
From a neutral perspective let's hope we see a great game of footy.

#### Howe can Pies beat Swans

Collingwood's high-flying intercept defender Jeremy Howe said the team have taken away key learnings from the last time the Magpies played Sydney Swans at the SCG.

"I think the game against Geelong was one of our best games, even though we didn't get the result.

"We took a lot of positivity out of that week, the way we reviewed it really strongly, had a positive vibe to it and took that into Fremantle."



#### **Norwood to Nullify Restless Roosters**

The season of highs and lows has come down to this. Norwood versus North Adelaide. Two sides seeking to get their hands on what the Hunters and Collectors describe as the holy grail. North Adelaide finished first, while the Redlegs placed third on the ladder, with only one win separating these sides. To reach the grand final, North Adelaide narrowly overcame Adelaide in the semi-final, whereas Norwood have used their double



chance to their advantage, losing their first final. Fortunately for Redlegs supporters, Norwood have used their double and then Adelaide, to reach the Grand Final. This game is set to be a blockbuster clash, as both sides have continually proved themselves throughout the season.

North Adelaide have arguably been the strongest side in the SANFL this season. They finished first in league, second in reserves, second in under 18's and fourth in under 16's. As such, it is only fitting they will play in the Grand Final this week. They have been a premiership threat all season as they have not descended below third since round 5. Further, they have the highest win percentage in the competition. North is sufficient in all areas of their game style. They are ranked second for scores for and third for scores against. They are also the most effective side inside forward 50, as opposed to Norwood who are ranked seventh. Coach, Jacob Surjan knows their game style inside out. Their main strength lies within their midfield quadrant through Wigg, Young, Moore and the Combe brothers. The Roosters have lost clearances only twice this season. Ironically, both times were against Norwood. In North Adelaide's first final, these players proved their dominance as they collectively had an average of 29.4 disposals. This allows their forwards one-on-one opportunities as the ball is often won at stoppage or centre clearance. These players had nearly half of the Roosters inside 50's in the first final (24). As such, Norwood need to nullify the influence of such players if they are to pose any threat on the premiership. However, North Adelaide will need to ensure they are not complacent, as the Grand Final will be only their second game in four weeks. While this provides players with adequate rest, clubs can lose momentum. Further, the Roosters recent history is not flawless, as despite winning two of their last three games, they lost to Sturt (who finished fifth) and only beat West Adelaide by six-points (who finished last).

Comparatively, Norwood have won 10 of their last 12 matches. In the preliminary final against Adelaide, the Redlegs won in a tight battle by 11-points after kicking four last quarter goals. This rectifies their first final against Adelaide where they lost by over 10 goals. In the weekends clash, Norwood played like their team of old. Strong defence, culminated with an array of inside 50's set up by the midfield (who are ranked second). This has been Norwood's strength. Defence! Since Jade Rawlings has been head coach, Norwood have been the best defensive side in the competition. However, Rawlings has struggled for his side to kick goals (ranked fourth for scores for). The Redlegs are the only side in the finals who have kicked more behinds than goals. Luckily for Norwood fans, Rawlings has built a diversified forward line with the likes of Jarvis, McClean, Lowe and Panos who are beginning to flourish. In the past fortnight Norwood have kicked 24 goals. This is two more goals than their season average. Therefore, if their midfield can beat North for the third time this season, Norwood will win.
