Second-placed Golden Grove and third-ranked St Peters OC went head-to-head in a high-scoring clash that saw Golden Grove dominate after a tight opening term.

The first quarter was evenly matched, with both sides trading goals in a lively start. Golden Grove held a narrow lead at the break, 3.2 (20) to St Peters OC's 2.2 (14), ahead by just 6 points.

The second quarter turned the game firmly in Golden Grove's favour. They exploded with a 10-goal term, their accuracy on display as they surged to 13.3 (81) while holding St Peters OC to just 4.2 (26). By halftime, Golden Grove had blown the margin out to 55 points.

In the third quarter, St Peters OC mounted a spirited fightback, lifting their scoring output and cutting into the deficit.

They added five goals to close the gap slightly, but Golden Grove still remained in control at 14.6 (90) to 9.6 (60), leading by 30 points at the final break.

Sacred Heart OC started the game strongly, making the most of their opportunities in front of goal.

They kicked 5.1 (31) to Rostrevor's 2.1 (13), taking an 18-point lead into quarter time.

The second quarter was much tighter. Rostrevor created more chances but struggled with accuracy, kicking just 1.6 for the term. Sacred Heart added only three behinds, but their early lead kept them ahead at halftime, 5.4 (34) to 3.7 (25), a 9-point margin.

The third quarter followed a similar pattern, with Rostrevor again wasting opportunities in front of goal. They closed the gap slightly, but Sacred Heart still held on to the advantage at three-quarter time, leading 6.8 (44) to 4.11 (35), up by 9 points.
