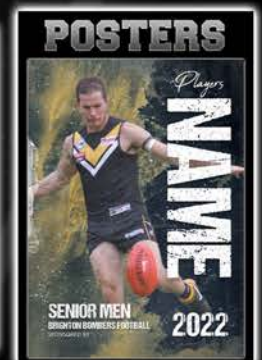

The Adelaide Crows have won three consecutive games for the first time since 2020 with a 29-point win over the Kangaroos at Adelaide Oval.

Any notion the game was going to be a walk in the park on a Saturday afternoon for Adelaide against the bottom placed Roos quickly dismissed in a competitive opening term.

A wasteful Adelaide kicked 4.7 to 3.3 to lead by 10 points before North Melbourne took control of the contest booting five goals in the second term to go into the main break with a slender eight-point lead led by midfield bull Luke Davies-Uniacke.

The game was setup for an exciting finale with scores tied away at three quarter time, but Adelaide regained control booting five goals to nil to run over the top of a spirited North Melbourne.

Darcy Fogarty finished with four goals to take his season tally to 30 from 16 games. Jordan Dawson was superb finishing with 33 disposals and nine score involvements.

Next up Port Adelaide on Saturday Night. Despite both teams missing out on finals it is a huge encounter to finish the year and Port Adelaide will be keen to give Champion Robbie Gray a fitting send-off.

Not that either side needs more motivation but Assistant Coach Scott Burns speaking to media on Monday probably summed up the feeling of many Crow fans. "If you play Port Adelaide twice and you've got a 2-0 record ... you've got a smile on your face from August until February next year"

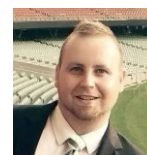

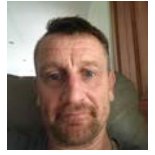

Respectively, Adelaide is second on the ladder, while Port Adelaide are ninth. Second to top versus second to bottom. Despite this ladder contrast, the intensity and pressure in showdown games are finals like. The outcome of this match has major repercussions on the formation of the top three positions. As such, this match is poised to be one to watch.

Adelaide have been impressive this season. If they overcome Port Adelaide, they can potentially become the minor premiers. They have been one of the most consistent sides as they have not slipped below third all season. Coach, Michael Godden's, secret to success has been his forward arsenal. The Crows have the highest score for in the competition. Surprisingly, they only have one player (Matthew Wright), in the top 10 leading goal kickers. Instead, they have got great return from both their key and small forwards, as well as their offensive midfielders such as Himmelberg, Gollant, Hately, Newchurch and Cook. With AFL selection drastically affecting the players Godden must pick from, it has exposed much of their young talent to the elite level. Therefore, on the eve of finals, Godden now has an arsenal of players who can kick multiple goals. Alarmingly for Power fans, they have the second highest score against. This is what happened in round one, when Adelaide defeated Port Adelaide by 63-points, after having 33 scoring shots. In Adelaide's last four games, their game style has been consistent. Despite losing inside 50's in two of these four games, the Crows have had greater scoring accuracy. This efficiency when going forward has allowed Adelaide to be weaker in some areas (tackling, disposal efficiency and clearances), as they can damage teams on offensive turnovers and rebound 50's. Further, Adelaide is the greatest contested marking side in the competition. The Crows have had less marks than their opponents in nine of the past fourteen games. Yet, they have had more contested marks in every one of these games. This allows players to play a faster brand of football and have confidence when kicking to contests. These consistent hallmarks indicate a quality side as they are acutely aware of their strengths and weaknesses.

In contrast, Port Adelaide have been dismal in season 2022. The Power have only scraped four wins. In last weeks clash against South Adelaide, the Powers season went from bad to worse, giving up a 23-point lead in the third quarter. This is reminiscent of their season. Close but not close enough. Port Adelaide have major flaws in their game. Throughout the past seven matches, the Power have had more disposals and marks than their opposition once (same game), been out marked in every game of this period and had a higher scoring efficiency twice. This lack of supply and then the subsequent lack of efficiency has driven a wedge between the Power and the top sides. Although, Port Adelaide rely on a high-pressure tackling game and are competent at inside 50's and clearances, if they allow other sides to dictate the speed of the match, they will lose. As such it is up to their leaders in that of McKenzie, Sutcliffe and Mayes to encourage the use of smart football.

While, these sides are playing two completely different levels of football, it is a showdown. An unpredictable beast of skill, intensity and hunger. If Port can win more of the football at its source and learn to control the ball, they could possibly upset the Crows. However, as much as I can entertain my imagination, the Crows will not lose this game.

Redlegs Red-Hot Run Continues

Round 19 of the Hostplus SANFL season kicks off with the in-form, red-hot Norwood Redlegs, traveling to Richmond Oval to take on a West Adelaide outfit, who, despite losing to North Adelaide, by six points last round, have won two of their last four, defeating Port Adelaide and South Adelaide, respectively. West Adelaide led by 6 points at Quarter-time and 4 points at the main break against the ladder-leading North Adelaide, only to fall agonizingly short of claiming a major scalp, in what ended up being a 10.7 67 to 11.7 73 defeat, at Prospect Oval on Saturday afternoon. Hamish Ellem booted four goals for the visitors, who, despite the loss, would be extremely proud of their efforts and will be hungry to end Norwood's eight-game winning-streak and potentially make them play in an Elimination Final. Former Port Adelaide player, Hamish Hartlett tallied 31 disposals to go with 10 tackles, while Jordan Boyle and Patrick Fairlie racked up 29 each. For North Adelaide, Tyson Brazel, despite having touched the ball a total of 6 times, finished with 2 goals 3, including the vital point in the 25th minute mark of the fourth term, which turned out to be the winning point. 100-gamer, Harrison Wigg finished with 27 disposals and 11 marks as his brilliant season continues, in what could be a Magarey Medal winning year. Former Magarey Medalist, Campbell Coombe, was as impressive as always collecting 17 disposals to go with 9 tackles. Veteran ruck man, Mitchell Harvey was brilliant against a promising young teenager in Oscar Steene, finishing with 22 disposals, 11 clearances, six inside 50s, 17 hit outs and a crucial fourth-quarter goal. Having won two of their last four, West Adelaide, will not be an easy team to beat next week, as they defeated South Adelaide by 5 points in Round 17 and the week before that, only just lost to the Bays by 9 points. The Redlegs, who have won eight games in succession, were made to work against Glenelg, defeating them 7.7 49 to 6.6 42, to come away with a tough, seven-point victory, in wet conditions on Friday night, under lights at Norwood Oval. The Redlegs were led by a brilliant performance from stand-in, acting captain, Jacob Kennerly, who tallied 28 disposals and 1 goal, including the match-winner, as well as a massive 13 tackles along with 10 clearances. Baynen Lowe was everywhere with the footy in hand, racking up 17 touches and kicking two goals, five behinds from seven scoring shots. Lowe, could have easily booted 5 and well and truly blown the game open, had he been able to capitalise on some gettable set shot opportunities. Harry Boyd, arguably the number 1 ruck man in the SANFL, was a force in the ruck racking up a massive 56 hitouts, 21 more than Glenelg could muster as a team. Due to how dominant Boyd was, Tigers coach, Brett Hand, was forced to concede triple Ken Farmer Medalist, Liam McBean in attack to nullify his influence, Boyd finished with 18 disposals. Former West Coast Eagle and Glenelg Magarey Medalist, Luke Partington, collected 32 disposals for the visitors in what was an effortless performance, he also had 10 clearances and 9 tackles. Glenelg forward, Lachie Hosie, kicked half of his side's goals, booting three of the 6. Glenelg captain and Jack Oatey Medalist, Matt Snook was well-held, only collecting 16 disposals in one of his quieter games this season.

The victory for the Redlegs means that they have all but secured a top three berth heading into the final game of the season against the Bloods in Round 19. For the Tigers, the loss means they are all but certain to play off in an Elimination Final, be it against either, reigning premier, Woodville-West Torrens, or Sturt.

Norwood will be looking to snap a two game losing streak at Richmond Oval when they take on West Adelaide in the final game of the minor round.

My tip: Norwood win, just, 5-10 points.



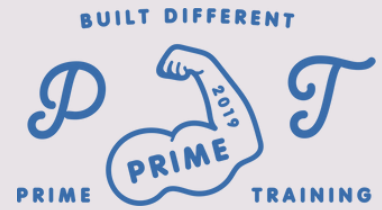
