Both sides have enjoyed great seasons to date as evidenced by finishing inside the top four and whoever is victorious is well placed for a Grand Final appearance with a week off and a home Preliminary Final.

Both sides go into the clash with reasonably healthy lists. Luke Jackson & Christian Salem were managed during the last game for the Demons against Brisbane, but both are expected to be available.

Tom McDonald made his long-awaited return for Casey in the VFL on the weekend and will provide Simon Goodwin another selection option during the finals campaign.

For Sydney, Tom Papley was subbed out of the round 23 clash with St Kilda due to concussion but the bye before the finals series has certainly worked in his favour and he will take his placed in the selected side.

The last time the two sides faced off it was the Swans who were victorious at the MCG by 12 points in round 12. Sam Reid and Logan McDonald kicking three goals each in a high-pressure contest that we can expect to see replicated again Friday night.

Light up on the big stage

Both sides are packed with superstars of the game, and someone will further enhance their reputation with a big-time performance.

For the Swans, can Lance Franklin wind back the clock to kick a bag of goals in a big final? For me it is Isaac Heeney who looms as the Swans match winner.

The 26-year-old won his first All-Australian selection this year and enters the clash in great form with eight goals in his last two games. Heeney is a class act who thrives in the big moments.

The Swans were knocked out of the finals last year in heartbreaking fashion losing to GWS by a point, but Heeney was one of the best on ground booting four goals. Expect the star to deliver again when the pressure is on.

For Melbourne you can take your pick from several Premiership stars, but I think we might see one of the small forwards have an extra significant impact this week.

Kysaiah Pickett was a solid contributor for Melbourne last year, but he has taken his game to another level in 2022 and his last few weeks have been superb.

Jake Melksham has also become an important contributor and he will be extra keen to make an impact after missing out of a Premiership last season. At 31 years of age this might be his last chance at Premiership glory.

The form line

The Demons form was a little patchy a few weeks ago but they have won their last two games and the round 23 victory over Brisbane was ominous.

The Swans could not be in better form winning their last seven games, and this does include wins over three of the current top eight teams.

It is all setup for a great contest. With the game at the MCG and remembering how the Demons performed in last year's final series I am going to just give them the nod.

Muzzled Dogs to Whimper in First Final

The Western Bulldogs will travel to Perth to play Fremantle in a final which will excite. After 24 weeks, eight clubs have made it again to September again. A selection of teams battling it out for a piece of silverware, in the closest finals series since 2016. Unfortunately, for one of these sides, their finals aspirations will be all over by Saturday night. The Dockers finished fifth, while the Dogs stumbled to eighth, after Carlton lost their last four games. Both clubs will be feeling rejuvenated after their pre finals bye last week. As such, the game is expected to be one to watch, as it is a true battle between finals experience and form.

Fremantle have not played finals since 2015 where they were minor premiers. Since this date, things have been dire for Fremantle supporters. They have not looked a damaging side until this season. Coach, Justin Longmuir's secret to success has been Fremantle's defence. The Dockers are ranked second for scores against (trailing Melbourne by three points). Further, they average 57.7 tackles in defence and 51.3 one percenters. This is elite and highlights why opposition teams have struggled to score against them. It also accentuates that Ross Lyons predecessor has adopted similar tactics to what he enforced. Despite Fremantle's defensive attributes, they are ranked only 12th in offense. Their main targets being Rory Lobb, Michael Walters and Lachie Schultz. All of whom average more than a goal a game. However, this is largely Fremantle's issue... they lack quality tall targets forward of the ball. Although Fremantle's tall players like Rory Lobb, Matt Tabener and Griffin Logue can turn a game, they are inconsistent. Against the premier sides in that of Melbourne, Collingwood and Richmond, this collective trio only managed one goal in each respective game. In an elimination final, these players need to stand up.

Excitingly for AFL fans, the battle in the midfield will also be mouth-watering as the Dockers young guns in Serong, Brodie and Brayshaw, will compete against the Dogs strength... their midfield. Serong averages 25.7 disposals and 5.3 score involvements, Brodie 27.6 disposals and 5.5 score involvements and Brayshaw 29.1 disposals and 6.1 score involvements. In contrast, the Dogs midfield Bailey Smith, Jack Macrae, Adam Trealor, Tom Liberatore and Marcus Bontempelli collectively average 27 disposals and 6.8 score involvements. Therefore, the battle inside the war will be one to watch.

Although, Fremantle's goal kicking ability is mediocre, the Dogs have an equally poor defence. They are respectively ranked 11th for scores against. They will need to rectify this area if they are to pose a threat in September. While this would appear unlikely to an outsider, those who have long lasting memories can appreciate the Dogs have made two of the last six grand finals, despite finishing outside the top four both times. What makes them unpredictable is their ability to score quickly as they average 56 inside 50's. Unfortunately, for Dogs fans, this is a rarity as players such as Naughton, Weightman and Ugle Hagen are generally inconsistent. This means there is often a reliance on Trealor (0.7 goals per game), Bontempelli (1 goals per game) and Dunkley (0.8 goals per game) to score. As such, if the Bulldogs forwards can cohesively function, coupled with a guiding influence from their midfield, they will likely overwhelm Fremantle.

The last time these sides met, Fremantle were 17-point victors. Although it is difficult to tip against finals experience, Fremantle have been the better side this season. Therefore, as Peter Motteux so eloquently described it in 1701, the proof is in the pudding.

In North's last game in round 19 they went down to Sturt by 22 points at Unley Oval. The Roosters lead at quarter time before quickly giving that away and never being able to recover it. Sturt managed to hold them at arm's reach for the entire second half and didn't allow them to score. The game was very even around the contest with North narrowly leading clearances while Sturt narrowly lead inside 50s. The main difference between the two sides was the ball use. Sturt went at 73% disposal efficiency while North only went at 66%. It may seem like a small margin, however, over the course of a game that is quite a large difference and no doubt hindered North to play on their terms while also aiding Sturt's ability to force turnovers and score. Campbell Combe was one of North's best as usual with the midfielder recording 24 disposals, 10 tackles and 9 clearances. Up forward Tyson Brazel was prolific with 4 goals to give his side a chance.

On-the-other-hand, Adelaide is coming off a 55-point win in the qualifying final against the Redlegs. Adelaide got off to a flyer, kicking 4 of the first 5 goals and lead by 26 points at half-time. They then broke it open in the 3rd term, kicking 7 goals to Norwood's 1, giving them an insurmountable 62-point lead at 3-quarter time. Adelaide had nearly double the inside 50s that Norwood had, giving the Redlegs defence no chance due the constant pressure that they were under all day. Adelaide also managed to kick very straight considering the strong breeze that caused havoc in the first game of the day. Brett Turner led the way in the midfield with 26 disposals and 16 tackles while Jay Boyle also had plenty of it with 28 disposals and a goal. Kieran Strahan and Lachie Sholl were also at their best, showing that they are a class above SANFL level. Skipper, Matty Wright kicked 5 goals while Luke Pedlar showed glimpses with 3 goals from 12 disposals.

This game promises to be a classic, however, it hasn't been that way recently. North have won 3 of the last 5 games, with Adelaide winning the two most recent games this year. The closest margin out of those games was 26 points so it may not be as close as many hope. In their most recent encounter Lachie Sholl was Adelaide's best with 31 disposals while Aaron Young was huge for North with 34 touches. It will be interesting to see if the week off effects North in a bad way while Adelaide come into this final with a game under their belt as well as a lot of AFL talent that should be too strong for North as it has been throughout this season.

The Adelaide Crows proved to be a genuine premiership threat with a massive 55-point victory over Norwood in the Qualifying Final on Sunday at Adelaide Oval, winning 18.9 117 to 9.8 62. Crows skipper, Matthew Wright led the way kicking 5 goals while Luke Pedlar booted three. Jay Boyle racked up 28 disposals and seven clearances while Brett Turner collected 26 including an incredible 16 tackles to go with his eight clearances.

Norwood's Nikolaus Rokahr, in his return game from a foot injury, had a game-high 32 possessions and 6 marks. Jack Heard played extremely well down back, with 23 touches, six marks and five clearances. Adelaide's Billy Frampton had 18 possessions down back and was a major key in keeping Norwood's forward line relatively quiet, as Matthew Panos and Jacob Kennerly kicked 2 goals each, with the latter also having 20 disposals.

After having the Crows number in the previous two games this season, managing to defeat them twice, the Redlegs were simply no match this time around as the Crows got out to an 25 point lead early into the first quarter. The Legs kicked the final two goals of the opening stanza to trail by 10 points at the first change. Adelaide put the game out of reach when they booted 7 goals to 1 in the third term to take a game-high 62 point lead into the final quarter. The Crows were dominant from the first bounce winning the Inside 50s by 33, (73-40), something that has been practically unheard of all year as Norwood, going into this match were the number defensive team in the competition conceding 62 points per game in comparison to Adelaide, who were the highest scoring team in the competition, averaging 92 points per game.

Glenelg kept their season alive as they fought off elimination against Sturt in the Elimination Final, triumphing by 16 points, 8.13 61 to 6.9 45. The Bays will also be looking to advance themselves and continue their run of good form over the last two weeks.
