halved its deficit from 50 to 21. Port's Kane Farrell did boot a 50-plus-metre barrel in the Power's only real highlight for the second term. Freo booted six majors in that second stanza.

But as Port Adelaide coach Ken Hinkley wants his team to become a great one and goals to the mercurial Robbie Gray 50-seconds into the third quarter and a bouncing long-range shot by improving ruck-forward Peter Ladhams, kept the Dockers at arm's length. The final quarter was a step in the right direction to Hinkley and the club's 'greatness' ambitions as Todd Marshall got valuable touches and finished with two goals.

Port bull Ollie Wines was best afield in a brilliant display in midfield, Dixon played his best game for the season and is building to a strong second half, explosive halfback Lachie Jones was supreme, Ladhams had game figures of a midfielder in ruck, Dan Houston and the evergreen Travis Boak won important touches. The Power will enjoy the bye this weekend before hosting a Thursday night top-four deciding blockbuster against fourth-placed Geelong Cats on June 10.



Kirkwood's retirement party with a win against Sturt in Unley last fortnight. Last week Centrals put their best foot forward
in a flying start against South Adelaide at Flinders University Stadium, chasing their first winning streak. They pounced on
every turnover in the forward half, creating plenty of them, finding loose players heading back inside 50, and hitting goals
on the run. When South worked their way back into the game, as good teams do, Centrals reset after half time and came
back themselves. Perhaps they could have even been in front with a quarter to play, but five missed five shots on goal for
the term soon proved costly. South made them pay by kicking four goals unanswered, twice over, skipping away to their
eventual winning margin with ten minutes to spare.

Centrals did have a relative hold on South Adelaide, and on the match, until this point. Their grip was lost when South hit triple figures, because the Dogs have not managed the same in attack. If Centrals found it difficult to keep South on a tight leash, then they may also struggle with the Eagles, who are next-highest on the ladder.

Last week they out-muscled Norwood and outscored them two-to-one, leapfrogging the Redlegs on the ladder in the process. In recent weeks, a variety of players have stood up for Woodville-West to hit the scoreboard, since their twin losses in Rounds Five and Six. The reigning premiers have only lost to fellow finals contenders thus far, both South and the undefeated Glenelg, plus a substantial loss to Port Adelaide at Alberton.

Any football side will tell you they are only taking it one week at a time. But the Eagles must use every minute of this contest at X-Convenience Oval to gear up for an incredible month of footy, in what will be a make-or-break stretch of three matches for the Eagles' title defence: First Port Adelaide, then Glenelg, then South Adelaide. We will soon know whether Woodville-West Torrens have what it takes to go back-to-back.

For this week, shutting down Aiden Grace is a priority for the Eagles, as he has goaled every week of 2021 bar one, an excellent recruit for the Bulldogs so far. Last week, despite being even for three and a half quarters of footy, the Dogs would go on to have 130 fewer touches than South. Any opponent will find a way to win with this weight of numbers. Especially the Eagles, who have swamped their opponents by huge margins in matches, both this year and last, when they have had strong possession. The Eagles have also been taking tall overhead marks, whilst the Bulldogs have not. If the Dogs can bring the ball to ground level, well, there is a lot of ground for them to cover at home.

I do not doubt the Dogs can provide the run and carry to take the footy away from the Eagles, with Jarrod Schiller leading all comers for the season. Can they trip up the Eagles before their brutal draw begins? Eagles by 20-30 points

With another round done dusted, the halfway point of the SANFL season is almost here, and the ladder is slowly taking shape. There are four points that separate fifth and sixth, meaning the teams outside the five need to make the most of the next few rounds to sneak into the top five. Round eight included some surprising and big margins, which proved what teams are up the top and what teams are on the bottom of the SANFL Ladder. The average margin for the round was 36.6 points, with some teams making easy work of their opposition. One team that made easy work of their opposition last Saturday was the Glenelg Football club who won by 89 points against the Adelaide crows. Glenelg Coach Brett Hand will be looking to

Funny enough, the last team to win their first nine games of the season was the Redlegs back in 1997 in their premiership year. Not only can the Bays make history this weekend with that 9-0 record, but they will also be very clear favourites to win this year's flag. The bays did what they do best last Saturday at Gliderol Stadium and made easy work of the crows. Winger Matthew Allen was outstanding for the Bays collecting first best with 33 disposals. Glenelg's midfield with Matthew Snook, Luke Partington and Brett Turner showed why they are one of the best midfield in the competition, all featuring in the best six players on the ground. Snook had the most Clearances on the ground with nine and is equal second for clearances in the league with 53. Even without Lachie Hosie, Glenelg were still damaging in the forward line with Luke Reynolds and Liam McBean kicking nine between them. Toby Pink, Christopher Curran, Sam Durdin, Michael Virgin and all of Glenelg's defence have held their own this season. Glenelg's Back six have only conceded 246 points in the last four rounds, which is the least by any team this season.

Norwood, on the other hand is coming off a disappointing loss to the Eagles, going down by 47 points at Woodville. Jade Rawling's side have had a patchy first half of the season with a big gap separating their good and bad footy. When the Redlegs are bad they unfortunately don't look like a finals side but when they are good, they look like beating anyone. Before Saturday's loss, The Redlegs had won three in a row and were looking to regain some momentum. They got off to a good start against the Eagles, kicking three goals in the first quarter and were up by two goals at quarter time. The Redlegs average four goals in the first quarter the last three weeks, meaning they have been getting off to good starts. Norwood Ruckman Michael Knoll has been fantastic this season, averaging 29 hit-outs per game and is third in the league with 234 hit-outs. Cameron Ball, Jacob Collins, Isaac Saywell and the whole of Norwood's defence has done well this season. Norwood has only conceded 496 points this season which is the least points scored against by any team this season.

Even though it's at the parade and the trip to Norwood is not an easy task, I think the Bays will be the first team in 24 years to win their first nine games of the season. I am intrigued to see how Norwood's solid defence hold up against Glenelg's forward line featuring Liam McBean and Luke Reynolds. I think it will be a tight tussle, but the Bays will be too strong.

Panthers to draw blood and continue their winning ways

Round 9 of the SANFL season ends at Hisense Stadium with a clash between West Adelaide and South Adelaide. These two sides are at opposite ends of the ladder with South Adelaide in second and West Adelaide in ninth, which may mean that a big South Adelaide win could be coming, however, the Bloods will be looking to bounce back after a 5-goal loss to Port Adelaide last week. The Panthers on the other hand are coming off a 28-point victory against Central District and are waiting for Glenelg to slip up to take top spot.

South Adelaide is coming off a 28-point win against Central District, however, it wasn't all smooth sailing. The Panthers took a while to get going after being down by two goals at quarter time and it was very tight up until 3-quarter-time but after the final break they broke away and kicked 6 goals to the Bulldogs' 2 to run out comfortable winners. The Panthers dominated almost every statistical category throughout the day never really looked like being beaten. They ended up having 130 more disposals and 45 more marks which shows their intent to pass the ball around until they were able to find an avenue inside 50. This was crucial as both sides had equal inside 50s but as South Adelaide were able to efficiently enter their forward half, they were able to generate better scoring chances. Bryce Gibbs had an unbelievable afternoon with 36 disposals and 2 goals and led the way through the midfield while Matthew Broadbent and Joseph Haines also racked up over 30 disposals each. In the forward line, Joel Cross (3.3) and Sam Skinner (3.2) looked like scoring every time they went forward.

West Adelaide went down by 29 points to Port Adelaide at Alberton Oval, but were in the game up until the last 10 minutes of the 3rd quarter. Port Adelaide dominated in the hit outs, which translated in a massive win in the clearances, which then led to 20 more inside 50s. Conceded that many inside 50s is always going to be hard to defend and on this occasion the West Adelaide defence couldn't hold up for long enough and the floodgates opened for Port towards the end of the game. Kaine Stevens was the best for the Bloods with 33 disposals and a goal while Jordan Boyle (28 disposals) and Bailey Chamberlain (25 disposals) also had plenty of it. Thomas Murphy was their only multiple goal kicker with 2 with six others chipping in with 1 goal.

The last few times these teams have played has been a mixed bag in terms of results. In the last 4 games each team has won two with only one game being separated by under 20 points. In more recent history, South Adelaide have had the wood over the Bloods winning the past 2 and will be looking to make it 3 in row on Sunday. Last time they played was in 2019 where South Adelaide ran out 28-point winners and did it comfortable for much of the game. The stats were fairly even, however, both sides were inaccurate, and it was South Adelaide that were able to make the most of their scoring chances. Joseph Haines was best on ground with 33 disposals and 12 marks for South Adelaide while Dallas Willsmore had 29 disposals and 10 marks for West Adelaide. This upcoming game seems to be trending in a similar direction as this one so expect South Adelaide to continue to put another win on the board.

They may only sit third on the AFL ladder, still one and two games behind the Western Bulldogs and Melbourne respectively, but the Brisbane Lions are the in-form team of the competition. Seven wins in a row has more than made amends for their average 1-3 start to the season. The seven games has also come against quality opposition with Richmond, Port Adelaide and GWS all legitimate premiership contenders in 2021.

This Friday night, they meet the ladder-leading Demons in what promises to be a blockbuster match-up against the Demons this Friday, no matter where it will be played in this COVID-19 interrupted part of the season.

The Brisbane Lions are currently flying, with every part of the field well covered for. They boast one of the strongest midfields in the game, with Hugh McCluggage (25 possessions ave), Mitch Robinson (20 possessions ave), Jarryd Lyons (27 possessions ave) and Dayne Zorko (24 possessions ave) all wreaking havoc at the ball, then adding dual All-Australian and 2020 Brownlow Medallist Lachie Neale, who despite having injury and form issues in 2021, will be expected to return to full fitness comes the second half of the season, it's hard to see any midfield (including the Western Bulldogs) beating them in the middle. Their forward line is functioning superbly, currently the second highest scoring in the competition with 154 goals. The twin towers of Eric Hipwood and new-recruit Joe Daniher combining for 40 goals at the half-way point, along with another 30 between Charlie Cameron and Lincoln McCarthy. The options are aplenty for the Lions, and even if injuries in their forward-50 do occur, they have the likes of Thomas Berry, Keidan Coleman and Daniel McStay to fill the void. Their defence is also extremely tight, with Daniel Rich, Harris Andrews, Grant Birchall and Brandon Sarcevich in particular working well to concede under 85 points on seven occasions.

This is however, going to come with pressure as the Lions continue to roar into the second half of the season. Since coach Chris Fagan took the role ahead of the 2017 season, they won the wooden spoon in his first season, improved slightly to 15th in 2018 and then with the acquisition of key recruits, soared to second on the table in both 2019 and 2020. Unfortunately, though, they were unable to capitalise on home-ground advantage and lost three of four finals they have played in that time, all of which at the Gabba. With these previous two seasons of finals-failures, the pressure begins to mount. While there is certainly still plenty of time for the Lions to win a premiership, with Cameron Rayner (21), Eric Hipwood (23), Daniel McStay (25), Charlie Cameron

(26), Lincoln McCarthy (27) and Lachie Neale (28), who all still have many years left in them, the issue isn't age, more-so the mental pressure to perform. The Lions are almost in the exact same position they were at the halfway point in 2019 and 2020, in the top four and looking strong.

Is Alistair Clarkson seasoned?

It is without any shred of doubt that Alastair Clarkson is one of the most decorated coaches our game has ever seen and ever will see. Clarkson's contribution is second to none and I firmly believe, as well as many others that Clarkson is the greatest man to warm the head seat in the coach's box in this century. However, despite his incredible reputation and ability, as Hawthorn continue to struggle this season, does it suggest that Clarkson has overstayed his welcome at the Hawks.

After a couple of stints as an assistant coach in the AFL for Saint Kilda and Port Adelaide; Clarkson was appointed the head coach for Hawthorn at the dawn of 2004. The club were at a very low point at the time finishing second to last, and Clarkson's ability would have certainly been challenged. Clarkson returned to Hawks to finals football in 2007 and delivered them a flag in 2008 in a victory against Geelong. During this time, Clarkson established a style of play labelled the 'Clarkson Cluster' that was extremely difficult to break down for opposing teams. Clarkson's legacy as Hawthorns most successful coach and one the most decorated coaches in the game was when he won three straight premierships for Hawthorn in 2013, 2014 and 2015.

Clarkson built two great teams for the Hawks that won premierships in different times. He built a dynasty of football that had not been seen from Hawthorn since the eighties and will always be revered in footy folklore. After a dynasty, it is only natural that his team was due to slump, however, last season and this season thus far have been dire for the Hawks. After only five victories in last years COVID-struck season, this season is seeing the passionate Hawthorn faithful hit panic stations. Only two victories gained in the first 11 rounds and placed second two last on the table; the Hawks are in the same position when Clarkson took over 18 years ago. This begs me to raise the opinion that Clarkson is perhaps season and that his best days as Hawthorn coach are in the past.

This leaves the danger for Clarkson that his legacy as Hawthorn's greatest ever man in charge is at threat of a little tarnish. His contributions to the club will be forever admired, however, Clarkson maybe needs to move on from the Hawks, try other coaching avenues and bring his expertise to another club. Sam Mitchell as Hawthorn's coach in the near future will be a bold and valuable move for a solid future for the mighty Hawks.


