

Crows claim famous Showdown victory

Gun recruit Jordan Dawson has secured Adelaide's first victory of the season with an after the siren goal that will go down in Showdown folklore and condemned Port Adelaide to a 0-3 start to the 2022 season.

As expected, the intensity in the first quarter was off the charts with both teams desperate but it was Port Adelaide who took a 19-point lead into the first change.

At different times the Power threatened to kick away but poor finishing coupled with the Crows great resilience and character allowed them to remain in the contest throughout.

Adelaide would outscore their crosstown rival in each of the last three quarters of the game and kicked the last four goals of the match against a panicky Power outfit to secure a remarkable victory amid scenes of pandemonium.

Dawson rightfully will take a lot of credit for the final goal from the free kick awarded to Lachlan Murphy, but the former Swan was immense all game.

A return of 24 disposals, two goals and five score involvements rightly rewarded with the Showdown Medal as best player afield.

The usual suspects Matt Crouch & Ben Keays got plenty of the ball and the returning Rory Laird was the highest disposal winner on the ground gathering 31 touches.

In only his third AFL game Lachlan Gollant kicked four goals while the much-maligned Elliot Himmelberg also booted a career high four goals to keep the critics at bay.

Taylor Walker will be available for selection this week after serving a six-game suspension and Skipper Rory Sloane who missed the Showdown with injury also in the frame to return.





In round two, Port will be looking to avoid another dreadful start to the season. This would build from last year, where they won only one of the first four games. In round one, the Power was out. Port Adelaide coach, Matthew Lokan's side were beaten in all the key areas. They lost disposals, marks, clearances, scoring accuracy and inside 50's. The latter of which being most important, as they conceded 65 inside 50's, despite having 46 rebound 50's. The power was not able to transition the ball efficiently from the defensive 50 to the offensive 50. This was exacerbated by Adelaide's midfield dominance around the ground. Against South Adelaide, Port cannot afford to be as convincingly demolished in this part of the ground. Port will rely on their experienced players in that of Succliffe, Wilson and Appleton to be competitive with South Adelaide's established midfield. However, as a Power fan it is not all grim. Their loss against Adelaide provided learning opportunities to exciting first game prospects, Jase Burgoyne and Hugh Jackson, who have both been developing their craft at an under 18 level. Burgoyne looked at home, as he had the most disposals for the Power with 22, while Jackson looked dangerous up forward.

In contrast, South Adelaide will be looking to repeat a similar start to last season as they won their first 4 matches. After finishing 5th last season, the Panthers reached the preliminary final. Ruckman, Keegan Brooksby, decimated Centrals winning 41 hit outs, which allowed Magarey medallist, Bryce Gibbs, and his midfield cohort to roam free with 39 clearances. Gibbs finishing with 14. This complemented Jye Menzies debutant four goal performance. Menzies, a Tasmanian draft prospect, looked comfortable forward of the ball. Although the Panthers only narrowly won, they won the statistics battle. Yet, they did not win inside 50's. While they were able to score from clearances and rebound 50's, coach Jarrod Wright will want to rectify this prior to Saturdays upcoming match.

The last time these two sides met Port Adelaide were 13-point victors. Unfortunately, for Port fans the evidence suggests this was an anomalous win. As a result of the Power's inexperience and South Adelaide's strength across the ground, the Panthers come into the game as clear favourites. Further, due to South Adelaide's established midfield, Port will not be able to compete for four quarters.
