





Crows Capitalise on Complacent Eagles

As the seasons end fast approaches, vacancies in the top five are beginning to diminish. Therefore, this week's contest between Adelaide and Woodville-West Torrens is pivotal in the context of the season. Can the reigning premiers, Woodville scrape their way to a finals berth or will they be rejected by a consistent Adelaide side who are battling for a double chance? The Eagles past two months have been bleak. They have won only two

of their last six matches. Comparatively, Adelaide has won four of their last six. This contrast between the two sides has been apparent all season as the Crows have constantly shown promise, while Woodville has continually battled for finals contention.

The Eagles are one win outside the top five. They play Adelaide, Sturt and South Adelaide in their run home. Three season defining games. Three games that could go either way. On the weekend Woodville were 48-point losers to a wounded North Adelaide side. The Eagles were beaten in nearly every aspect of match play. They convincingly lost the disposal count, marks, disposal efficiency, tackles, clearances and inside 50's. Had North Adelaide have capitalised better, they would have won by over 10 goals. The Eagles have a tendency to overuse the football. In their four respective losses, in the last six games, they have had less kicks than the opposition every match. Interestingly, they had more handballs in each of these losses. They are electing to run the football, as opposed to playing direct effective football, which massively contributed to them winning last seasons grand final. Further, the Eagles have been ineffective in their transition to the forward half as they have lost disposal efficiency in such losses. Woodville also lost marks, contested marks, tackles and inside 50's over this period. This exemplifies that their recent form has not been to the standard the competition demands. As such, coach Micheal Godden will call upon his experience Riley Knight, Menzel, Goldsworthy and Firns to get them out of this form slump. There are great weaknesses in their game which they will need to quickly rectify if they are to defeat one of the strongest sides in the competition.

Although Adelaide lost on the weekend, they have been impressive this season. They currently sit third, and with a potential top two finish they are looking one of the danger sides of the competition. The Crows have the highest score for in the SANFL. This forward arsenal the Crows possess will make the Eagles nervous, as the Eagles have the highest score against, out of the top seven teams. Through the AFL talent in that of Rowe, Himmelberg, Wright and Frampton, who are irregularly in the league side, Adelaide has the most potent forward line in the competition. In the last three weeks Adelaide's scoring accuracy has been higher than their opposition. Despite having an unpredictable line up every week, due to AFL selection, the Crows have been one of the most consistent sides. They have not slipped below third all season. If they can win on the weekend, they will likely surpass Glenelg or North Adelaide with their superior percentage.

The last time these sides met, the Crows were 33-point victors. While the Eagles season teeters on this match, the likelihood of them winning is low. They will need to ultimately fix six separate areas of their game: efficiency, control, ball winning, contested football, overuse and inside 50's. As most ships will be able to tell you, a bail can only remove so much water out of a sinking ship. As such, Adelaide should win this game in clinical fashion.




