Bulldogs have too much bite

Despite coming off a 19-point victory over Hawthorn the previous week the clash against the top of the table Western Bulldogs in Ballarat was always going to present a big challenge for the Adelaide Crows. The Crows battled away in blustery conditions, but the Bulldogs simply had too much class running out comfortable 49-point winners.

Kicking with the aid of the breeze in the first quarter Adelaide started brightly kicking the first two goals of Liam Sheedy the contest, but the Bulldogs had taken control by quarter time booting five goals to lead by 12 points. By half-time the margin was beyond five goals and the contest was effectively over. Skipper Rory Sloane had a productive day and was the pick of the Crow midfielders gathering 26 disposals including four clearances and five score involvements. Elliot Himelberg and Taylor Walker combined for four goals which made up half of the Crows goal tally, but the Adelaide forwards had limited supply with the Bulldogs dominating the inside 50 count (65-40). Senior Coach Matthew Nicks in the after-match press conference was still upbeat despite the loss.

"We played against a very good today, they capitalised on all of our mistakes, but I was really pleased to see the second half how we fought it out"

The Crows return to Adelaide and will host Port Adelaide in Showdown 50 in what looms as another huge test, the Power having won the last three Showdowns. In a rebuilding season a win over the archrival would be a nice celebration in what has been a challenging season.

Powerful start and finish for Port

Port Adelaide entrenched itself in the top four and a chance for top-two after a convincing 15.10 (100) to 11.7 (73) win against Greatest Western Sydney Giants at Marvel Stadium on Sunday night. After the returning Toby Greene kicked a go-ahead goal early in the final guarter, Port powered to another gear with a brace of goals to Charlie Dixon (four goals) and an arrow from an angle to Xavier Duursma to distance itself from the tenacious Giants.

Duursma's two 'Three Amigo' team-mates Zak Butters and Connor Rozee were also pivotal in the frantic final term soured by a head injury to GWS young gun Jacob Hopper who was accidentally kicked in the head as he attempted to smother a kick from Karl Amon. The latter was magnificent for the Power especially early in the piece and late when Port needed vital run between half back and half forward. Ollie Wines may have nailed a top-three spot in the race for the Brownlow Medal with another powerhouse display with 28 possessions balanced between 14 kicks and 14 handballs and 17 contested. Ruck forward Peter Ladhams kicked three freakish goals including an 'Angus Monfries' goal that took on off-break after Giants' defender Nick Haynes opted to allow the ball to bounce. It bounced the right way, for Port supporters, in a wrong sort of way if you follow the laws of physics!

Defensive trio Aliir, captain Tom Jonas and impressive Trent McKenzie were supreme on Harry Himmelberg, Jesse Hogan and Greene, although Greene kicked 2.4. Half backs Darcy Byrne-Jones and Ryan Burton mopped up consistently throughout the night out of the defensive zone. Port Adelaide coach Ken Hinkley said it was an impressive performance.

"I thought it was a strong performance by the boys and I really liked the way we were challenged," he said. "GWS, really good side and they had plenty to play for. "I think we got asked again in the last couple of weeks to respond again and we were able to do that." The Power take on the Adelaide Crows this Saturday night at Adelaide Oval (at this stage) in Showdown 50.



Redlegs To End Tiger Train

After a lackluster week in isolation, and two weeks without our beloved game both sides could argue they enter the game under-done. With players likely binging the most recent series of Outer banks, while trying to stay fit with make-shift home gym sessions, this unprecedented mid-season break will make for a fascinating contest. What momentum these teams were taking into this match has likely subsided. For Glenelg this break could be very detrimental to their progress, as they have won 14 games straight. In contrast, Norwood would be seeing the benefits of lockdown, as have won only one from their last three, which is disappointing given they have had ample opportunities to put themselves in a commanding top two spot.

Much has changed in the world since SANFL was last played only 21 days ago. 3 States went into a statewide lockdown, Australia has collected their highest number of gold medals ever and Alastair Clarkson is leaving Hawthorn. However, one thing that has not changed is these two sides predicament in season 2021. On one side Norwood have been able to defeat top sides in that of South Adelaide, Sturt and Port Adelaide, but have ultimately failed to play a consistent brand of football and therefore find themselves fifth. Comparatively, Glenelg are top and have retained momentum throughout the whole season.

Norwood coach Jade Rawlings will demand greater effort from his players this week as they take on the Tigers. Over the past three weeks Rawlings cannot be displeased by most aspects of Norwood's game. This was apparent in their last match against the Eagles, as Norwood won marks, kicks, tackles, scoring accuracy, hit outs and rebound 50's. Yet, they were defeated by 36 points. This has been a consistent facet of their game style, whereby statistics do not always correlate with the result. This suggests that Rawlings as a coach, wields much power in his team's outcome, as there are not any overwhelming holes in their game.

Nevertheless, Norwood are yet to exhibit an elite strength to their game. While Norwood have shown to have no consistent weakness, the most alarming area for Rawlings is their goal kicking. Throughout the season the Red and Blue has booted a total of 874 points; the third lowest in the competition. It has instead been Norwood's defense which has kept them in games, conceding the second lowest score of 861. With the inclusion of Paul Puopolo this season, red and blue fans may have hoped for more scoring, as Puopolo himself has only mustered seven goals from 13 games. Of course, Norwood cannot blame Puopolo for this, however, it is up to the sides most experienced players to rally their forward line and allow the likes of young guns Tristan Binder and Xavier Tanfra to flourish.

In order to defeat Glenelg, Norwood must apply scoring pressure. This will be achieved with great difficulty, as the Tigers maintain arguably the strongest midfield in the competition. Magarey medalist, Luke Partington leads the charge in the Centre along with fellow veteran players Matthew Snook and Brett Turner. Once forward, the ball is left in the prolific hands of Hosie, McBean and Reynolds who have collectively kicked 87 goals this season, hence Glenelg is the highest scoring side with 1275 points. As it sits Glenelg are undefeated. They have a sound game plan and the cavalry to defeat anyone. Every time a side has challenged them, they have responded. The closest team to do so being Norwood, when the Tigers came back from a 41-point deficit at half time to pip Norwood by 1 point. As a result, this match is poised to be another blockbuster as both sides adhere to vastly different game plans.

While Glenelg fans may struggle to admit it, a loss prior to finals can be a blessing in disguise. Therefore, in a major upset I believe Norwood's defense will overcome Glenelg and guide them to their first defeat of the year. Norwood by 1-12 points



The Magpies are sitting 6th on the ladder and are just one match and percentage outside the top five. It may seem a bit of a hurdle to overcome to sneak into the top five, but the way the season has been with upsets and unpredictability, I wouldn't count the Magpies out. Port's AFL side in great form and currently in the top four, is making it hard for players to get into the side from the Magpies outfit. One of these players is Hamish Hartlett, who is pushing his claim for an AFL appearance, averaging 22.6 disposals the last three outings. Hartletts' knowledge and experience has been invaluable for the youth of the Port Adelaide team, and they would have been loving the opportunity to learn from a senior player. The youth who are developing nicely for the Magpies are the likes of Jackson mead, Sam Hayes, Joel Garner and Jed McEntee. Mead, Hayes, Garner and McEntee have all featured in the Magpies best players in recent weeks. Hayes has had an outstanding season so far with 484 hit-outs, which is the second-best in the league. The Magpies have only lost the hit-out count once, which is more evidence of the great season Hayes is having. Coach Matthew Lokan will hope his Magpies can keep their finals hopes alive with a good win against the Crows this weekend.

It is looking Highly unlikely the Crows will be playing SANFL finals this season. Even though the Crows sit 8th on the ladder, they still have had a valuable and competitive season. Apart from a couple of outings, the Crows have been in most matches this season. One of their most impressive efforts this season was their 15-point loss to the Bays in round 13, taking it up to the Glenelg side. Adelaide has not lost the hit-out count since round seven and has been one of their strengths throughout the season. Strachan has had an outstanding season and leads the hit-out count in the league with 513, averaging 36 per match. Young players such as Ben Davis, Joshua Worrell, Jackson Hately, Fischer McAsey have all had standout matches this season, with some being rewarded with AFL opportunities. It was a close 14 point match the last time these two teams met in Round 6, and it was the closest margin ever in an SANFL showdown. I am really looking forward to the Hayes and Strachan battle in the ruck, and it will be fascinating to watch. After a two-week hiatus due to COVIDs re-emergence in South Australia, the SANFL is back for Round 16 where Central District will host South Adelaide at X Convenience Oval, Centrals currently sit in 9th and are only really playing for pride as well as trying to avoid the wooden spoon whilst South Adelaide sit in 4th and will be looking to all but lock up a spot in the finals with a win. Both sides are coming off losses in Round 15 so they will be keen to bounce back after having two-weeks to think about what went wrong.

Central District are coming off a 13-point loss to Sturt in a very low scoring affair. This game provided an opportunity for the Bulldogs, facing another side unlikely to make finals, at home, however, they were unable to get the job done and ultimately couldn't reel the Double Blues in after they made a hot start. Sturt led by 3 goals at half-time which proved too much in the end even though they only managed to kick one more goal for the rest of the game. The rain stayed away for much of the game, so it was interesting just how low scoring it was but nevertheless Centrals didn't quite have the firepower to get the job done. Sturt dominated in the ruck; however, the Bulldogs were better on the clearance front which should have allowed them to put create more attacking pushes than their opposition. Both sides had 32 inside 50s so it came down to who could be more clinical and efficient when their chances came and ultimately it was Sturt who came out on top. Kyle Presbury was massive all day and was one of the best on ground with 34 disposals, however, he didn't have enough support with the next best possession winner being Justin Hoskin with 21. Their goalkickers included Brett Kennedy, Connor Mclean, and Jarrod Schiller, all kicking 1 apiece.

South Adelaide on-the-other-hand have lost 2 of their last 3 with both losses coming against the top 2 teams in Woodville-West Torrens and most recently, Glenelg. This game against Glenelg provided a chance to give the Bays their first loss of the season, however, Glenelg never looked like losing. The Bays got out to a 30-point lead halfway through the second term before the Panthers reeled it back to 6 points a couple of times throughout the last quarter, however, Glenelg were able to continuously kick away and ended up with an 18-point win. The Panthers played a largely kick based game compared to Glenelg, but they still lost the mark count which shows that a lot of their disposals weren't effective enough to create good looks inside 50 or in front of goal. This ultimately showed with the inside 50 stats as both sides had similar number of entries, however, Glenelg were able to generate better scoring chances which allowed them a far better chance to kick a winning score. Experienced duo Bryce Gibbs (27 disposals and 14 tackles) and Matthew Broadbent (24 disposals) led the way like usual while there were 8 individual goal kickers which would be pleasing to see.

In recent history, South Adelaide have won 4 of their last 5 encounters and won their most recent encounter this year by 28 points. Centrals started this game well and led for most of the first half until the Panthers turned it on and ran away with a comfortable win. Again, Bryce Gibbs and Matthew Broadbent were huge with 36 and 34 disposals respectively for South Adelaide while Nick Lange was good for the Bulldogs with 4 goals. This game looks to be heading in the same direction with the Panthers keen to make a statement to the rest of the finals contenders.





Who Will Be The Sixth 400-Gamer?

In what has been a difficult time for the game in the previous two weeks, with COVID-19 once again causing havoc on the AFL Season, it was a weekend of celebration for the great Shaun Burgoyne. On Saturday night, 'Silk' became the fifth player in the game's 163-year history to reach the 400-game milestone, and the first Indigenous player to notch the quadruple century.

For just five players to reach this incredible achievement in almost two centuries goes to show what is required; a strong work ethic, dedication, resilience and a hint of good luck with health and injury along the way.

There are many players currently in the league who are somewhat within striking distance of the 400 game mark. However, with form issues, injury concerns and the possibilities of game-time and/or positions on lists being compromised in the future due to rebuilding and money-saving, some are more likely than others.

I have identified three players who are the most likely to reach that elusive 400 game milestone;

1. David Mundy

Current Games Played: 347

Games Required: 53

For so long many out of Perth would barely give David Mundy a mention, but now the Victorian-born midfielder is certainly up there as one of the finest footballers to ever come out of a Western Australian club. From his first season in 2005, Mundy has held an unquestionable position in Fremantle's best 22 and has rarely disappointed. A best and fairest in 2010 and All Australian in 2015, and a selection in Fremantle's 2013 Grand Final are among his greatest achievements on field. At the age of 35, the former captain is playing as well as ever, averaging 25 possessions, five clearances and four tackles, all of which are considered above average for AFL standard. For David Mundy to reach 400 games, he would need to play majority of this season's remaining games at least two more full seasons, a final or two would help boost those games up. It seems far-fetched, but if he continues at the rate he is now... why couldn't he?

Only seven games away from over taking Matthew Pavlich's club record for most games played.

2. Joel Selwood

Current Games Played: 325 Games Remaining: 75

The captain of the Geelong Football Club has been the epitome of hard work, dedication, and an unbelievable success rate. Since debuting in 2007, where he won the NAB Rising Star award, he has played in five Grand

Finals, won four Premierships, three best and fairest awards, six All Australians and four times the most courageous player, he has also only ever missed the finals on one occasion in 2015. Only once in his fifteen seasons has he played less than 20 games a year, he has been able to escape serious injury for so much of his career and has never been dropped.

However, Selwood's courage to go back with the flight of the ball and unflinchingly dive into packs has resulted in concussions and head injuries. His biggest strength is also his biggest weakness, and this is the only concern in not reaching 400. With Geelong's premiership window wide-open for the next few seasons and with Selwood form still certainly apt to remain in the side, he would certainly be expected to at least get very close.

For Joel Selwood to reach 400 games, he would need to play until at least another three seasons, playing at least 20 games every campaign. By that stage he would be 36 years old, if he stays injury free and avoids anymore concussion issues, there is absolutely no reason it cannot happen.

3. Dustin Martin

Games Played: 258 Games Remaining: 142

This one may, but should not, come as a surprise. While Dustin Martin still has at least six seasons plus a few finals required to reach 400, he has proven to be one of the most consistent and durable players we have seen... possibly ever.

Since debuting for the Tigers in 2010, Martin has never played less than 20 games in a season. From round one 2010, he has always been one of Richmond's most important players and a main stay in the midfield. He has avoided injury through most of his career and become one of the greatest players in the game's history. Three premierships, three Norm Smith Medals and a Brownlow Medal put him in the elite category in every sense. Football is his life, he loves the game of there does not seem to be any obvious reason why he would give the game up until he exhausts everything he has, and he still has many years to come with a lengthy contract not expiring until 2024, which would be expected to be extended.

For Dustin Martin to reach 400 games, he would need to play until at least 2027. At this stage he would be 36 years of age and I cannot see any reason why this is an unrealistic prospect. He is arguable in career best form, tearing up the midfield with his strength, ability to shake players of and that powerful, penetrating kick.

TEAM TALK with JORDAN

The Cattery

2007 was the year that Geelong became the powerhouse that they are known as today. After years of underachieving failing to become that powerful team that they always threatened to be they finally turned it around by not only having developed an ominous high attacking game style that wielded three premierships in five years, but they made their home ground Kardinia Park (it has had many different names over the years) the unbreakable fortress that many a team have





now come to fear when they play there. In modern day football, every little bit counts, and the Cats have known that better than most teams. We all talk about fortresses when dominant teams seem even more powerful and even invincible on their home decks, but no team has ever had as pronounced a home ground advantage as Geelong has had at Kardinia Park. Footy pundits and critics have long since given up quoting the numbers, they've just accepted the fact that it's near on impossible to win there.

Before Geelong turned there fortunes around some 14 years ago, they famously lost a match to North Melbourne at Kardinia Park in what became the "line in the sand" moment for them. Not only was the playing group called into question but the club as a whole, culture administration, coaches all of it. They then destroyed an abysmal Richmond by 157 points at the Telstra Dome (now called Marvel Stadium) and from then have never ever looked back. As mentioned above, since then Geelong entered a golden era yielding three flags, playing in 5 grand finals and further 10 preliminary finals which is incredibly impressive. None of those games have been played at their home ground which is affectionately called "The Cattery" but it sure has played a major part in the club's consistent dominance over the competition. Since that loss to the Kangaroos in 2007 and as of the 2021 season, Geelong has played a total of 108 games at Kardinia Park. They've won an astonishing 97 of those, 97! Only 11 losses which is incredible, and their winning strike rate is 89.9%. The sheer key factors in the dominance that Geelong has there are teams that have relative unfamiliarity in which no visiting team ever playing there more than once per season and some of the bigger drawing Victorian clubs such as Hawthorn, Carlton and Richmond only playing there very occasionally, like once or twice in 12 years. The unique dimensions of the ground in my opinion play the biggest part.

Kardinia Park is only just the longest ground of any of the current AFL stadiums at 167 metres only a metre longer than Adelaide Oval, two metres more than Optus Stadium in Perth and five metres more than the MCG. It is significantly narrower than any of the other grounds however which is the most unique aspect of the grounds landscape. At just a measly 112 metres wing-to-wing, it is 27 metres skinnier than the MCG and that near 30 metres difference to the MCG is as good as one less kick for sides trying to switch the play side to side and make the ground bigger. It's no wonder teams have struggled and often have found themselves kicking the ball out on the full more than usual when they play at the cat's home ground. It's also Geelong's incredible defensive qualities that really shine through effectively smothering the opposition into turning it over and having all defensive lines covered effectively roadblocking half the ground. Considering how many teams have struggled there over the years, there are a few sides that boast somewhat of a half decent record there in recent times. Sydney has taken the cat scalp there 4 times in the last few years and had a 3-game winning streak there and Fremantle famously beat the cats in the first and only to date final played at the ground, the 2013 qualifying final, the dockers also beat them there again in 2015. For every other team it is the dreaded travel across there to face impending death. Of the 97 wins, 31 of those has been by a minimum of 10 goals and a further 8 has been by 100 points or more. Now that is some sort of dominance and it doesn't look like diminishing any time soon.


