





We lost by about 200 points, and personally I could neither stem the tide from half back, nor turn it, from in the ruck, after twelve years a slave to volleyball on a Saturday. I'm heading right back there.

I've not watched enough footy in the last month to comment truthfully on who will bag out this weekend, in the opening game of round six, though I suspect it'll come from West Lakes sooner than West Adelaide.

It's The Bloods against the Crows Reserves; West Adelaide, winless, the SANFL Crows, shy of top spot by less than one quarter of one percentage point.

In the AFL round just gone, the Power found something from nothing, and the Crows were themselves in need of the tarps at half-time.

I am hardly suggesting this change of fortunes will happen on Saturday at Hisense Stadium. West Adelaide took a toweling from North, largely occurring after half time as the Roosters became steadily more accurate in attack.

Consequently, North Adelaide sit pretty at the top of the ladder. This is a good thing, as I've already mentioned, because their fadeout to 2021 was heaps bitter.

We are still waiting for West Adelaide to fade in. Three goalkickers on the weekend was all they could muster, from a clearance count they lost by 20 and an inside-50 count they lost by 35. It was however only two (long) weekends ago that they went toe-to-toe with their inner-west rivals, reeling in the wayward Eagles on several important occasions, forcing a contest from a well-earned share of the footy.

Four minutes of Menzel au début was all that came between them.

That match is a rare recent highlight and should be kept close to heart. Football games aren't won on paper, but the sheet of paper with injuries on it is glaring for West Adelaide, with several players exposed to COVID for awful measure.

Quads, knees, 'strings, heads, and broken bones are all plaguing the Bloods.

Adelaide are by contrast fresh and firing at Reserves level and shrugged off South Adelaide in a fantastic contest down south on the weekend. The Panthers only led in the second half, kicking four straight goals, across the big break, in what was a deserved momentum swing for the home team.

However, the Crows held firm, and then the Fog put them back in front. He was joined by another now-familiar AFL name in James Rowe, who had 25 touches, five inside-50s and a goal to be named the Coles valuable player in what was certainly a valuable win.

West Adelaide were on the mark two weeks ago, and only truly off it for one scoreless second-quarter this weekend just gone. I trust they enjoyed their trip to Port Lincoln despite the result, and after a week's break for everyone next week, they're off to Loxton again, to face a faltering Port Adelaide.

Should they get through this weekend's matchup with the Crows Reserves relatively unscathed, having provided a contest for the home fans to enjoy, there ain't no reason they can't draw blood against Port in a couple weeks' time, and sing that song we've not heard often enough.

Glenelg get back to winning ways with a trip to Prospect

Round 6 of the SANFL season sees a blockbuster game taking place between two of the best sides in the competition, North Adelaide and Glenelg from Prospect Oval. North Adelaide is coming off a commanding few weeks, most recently dismantling West Adelaide away. Glenelg won their first 4 games of the season, however, like last year, it was the old foe Port Adelaide that ended their unbeaten run.

The scoreboard reads a 70-point victory to North Adelaide, however, most of this came after quarter time, with West Adelaide actually leading at the first break. This was largely due to North's inaccuracy, kicking 1.6, but they soon tidied that up and ran away with a convincing win. North ended with double the clearances and inside 50s than that of the Bloods which shows just how dominant they were. West Adelaide only managed to score 35 points which shows how North's efficiency offensively wasn't the only reason they won. It was also a very even performance by all players with only 3 players getting under 10 disposals. Campbell Combe was the best, however, with 30 disposals, 12 clearances and a goal while Harrison Elbrow had 23 touches and kicked 2 goals. Jacob Bauer led the way in the forward line with 3 goals, while Will Combe and Nigel Lockyer joined Elbrow with 2 goals.

Glenelg, on-the-other-hand, are coming off a thrilling 3-point loss to Port Adelaide after a flying first month of the season. Not many would have seen this coming considering both sides were at the opposite ends of the ladder, with Port yet to register a win prior to this game which will make it even more disappointing for Glenelg. Port got the early jump on Glenelg leading by 19 points at quarter time. Glenelg then trailed by more or less a goal for the rest of the match before getting within a point at three quarter time. The margin stayed like this for the whole last quarter before Hugh Stagg missed a late shot to ensure a 3-point win for Port Adelaide. What will make the loss more disappointing is the fact that Glenelg dominated clearances but couldn't translate that into inside 50s with that stat just about being breakeven. The usual suspects were great again for Glenelg with Luke Partington racking up 35 disposals, 10 tackles and 9 clearances. Max Proud and Matthew Snook were also good with 25 disposals each. As usual, Lachie Hosie was in fine form, kicking 5 goals, with 3 of them coming late in the game when it was on the line.

Over the past few years these two sides have faced off in some great games with Glenelg winning 4 of the last 5, with the other game being a draw. Last year Glenelg won both encounters and won by 31 points at their meeting at Prospect Oval. On that day Glenelg got out of the blocks fast, leading by 4 goals at quarter time before North Adelaide stormed until three quarter time, where Glenelg ran away with it. On that day Liam McBean kicked 5 goals and Luke Partington had 35 disposals, while Aaron Young and Campbell Combe were the best for North Adelaide with 24 and 26 disposals respectively. I expect Glenelg to bounce back after a disappointing result last weekend with a win away from home in North Adelaide.

Norwood to ruin Panther Parade at the Parade

South Adelaide will travel to The Parade this week to play Norwood in a middle of the table clash. Both clubs currently sit outside the top 5 with a record of two wins and three losses. After both sides made finals last season, they are yet to find their form this year. Norwood have beaten the teams they have needed to (West Adelaide and Port Adelaide), while the Panthers have beaten Central Districts and Port Adelaide. The last time



these two sides met was in a semi-final last season, where the Panthers were 19-point victors. As such, this game is poised to be close as both teams enter with similar sides and the same record.

After making the preliminary final last year, South Adelaide have been disappointing the past three weeks. They have lost to North Adelaide, Sturt and Adelaide. However, they have arguably been disappointing all season, as they only narrowly beat Central districts and Port Adelaide. In these wins it was their greater accuracy which enabled them to win, as both Centrals and Port had more scoring shots than the Panthers. Nevertheless, they come into this weeks clash on the same record as their opposition.

While they have lost, the Panthers have executed much of their game plan during the past three weeks. They have produced a total of 151 inside 50's. Former Hawthorn coach, Alastair Clarkson, regularly made a note that teams with 50 or more inside 50's rarely lose games. Unfortunately, these inside 50 entries have been poorly executed. The panthers have only kicked 26 goals from these inside 50's. This is reflected through the club's disposal efficiency in rounds 3-5, which is at 78 per cent. While this is a relatively efficient, it is not elite. Surprisingly, the Panthers have also lost clearances the past two weeks. With Magarey medallist, Bryce Gibbs alongside, Mitch O'Neill and Hayden Sampson, this would be of great disappointment to Panther fans. If they are to win, they will need to rectify these elements this week.

Conversely, Norwood are yet to impose themselves on the competition. While being competitive with Glenelg and Woodville, the Redlegs have ultimately not been able to beat sides above them. On the weekends loss to Sturt, Norwood looked a formidable team. They conceded more clearances, inside 50's and hit outs than the opposition. Norwood's ball use was also relatively ineffective. They had 323 disposals for only 42 inside 50's. Although the Panthers have not been in terrific form, these areas will need to be rectified, otherwise they could be staring down the barrel of a 2-4 start. Norwood coach, Jade Rawlings will call on his experienced players this week to win the midfield battle against South Adelaide. The normal culprits in that of Rokahr, Nunn and Kennerly will all have to be influential if Norwood are to win.

Neither side has demonstrated they are genuine premiership threats. However, this game will likely be match of the round. Two teams with the same record. One looking for vengeance from the semi-final last year, while the other trying to get their season on track after three consecutive losses, this match will have everything a football fan wants. There is very little which separates these two sides, but it will ultimately come down to the team that shows greater endeavour that will win. While either team can win, Norwood's constant ability to influence a game and the key statistics will ultimately hold them in better stead come the final siren.
