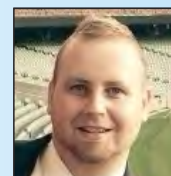

Gallant Crows fall short in Showdown 50

A week from hell. An apt description of what the Adelaide Crows dealt with in the leadup to Showdown 50. With Taylor Walker fined and suspended for six matches for a racial slur at an SANFL match last month and the Crows occupying 16th position on the ladder, you could be forgiven for fearing the worst for what lay ahead in the clash with the cross-town rival.

Instead, the Crows produced one of their liveliest and valiant performances of the season to go down to the Power by only four points. The Crows were fierce around the contest and the lethargic Power looked well off the pace. Port kicked the first goal of the contest, but it would be their only goal in the first half. Adelaide led by a point at quarter time before extending the lead to 19 points at the half time break, Ned McHenry kicking the last two goals of the term.

An enthralling third quarter saw both sides have opportunities to impact the scoreboard as Port got more a foothold in the game and the margin was reduced to 10 points at the final change.

Brodie Smith was subbed out of the game late in the third term and the Crows lost defender Will Hammill at the start of the fourth to concussion. Despite chances late, a three goal to one last quarter was enough for Port to hang on. Aliir Allir was comfortably the best man on the ground and Willem Drew was the pick of the Port midfielders, but the Crows had plenty of good contributors.

Harry Schoenberg, Rory Laird and Paul Seedsman were the top possession winners on the ground and Jordon Butts completely outplayed Charlie Dixon. Brayden Cook did not disappoint in his AFL debut gathering 17 disposals, three clearances and two score involvements. Despite the loss Senior Coach Matthew Nicks was extremely proud of his team's effort after the game.

An AA class Showdown

Expect the unexpected and red hot favourites Adelaide were up for the fight winning the ball in the trenches at a dewy Adelaide Oval. Port Adelaide Power withstood a stern and superb Crows challenge to edge out an Aliir-led four-point win 7.13 (55) to 7.9 (51) win.

Sydney Swans, who had lost to St Kilda, in another upset on this same evening, gave up Aliir to Port and he made sure the Swans lost in more ways than one. Aliir dominated at centre half back with 10 marks, 21 possessions and the Showdown Medal. He also took the final mark of the game as a surging Chayce Jones out of the Crows defence failed to hit up any of the free Crow players leading toward him. Jones', so defiant all night, kick only found Aliir.

Game over. However, earlier in the evening, it was as if the gravity of the situation - and with a double-chance top four position almost guaranteed with a win against the 'old enemy', was too much as the Crows little 'terrier pest' Ned McHenry strolled into an open goal for his second goal in the second quarter.

Adelaide up by 20 points. But class started to come through. The dancing feet of Connor Rozee, quick hands by Robbie Gray culminated to a bending goal by Sam Powell-Pepper in the frenetic final term that gave Port the lead. Big Charlie Dixon, 'Sam Taylored' by emerging Adelaide key defender Jordan Butts, rose to make it his moment to mark and put the Power 10-points clear. But the Crows' never-say-die' attitude produced a Tom Lynch snap to keep Adelaide in the game.

Port defended grimly against a side that was down two men - Brodie Smith and Will Hamill - both with concussion. That defence also earned Port Adelaide a two-game buffer inside the top-four with two minor round games left. 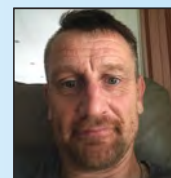

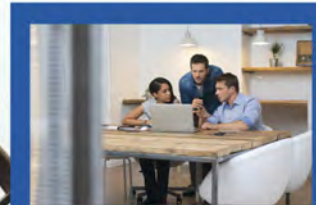

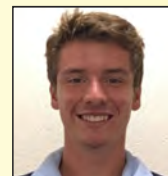
Norwood v West Adelaide

Unfortunately for the West Adelaide this was not an uncharacteristic loss, as the Bloods have not tasted blood for over three months. Conversely, Norwood have lost 3 of their last four games, as they desperately try to cling onto a top 5 spot to make a finals birth. As such the match is poised to be entertaining, because despite the Redleg's ladder ascendency, West Adelaide will feel confident they can defeat Norwood and break out of their losing rut.

While West Adelaide would love to desperately break their 10-game losing streak, Norwood will live by the ageless football cliché this week; "we have more to play for." Norwood are fifth with Port Adelaide and Sturt breathing down their neck, as these teams sit one game outside the five. Further, if Norwood dropped this game to the bottomless Blood's and Sturt won, Norwood would exit the top 5 for the first time this season. The epicenter of the Redleg's issues lies within their ball use. In three of the past four weeks Norwood have won the inside 50-count, however their poor ball use has damaged their ability to score. In these weeks the Redleg's have collectively had 191 inside 50's. Yet, they have only kicked 30 goals, meaning for every inside 50 they are a 15 per cent chance of kicking a goal. Comparatively, their opponents have scored 38 goals from only 162 inside 50's (24 per cent likelihood). This is of great concern to Norwood coach Jade Rawlings, as they have had an inferior disposal efficiency in all of their losses in the past month. Evidently, this is enabling opposition sides to score from turnovers and in turn make Norwood's scoring more difficult.

Despite Norwood having a dismal win-loss record throughout the last month, red and blue fans should not be ringing alarm bells just yet. The Redleg's three losses have come against Sturt, Glenelg and Woodville. Glenelg and Woodville are first and second and have maintained a quality brand of football, while Sturt are in tremendous form. Although Rawlings and his playing side will be disheartened through a lack of wins, they have lost to arguably the three form teams of the competition.


In contrast, West Adelaide do not have such excuses for their losses. In last weeks match the Blood's failed to register a goal. Against an established side such as Norwood, this will need to be quickly rectified if they are to win. Over the past month a major source of their many problems has been a failure to win possession, as they have had less disposals than the opposition in every game over the last month. Subsequently, teams have been able to manipulate the speed of play by controlling the ball through a series of uncontested marks. Since Round 12 opposition teams have taken 502 marks to West Adelaide's 397. A 105 mark differential! The only silver lining to coach Brad Gotch's season, has been the blossoming of both new and experienced players in that of Kaine Stevens, Jordon Boyle and Thomas Murphy, who are all averaging over 20 disposals at above 80 per cent efficiency. In order for the Bloods to upset Norwood, these players will have to find something special to lift the rest of their team.

The last time these sides met Norwood were embarrassed, losing by 18 points to the bottom sitting West Adelaide. Unfortunately for Red and Black supporters one would find it difficult to imagine the Blood's reciprocating this Round 4 game. **Norwood by 37-48 points**

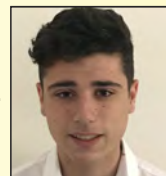

Fraser Fort kicked two goals and midfielder Kyle Presbury was in stellar form and a shining light in a gloomy day for Centrals as he collected 31 disposals with nine marks.

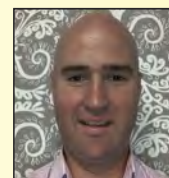

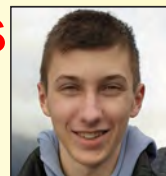
Sturt v Port Adelaide

Who Will Be The Sixth 400-Gamer?

In what has been a difficult time for the game in the previous two weeks, with COVID-19 once again causing havoc on the AFL Season, it was a weekend of celebration for the great Shaun Burgoyne. On Saturday night, 'Silk' became the fifth player in the game's 163-year history to reach the 400-game milestone, and the first Indigenous player to notch the quadruple century.

For just five players to reach this incredible achievement in almost two centuries goes to show what is required; a strong work ethic, dedication, resilience and a hint of good luck with health and injury along the way.

There are many players currently in the league who are somewhat within striking distance of the 400 game mark. However, with form issues, injury concerns and the possibilities of game-time and/or positions on lists being compromised in the future due to rebuilding and money-saving, some are more likely than others.

I have identified three players who are the most likely to reach that elusive 400 game milestone;

1. David Mundy

Current Games Played: 347

Games Required: 53

For so long many out of Perth would barely give David Mundy a mention, but now the Victorian-born midfielder is certainly up there as one of the finest footballers to ever come out of a Western Australian club. From his first season in 2005, Mundy has held an unquestionable position in Fremantle's best 22 and has rarely disappointed. A best and fairest in 2010 and All Australian in 2015, and a selection in Fremantle's 2013 Grand Final are among his greatest achievements on field. At the age of 35, the former captain is playing as well as ever, averaging 25 possessions, five clearances and four tackles, all of which are considered above average for AFL standard. For David Mundy to reach 400 games, he would need to play majority of this season's remaining games at least two more full seasons, a final or two would help boost those games up. It seems far-fetched, but if he continues at the rate he is now... why couldn't he?

Only seven games away from over taking Matthew Pavlich's club record for most games played.

2. Joel Selwood

Current Games Played: 325

The captain of the Geelong Football Club has been the epitome of hard work, dedication, and an unbelievable success rate. Since debuting in 2007, where he won the NAB Rising Star award, he has played in five Grand

Finals, won four Premierships, three best and fairest awards, six All Australians and four times the most courageous player, he has also only ever missed the finals on one occasion in 2015. Only once in his fifteen seasons has he played less than 20 games a year, he has been able to escape serious injury for so much of his career and has never been dropped.

However, Selwood's courage to go back with the flight of the ball and unflinchingly dive into packs has resulted in concussions and head injuries. His biggest strength is also his biggest weakness, and this is the only concern in not reaching 400. With Geelong's premiership window wide-open for the next few seasons and with Selwood form still certainly apt to remain in the side, he would certainly be expected to at least get very close.

For Joel Selwood to reach 400 games, he would need to play until at least another three seasons, playing at least 20 games every campaign. By that stage he would be 36 years old, if he stays injury free and avoids anymore concussion issues, there is absolutely no reason it cannot happen.

3. Dustin Martin

Games Played: 258

Games Remaining: 142

This one may, but should not, come as a surprise. While Dustin Martin still has at least six seasons plus a few finals required to reach 400, he has proven to be one of the most consistent and durable players we have seen... possibly ever.

Since debuting for the Tigers in 2010, Martin has never played less than 20 games in a season. From round one 2010, he has always been one of Richmond's most important players and a main stay in the midfield. He has avoided injury through most of his career and become one of the greatest players in the game's history. Three premierships, three Norm Smith Medals and a Brownlow Medal put him in the elite category in every sense. Football is his life, he loves the game of there does not seem to be any obvious reason why he would give the game up until he exhausts everything he has, and he still has many years to come with a lengthy contract not expiring until 2024, which would be expected to be extended.

For Dustin Martin to reach 400 games, he would need to play until at least 2027. At this stage he would be 36 years of age and I cannot see any reason why this is an unrealistic prospect. He is arguable in career best form, tearing up the midfield with his strength, ability to shake players of and that powerful, penetrating kick.
