



It's down time as Port clock out 2022

It's official.

After a season of missed opportunities, Port Adelaide Power have clocked out with two regulation games of the season remaining.



Conversely, the Richmond Tigers have almost assured itself of a finals berth after dismantling the Power at a wet and windy Adelaide Oval 16.13 (109) to 10.11 (71) as power forward Tom Lynch and the mercurial Shai Bolton booted four goals apiece.

The first half was a typical Port v Richmond tight affair but it was the third quarter when the Tigers effectively clocked into finals mode and the hosts checked out with 'downtime'. The 2017, 2019-20 premiers kicked 7.4 to 3.3 in the premiership term.

Brownlow Medallist Ollie Wines and lion-hearted Travis Boak were the Power's best players by far while Charlie Dixon and Jeremy Finlayson alternated between being key forward pillars - in the absence of Todd Marshall (COVID protocol) - and stints in ruck against impressive Toby Nankervis.

Midfield gun Connor Rozee's knee injury impacted his game after he had strung together two months of 'top three best player games' for the Power.

It was the lack of height and the Tigers' superior wet-weather ball handling skills that was the massive difference between the teams. The home loss again puts mounting pressure on Port Adelaide coach Ken Hinkley after the team lost its fourth game on the trot and fifth Power failure in six games. He said Richmond feasted on the big moments while the Power wilted.

"There were some critical parts of the game that we were beaten badly in," Hinkley said. "We had plenty of opportunities but in the contest itself, they were cleaner with the ball, they were certainly more effective away with the ball, they were able to take territory off us, which is a really big part of our game and we usually do it reasonably well. "Richmond was able to be stronger and better organised around the ball than us. "We played a game that was pretty good until half time and then they were able to dominate the game to take the game away from us. "They gave us some turnovers but they had more polish and they were certainly able to put more scoreboard pressure on us."

Panthers Produce Power Outage

In a dead rubber contest, Port Adelaide will play South Adelaide this week. Both sides cannot play finals, nor can they get the illustrious wooden spoon. The Power sit ninth on the ladder, with only potential to elevate to eighth, while South Adelaide are seventh. Although the Panthers mathematically can still make the top 5, they will need a Steven Bradbury-like miracle. The last time these sides met, the Panthers were 10-point victors. While both these sides are essentially playing for nothing, the contest is poised to be excruciatingly close.

South Adelaide have been mediocre in season 2022. In their most recent clash, South Adelaide were defeated by bottom of the ladder West Adelaide. This was their ninth loss of the season and their twelfth game decided by under two goals. Despite the Panthers poor win-loss ratio, their season could have been vastly different. South Adelaide's average losing margin is 15. When push has come to shove, the Panthers have been unexceptional. In the weekends loss, South were convincingly beaten around the football as their opposition had 67 more disposals and four more clearances. This has become a concern for coach Jarrad Wright, as the Panthers have had fewer disposals than their opposition two of the past three weeks. Similarly, South Adelaide's application of pressure has been secondary, losing the tackle count two of the last three weeks. Surprisingly, the Panthers have had more inside 50's than their opposition in this time frame. Through Sampson, Broadbent, Haines and Brooksby the Panthers have driven the ball forward. Unfortunately, South Adelaide are only an average side at converting such inside 50's into major scores. In fact, this directly reflects South Adelaide's ladder position as they are the seventh best side at converting inside 50's into goals. If the Panthers are to beat the Power, they will need to rectify their inefficiency in the forward half and their lack of pressure on the ball carrier.

Comparatively, the Power have won four matches this season. These four matches have been useful reprieve to what has been a dismal season. Unfortunately, Port fans have had little to cheer about in the past seven matches winning only one match. In recent weeks, the Port Adelaide defence has been far from impenetrable as their average score against (in the past seven games) has been 87. The average winning margin in the AFL last season was 67. Further, the bleeding in the Port Adelaide game is not strictly in defence. The Power have the lowest score for in the entire competition. In the past month, Port Adelaide have kicked 29 goals. Of these 29 goals, there have been 16 different goal kickers. This is arguably promising as multiple players are getting involved in the scoring. However, it is also a sign that the Power have an unsettled forward structure and as such have failed to effectively kick goals despite an adequate supply (189 inside 50's over this four-week period).

Both sides have fundamental weaknesses in their game. Yet while the Panthers do recognise they have major limitations, their ability to compete with the premier sides has been admirable. In contrast, the Power have been inconsistent with both the top and bottom sides. Therefore, due to Port Adelaide's inconsistency coupled with their innate inability to score and prevent scores, they will not win. Instead, the Panthers will likely ensure victory.

The penultimate round of the 2022 SANFL home and away season heads to Prospect Oval for a clash between North Adelaide and West Adelaide, two sides at opposite ends of the table. North sit a game clear in first with

12 wins while West Adelaide sit a game clear in last with 2 wins. A win for North could see them take out the minor premiership if Adelaide loses, however, more realistically will see them move 1 game away from securing it.

North Adelaide is coming off a very convincing win away from home against Glenelg in what was a 1st vs 2nd clash heading into it. The game started off relatively close with Glenelg leading by 7 points at quarter time. After that, however, it was one way traffic with the Roosters kicking 11.6 to 4.6 over the next two quarters to easily run away with a 51-point win. Glenelg were very wayward all day ending up with 7 goals and 15 behinds which stopped them from keeping the game close and therefore giving themselves a chance. All of the key stats were only slightly in North Adelaide's favour showing how much accuracy played a factor. Campbell Combe was terrific all day, finishing with 26 disposals, 8 clearances and a whopping 20 tackles. Aaron Young was also at his best with 27 disposals, 9 inside 50s and 2 goals. Up forward Nigel Lockyer was instrumental with 4 goals while Frank Szekely and Tyson Brazel both kicked 3 each as well.

West Adelaide is also coming off a great result, recording their 2nd win of the season over South Adelaide at Hisense Stadium. The game started off close with West Adelaide leading by 6 points at the main break. South Adelaide then kicked away to lead by as much as 26 points 5 minutes into the last quarter. From there the Bloods dug deep and managed to kick the last 5 goals of the game to run over the top of the Panthers by 5 points. Like Glenelg, South Adelaide kicked poorly in front of goal all day, finishing with 8.15, and considering this game was far closer, it's fair to say that it was a major contributor in West Adelaide being able to run away with the 2 points. West Adelaide lead clearance but couldn't translate that into more inside 50s with South Adelaide leading that facet of the game. Even with South's inaccuracy, West Adelaide defence held up well and managed to repel a lot of the Panthers' forward entries. Jordon Boyle was the key to that, ending with 34 disposals and 8 rebound 50s while Jackson Edwards had 32 disposals, 9 inside 50s and a goal. Up forward, Josh Gore and Nick Steele were West Adelaide's only multiple goal kickers with 2 apiece.

The recent history between these two sides is very one sided with North Adelaide winning 4 of the last 5 encounters and they have won 4 on the trot to be more specific. Glenelg, who lost to top-of-the-table, North Adelaide by 51 points, in a 16.12 108 to 7.15 57, will be looking to avenge themselves and secure that coveted double-chance with a victory over the Rampaging Redlegs on Friday night. Bays wingman, Matthew Allen (23 disposals, two goals) and veterans Andrew Bradley and Matthew Snook, 19 touches each, were only some of the few positives from a Glenelg outfit, who conceded six goals in the second term whilst only managing 1 goal from 5 shots themselves.

For Norwood, a victory on Friday night would not only propel them into the top-three but it would also mean they will be only 2 points behind league-leaders North Adelaide, with one game to go. The Redlegs also have not defeated Glenelg in their three previous meetings, dating back to last season, so it would be even sweeter of a victory. A victory for the Bays would also secure a top two finish and that coveted double-chance as well as put an end to Norwood's seven-game win streak.

My tip: Norwood by 3 points.
